Parking

All parking passes will be mobile. An email will be sent containing a link to obtain your pass. Media members will download an AXS app to access their parking pass. Parking will be in Lot 2 on the west side of Amon G. Carter Stadium.

Credential Pickup

Unless other arrangements are made, all credentials will be available at the Media Will Call table on game day. The table is located on the west side of Amon G. Carter Stadium at the loading dock entrance located in Lot 2. The table will open at 9:00 a.m. (two hours prior to game time). All media will enter the stadium through the loading dock entrance at level B2. There, they will have their temperatures checked and a red wrist band will give them access to the press box. The writers press box and TV booth are located on Level 2, while the radio booths are on Level 3. All media areas may be accessed by either the stairs or elevator in the northwest corner of the stadium.

Photographers

Approved photographers will receive a yellow arm band along with their credential. The arm band will allow access to shoot from the first row in sections 101, 109, 120 and 129. Spaces are first-come, first-served and social distancing must be maintained. Photographers will have a workroom on Level B1 of the stadium near the visiting locker room. No person obtaining a credential through the bowl will receive any field access at any time before, during or after the game.

Pregame Meal

A boxed lunch and drinks will be provided in the press box beginning at 9:00 a.m. All media must eat at their assigned press box seats.

Postgame Interviews

All postgame interviews will be conducted via Zoom through the respective school's SIDs. All Zoom interviews will be recorded, and quickie quotes will be taken by a member of the bowl staff and emailed. Email links will be sent to the media during the game.

Statistics

Live statistics will be available via statbroadcast. The media link is: http://armedforces.statbroadcast.com. No printed statistics will be disseminated during the game. Final game books will be available in the press box at the conclusion of the game.

Internet Access

Wireless internet is available in the press box by choosing to connect to the Dan Jenkins Press Box. The password is frogstrong2020.

Stadium Frequency Coordination

Any affiliate TV station, video crew, radio station or other media using any transmission device (mics, IFBs, In-Ears, 2-way radios, microwave, etc. [cell phones/pagers excluded]) must have clearance through the Amon G. Carter Stadium frequency coordinator. The device and frequency under which it operates must be reported in advance to avoid interference with the many radio frequency devices that already have been established. If you plan on using a "wired microphone," please do NOT bring your wireless equipment into the stadium.
