WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS ARKANSAS . . .

- MSU 45-39 in SEC lid-lifters — 30-19 at home, 15-19 on the road and 0-1 at neutral sites.
- The Bulldogs are 3-1 versus Arkansas in openers, with the last meeting coming in 2012, a 98-88 loss in Fayetteville.
- MSU's most common league-opening foe is Auburn (21, 10-11).
- Mississippi State has lost four-straight SEC openers, with its last win coming against South Carolina in 2013.
- With his one block against the Ospreys, **Aric Holman** needs just five more to tie Gavin Ware for the eighth most in school history.
- Against North Florida, MSU scored 100-plus points for the first time since a 106-88 win against Eastern Washington in **Ben Howland's** first game as head coach on Nov. 13, 2015. It also marked the 54th time in school history the Dogs have reached the century mark.
- The 109 points scored were the most since MSU totaled 107 against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Nov. 23, 1999.
- Mississippi State has now shot 50 percent or better from the floor seven times this season. Last year, the total was eight.
- It's 62-percent shooting against the Ospreys was its best since making 62.0 percent of its shots against Auburn on Jan. 16, 2011.
- Against North Florida, both **Aric Holman** and **Xavian Stapleton** had career highs with 23 and 16 points, respectively.
- **Abdul Ado** has 28 blocks on the year, a total that's eighth best by an MSU freshman in school history. His 2.3 clip is third in the SEC and the highest in school history for a freshman.
- The Bulldogs have now won 11 home games, it's most since also winning 11 in 2014.
- MSU leads the SEC and is 21st nationally in points allowed at 62.6.
- Mississippi State is looking for its first 13-1 start since opening the 2003-04 campaign 21-1.
- The Bulldogs are looking to snap a 18-game losing streak against ranked opponents.

Prior to this season, the last that happened was on Feb. 7, 2017, at Auburn when **Weatherspoon** totaled 25 and **Lamar Peters** had 23.

Q & GAME WINNERS

■ Game-winning shots have become the norm for junior All-SEC guard and leading scorer **Quinnndary Weatherspoon**.

On Dec. 3 at home against Dayton, he collected a steal with 4 seconds left and went the length of the court for a layup to give MSU a thrilling 61-59 win.

Then against Jacksonville State, he drained a 3-pointer with 0.7 seconds left to lift the Bulldogs to a dramatic 59-56 win.

As a freshman against Vanderbilt, he drained a buzzer beater from 3-point range for a 75-74 victory.

SEEING DOUBLE

■ In the season opener against Alabama State, **Aric Holman** wasted little time recording a double-double.

The junior forward poured in 18 and grabbed 11 rebounds in the Bulldogs' win.

Against Green Bay, **Abdul Ado** broke into the category for his first with 12 points and 11 boards in just his second game at MSU.

Against Dayton, **Quinnndary Weatherspoon** had 11 points and 10 rebounds for his third-career double-double.

Then against Cincinnati, Holman delivered again with 18 points and 10 rebounds.

He matched the feat in the win against UT Martin, marking the first time he's had double-doubles in back-to-back games.

■ Three times this season, Mississippi State has limited opponents to just six free throw attempts or fewer.

Then against UT Martin on Saturday, the Skyhawks were just 4-6.

The last time MSU held an opponent without a free throw was on Jan. 19, 1985, in a 61-44 win against Ole Miss.

MSU FOUL SHOTS

■ Although Mississippi State made it the charity stripe 20 times against North Florida, four times this season it's attempted nine or fewer shots.

As a results, the Bulldogs are last in the SEC in free throws made (168) and second in attempts (250).

STRONG REBOUND MARGIN

■ Mississippi State out-rebounded North Florida, 46-21, it's largest margin this year.

Woodard, the top-ranked player in Mississippi and a Dandy Dozen selection, is ranked 56th overall nationally and is the son of Robert Woodard, Sr., who played at MSU from 1987-90.

He led Columbus to the Class 6A crown in 2016 and was last year's Gatorade Player of the year.

The 6-6, 187-pound Stewart is listed as the 33rd best small forward.

As a junior at Riverside last year, he averaged 18.9 points, 9.7 rebounds and 3.1 assists.

Nationally, Scout has him as the 103rd best player overall, while Rivals has him at 103.

Ben Howland

22nd Season Overall | 3rd Season At Mississippi State
443-240 (42-34 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015, Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 443-240 record – Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (42-34).
- Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).
- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children – Meredith and Adam (Brittney) – and two grandsons, Benjamin Clark Howland II and Elijah Howland.
