SHORT HOPS

► Louisiana and Mississippi State played a doubleheader in the fall of 2019. The Ragin' Cajuns took the first game of the twin bill, 7-4, before dropping the second game 13-2.

► Spencer Arrighetti was named the Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week. (March 2).

► CJ Willis tied the doubles record for Louisiana, smashing three on Tuesday night. (March 2)

► Matt Deggs is back in his second season for Louisiana. The Texas City, Texas, native reached his 200th win as a Division I baseball coach against Rice on Saturday. (Feb. 27)

► Louisiana freshman utility player, Sam Bianco, brother of current LSU player, Drew Bianco, and is the son of former LSU assistant and current Ole Miss Baseball Coach Mike Bianco.

► Louisiana scored 20 runs during opening weekend, the most opening weekend runs since 2016 against Sam Houston State.

► Out of all the teams Louisiana is playing this year, those schools combined for a 203-142 (.667) record in 2020.

► Louisiana has 20 newcomers and 19 returning players on its 2021 roster. There are only seven players on this year's team that were on the 2019 roster.

► Louisiana's pitching staff paced the Sun Belt Conference in strikeouts last season with 173.

► Louisiana is scheduled to play 33 home games this season, the most since 2014 when the team played 40 home games.

RAGIN' CAJUNS GAME NOTES

BENNY BATS

Ben Fitzgerald is swinging a hot bat for Louisiana to start the year. Fitzgerald has reached base in 11-straight games and is in the top 10 in the conference in doubles, steals, slugging, on-base percentage and total bases.

HOT START

Louisiana (9-4) is off to its best start since the storied 2014 season, when the program started the year at 11-2 and finished the season at 58-10.

AP SWAGGIN'

Austin Perrin was great in his start against McNeese State on Wednesday, March 3. In his first start since May of 2019, Perrin only surrendered one hit through five innings and fanned seven batters, the second-most of his career.

WINNING IS FUN

Louisiana ended the 2020 season winning six of its last seven games and it carried into this season. Putting together last year's hot streak and this year's start, the Ragin' Cajuns have won 15 of their last 20 games, the best streak since 2017 when the Cajuns went 15-4-1 from March 25 to April 25.

DID SOMEONE ORDER ARRIGHETTI WITH A SIDE OF DOMINANCE

In his first three appearances at Louisiana, Spencer Arrighetti has tossed 15.1 innings of one-run baseball. Arrighetti has earned two wins and picked up a save in his second appearance of the season against Rice, sealing a 5-3 win for the Cajuns. Arrighetti was the Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week (March 2) and is now the Saturday starter for Louisiana.

WHAT YOU SWINGIN' WILLIS

On Tuesday night against Louisiana Tech (March 2), CJ Willis tied the program record for doubles in a single game with three. Willis is the first player since Kyle Clement (April 19, 2016 vs. Nicholls State) to record three doubles in the same game.

NEED A TALLEY

Currently, Brandon Talley is tied for second in the country in pitching appearances with seven. Among the 11 players that have made seven appearances, Talley has pitched in the second-most innings (10.0).

COMBINED SHUTOUT

Behind the great start of Spencer Arrighetti, Louisiana blanked Louisiana Tech for the first time since Feb. 11, 2005 it its 2-0 victory on Tuesday (Feb. 23) when the teams play for the first time this season.

TEAM DNA

Student-athletes on the baseball team come from all over North America. One player is from Canada and the rest of the team are from 13 different states. The states represented are: Alabama, Arizona, California, Illinois, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Oklahoma, Texas, Wisconsin.

DOMINANCE ON THE MOUND

Louisiana fanned 10.18 batters per game in 2020, its most since 1999. The Ragin' Cajuns also led the conference with 173 Ks last season and the team returns 72% of those strikeouts for the 2021 season.

JUCO RECRUITING CLASS RECEIVES HIGH HONORS

It's never too early to talk about the future crop of Ragin' Cajuns that will make their way to campus in next year, and Louisiana's JUCO class was tabbed as the No. 3 JUCO Recruiting Class in the entire country by thejbb.net.

FOUR-YEAR TRANSFERS

The Cajuns added three four-year college transfers in CJ Willis (LSU), Brett Borgogno (Cal State Fullerton) and Drake Osborn (Texas A&M-CC). Osborn was a Third Team All-Southland Conference Catcher in 2018 and Buster Posey Watch List member in 2019 and Willis was selected in the 39th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Tampa Bay Rays.

HITTING NOTES

- Out of the 554 at-bats the Ragin' Cajuns recorded last season, the team only returns 274 of them.
- Brennan Breaux ended last season hitting .444 in his last five games (8-for-18), and was the only player on the team to end the year batting over .300.
- Returning hits leader Connor Kimple is back patrolling the outfield. He ended the season with 15 hits.

PITCHING NOTES

- Louisiana has seven pitchers on the 2021 roster that have made starts in their careers. The clubhouse leader in career starts is Jack Burk with 26.
- The pitching staff in 2021 returns: 64 starts, 161 appearances, 494.0 innings pitched, 416 strikeouts and 4.32 ERA.
- Jack Burk (152.0) and Austin Perrin (127.1) are the two pitchers on the roster who have thrown over 100.0 innings in their careers.

MLB Draft Cajuns

Three Louisiana Baseball players have already been drafted once in their careers and they are:

- CJ Willis – 39th Round 2018 MLB Draft (Tampa Bay Rays)

MINNESOTA CAJUNS

Sam Riola, from Hamm Lake, Minn., is the first Minnesota native on the roster since Tim Beasley in 2006. To take it a step further, Beasley coached Riola at Bethel University before Riola made his way to Iowa Western JC and then transferred to UL.

NEW IDENTITY

Out of the 40 players on the current roster, the Cajuns only have seven student-athletes who have played two or more years at Louisiana. (Connor Cooke, Brennan Breaux, Alex Hannie, Jacob Schultz, Austin Bradford, Austin Perrin, Jack Burk)

Matt Deggs is entering his second season as the leader of Louisiana Baseball after being announced as the head coach on July 18, 2019.

Deggs owned a 8-9 record before the 2020 season was canceled due to Covid-19, and finished the year winning six of their last seven games.

Deggs, a Texas City, Texas native, previously coached at Louisiana as an assistant under Tony Robichaux during the 2012-2014 seasons. After the conclusion of the historic 2014 season, Deggs departed Louisiana to become the head coach at Sam Houston State where he has spent the last five seasons.

At Sam Houston State Deggs, posted an outstanding record of 187-118 (.613) with Southland Conference regular season championships in three of the last four seasons. Deggs also guided the Bearkats to a Super Regional in 2017, becoming the first-ever Southland program to accomplish the feat.

Deggs led Sam Houston State to NCAA Tournament berths in two out of five seasons (2016, 2017), and claimed at least one conference title over four-straight seasons. Sam Houston State (42-22, 24-6) won both the regular season and tournament title in 2016 en route to an NCAA Regional, coincidentally in Lafayette. Deggs' 2017 squad broke the 40-win barrier again, posting a record of 44-23, 19-11. The 2017 group won 12-of-13 games to close the season to secure the school's first-ever Super Regional berth in Tallahassee, Florida.

Sam Houston State's 2017 group finished ranked in all six national polls, checking in at No. 14 (Collegiate Baseball), No. 16 (NCBWA), No. 18 (D1 Baseball), No. 19 (USA Today Coaches), No. 20 (Baseball America) and No. 22 (Perfect Game).

Deggs' the final two squads at Sam Houston State earned Southland regular season crowns where the Bearkats went 39-20, 24-6 in 2018, and followed with a 31-25, 20-10 record in 2019.

Development of student-athletes was a constant under Deggs' watch of the Sam Houston State program. In his five seasons, a total of 16 Bearkats were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft.

Crediting former legendary UL coach Coach Robichaux for resurrecting his coaching career, Deggs was brought onto the Ragin' Cajuns staff during the 2012 season as an assistant coach, specializing as hitting coach and third base coach, while also overseeing team personnel and recruiting.

Louisiana made significant waves during Deggs' stint as an assistant coach, including student-athletes receiving 15 All-Sun Belt honors, three All-America accolades and two Freshman All-America nods. Plus, former Louisiana standout Blake Trahan earned Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year and became the program's first-ever Team USA member.

The 2014 season was a special one at Louisiana for many reasons. Not only was Cajun nation ignited around its top-ranked baseball program, but it was the winningest season in school history, at 58-10. Louisiana also won the conference regular season title with its 26-4 mark in league play, and began a run of three consecutive Sun Belt tournament titles (2014, 2015, 2016).

The No. 1 ranking that Louisiana earned in 2014 was the second time a program that Deggs was a member of ascended to the top spot in the national polls. During his time with Texas A&M (2006-10), the 2009 squad achieved the school's first-ever preseason national No. 1 ranking.

The Aggies produced two Big 12 Players of the Year, nine All-Americans and 15 First-Team All-Big 12 performers during Deggs' time with the program. Texas A&M won back-to-back Big 12 titles in 2007 and 2008. Deggs' five-year stretch with Texas A&M saw the program go from posting a sub-.500 record in 2006 to reaching back-to-back NCAA Super Regionals in 2007 and 2008. Deggs assisted the Aggies to two Big 12 Tournament crowns (2007, 2010) and one regular season title (2008).

Prior to coaching the Aggies, Deggs served as hitting coach and recruiting coordinator at Arkansas for Dave Van Horn from 2003-05. Deggs provided instruction to three Razorbacks who earned all-conference recognition, as well as three Freshman All-Americans. The Razorbacks claimed both the SEC Championship and booked a trip to the College World Series in 2004.

Deggs first received experience as a head coach at Texarkana College for five seasons (1998-2002), compiling a sound record of 187-100. The squad claimed two Texas Eastern Athletic Conference runners-up finishes, a pair of TEAC titles (2001, 2002) and the school's first-ever trip to Junior College World Series.

Developing and recruiting talented young men was a staple of Deggs', even early on in his coaching career, as he brought future MLB All-Star Hunter Pence to Texarkana as a former high school standout from Arlington, Texas.

Deggs spent the 1996 and 1997 seasons as the hitting and infield coach at Northwestern State under Van Horn, assisting the Demons to the Southland Conference title in 1997. His infield units ranked among the top infield groups in the country for both seasons.

During his own playing career, Deggs was an infielder for Alvin Junior College from 1991-92 and at Northwood University from 1993-94. Deggs earned a Master's degree from Northwestern State in 1996.

Deggs followed his college career with a turn in the professional ranks, playing three years for the Mobile (Ala.) Baysharks and the Tennessee Tomahawks, two of which were spent as a player/coach under former Boston Red Sox manager Butch Hobson and former Red Sox catcher Mike O'Berry.

Deggs is married to the former Kathy Saldia and the couple has a son, Kyler, and two daughters, Klaire and Khloe.
