DAWG BITES

- The Dawgs are hitting .305 on the year and have an on-base percentage of .427. The .305 average is the 20th best in the NCAA, and the on-base percentage is the 33rd best in the country. The Diamond Dawgs have four players hitting over .300 on the season, with Colton Ledbetter leading the team with .367 average.
- Round Trippers: The Dawgs have hit 11 home runs. This is the third most in the Southeastern Conference this season. Eight MSU players have hit a homer this season, with Bryce Chance, Colton Ledbetter, and Kellum Clark leading the team with two homers each.
- Good Eye: The Dawgs have had a good eye at the plate this season. They have drawn 48 walks this season, the most in the SEC. Luke Hancock has eight walks, while Lane Forsythe, and Dakota Jordan, have drawn seven.
- Best Fans in the Land: The Diamond Dawgs have the best fans in college baseball. The Dawgs have played six games at home this season, with four drawing over 10,000 fans to games. In the series opener against Arizona State, the Dawgs had a crowd of 11,136. Mississippi State drew the most fans in the country over the weekend series. In the second game of the series against Arizona State, the Dawgs drew 14,320 into Dudy Noble Field, the seventh most in field history.
- It's been written about. It's been Tweeted about. It's been talked about. It's what has become known as The Dude Effect. If anyone had forgotten or doubted that the best home-field advantage in all of college baseball is inside the confines of Mississippi State's Dudy Noble Field. Opponents don't simply have to defeat the Diamond Dawgs.

- Visitors have to conquer the cowbell-crazed home crowd as well.
- Graham Yntema made his first career start as a Bulldog on Saturday Night against Arizona State, going five total innings. He allowed one earned run on three hits, collecting six strikeouts in the game - a personal career high.
- In Saturday's action, Colton Ledbetter stole three bases, which set a new career high for him. He is the first Bulldog to do so since Kamren James (April 5, 2022)
- Freshman Bradley Loftin made his first collegiate start on Tuesday night and recorded eight strikeouts. He limited the Warhawks to only one unearned run in the contest, and ULM only tallied two hits off Loftin, who went four innings.
- Did you know that the Diamond Dawgs are one
 of three programs in NCAA History and the only
 Southeastern Conference program to play in the
 NCAA Men's College World Series in six-straight
 decades.
- Mississippi State's Luke Hancock and Colton Ledbetter are two of 25 players selected to the Preseason All-SEC baseball teams by the league's coaches. Hancock was named second-team catcher, while Ledbetter was named a secondteam outfielder.
- The Diamond Dawgs saw two players, Colton Ledbetter, and Amani Larry, earn Preseason All-American honors.
