### WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS TENNESSEE . . .

- Mississippi State is 0-3 in the SEC for the second-straight year. The Bulldogs haven't been 0-4 since the 1992-93 season.
- The Volunteers have won four out of the last five overall in this series and two-straight in Starkville.
- In their last meeting, however, MSU claimed a 71-66 win in Knoxville.
- Craig Sword had 20 points at Arkansas, marking the 18th time in his career he's scored 20-plus points. He's now scored 20-plus points in back-to games for the first time this season and the third time in his career.
- Gavin Ware has scored in double-digits 15-straight games, the most since Tony Watts did it 28 games in a row in 1992-93.
- Mississippi State will recognize its 1991 SEC championship team during the game.
- With the hard-fought loss at Kentucky on Tuesday, MSU has now dropped 12-straight games to ranked teams and 14 out of the last 17. The Bulldogs are 0-2 this year, with the other setback coming against Texas A&M.
- In just 14 games, **Malik Newman** has already drained 33 3-pointers. That's currently the 7th most by an MSU freshman, while his 86 attempts rank 8th. His 13.1 average, second highest on the team, ranks 6th all-time by a freshman in school history.
- Senior guard Fred Thomas is just 40 points shy of 1,000 for his career.
- Gavin Ware has a player efficiency ranking of 32.22, which is ninth best nationally and third best in the SEC behind leader Ben Simmons of LSU (34.88) and Arkansas' Moses Kingsley (32.47).
- The Bulldogs' three offensive rebounds at Kentucky were the fewest since having three against Vanderbilt on 2-23-13.

### **MSU BY THE NUMBERS**

**6** — Mississippi State has shot 50 percent or better from the field **6** times this season. The Bulldogs are 5-1 in those games, with the lone setback coming at No. 13 Kentucky on Tuesday.

11 — Senior forward Gavin Ware is 11th in the country in field goal percentage at .650 (102-157). In the SEC, he's tops.



He was the first MSU freshman to earn the honor since Gavin Ware and Craig Sword in 2012-13.

Newman won his honor following the 93-69 win against Northern Colorado in Jackson with his 20-point performance on 6-11 shooting.

#### WARE TABBED SEC POW

■ After scoring a career-high 26 points and grabbing 13 rebounds in the season opener against Eastern Washington, senior forward Gavin Ware was named the first SEC Player of the Week this season.

It's the second league honor for Ware, who was named SEC Freshman of the Week on Dec. 24, 2013.

He was also the first Bulldog to earn POW honors since Craig Sword on Dec. 2, 2014.

### WARE MAKING REBOUNDING MOVES

■ Senior forward Gavin Ware currently has 772 rebounds, tied for the 8th most in school history and 87 shy of moving into MSU's all-time Top 5.

## WARE LOOKING TO JOIN ELITE 1,000/800 CLUB

■ Currently, only six players in Mississippi State history have totaled 800 rebounds and 1,000 points.

However, senior forward Gavin Ware is on pace to join that group.

The six players who have achieved that feat are Bailey Howell (2,030 pts, 1,277 rbs), Jarvis Varnado (1,403 pts, 1,096 rbs), Rickey Brown (1,838 pts, 1,092 rbs), Wiley Peck (1,136 pts, 964 rbs), Erick Dampier (1,231 pts, 859 rbs) and Tyrone Washington (1,119 pts, 847 rbs).

Ware now has 1,153 points and 772 boards.

### **WARE AIMING FOR 20.0 POINTS**

■ Senior forward Gavin Ware is currently averaging a team-best 16.8 points after having 11 at Kentucky, which is also seventh in the SEC.

Mississippi State hasn't had a player finish a season averaging 20 or more points since Jeff Malone averaged 26.8 in 1983.

In 1981, Malone, who went on to enjoy a stellar NBA career with Washington and Utah, averaged 20.1 points.

In 1996, the year the Bulldogs advanced to the Final Four, Darryl Wilson was close at 17.8.

## HOWLAND LOOKING TO JOIN ELITE CLUB IN TERMS OF NCAAS

■ Ben Howland enters his first season at Mississippi State looking to achieve a feat only 12

coaches have ever done, and that's lead four different teams to the NCAA Tournament.

Howland has already guided Northern Arizona, Pittsburgh and UCLA to the Big Dance.

The first 12 coaches to do so are Lon Kruger, Steve Alford, John Beilein, Lefty Driesell, Cliff Ellis, Larry Eustachy, Jim Harrick, Fran McCaffery, Tom Penders, Tubby Smith, Rick Pitino and Eddie Sutton.

### **HIGH FREE THROW PERCENTAGE**

■ Mississippi State currently leads the SEC with its .742 free throw percentage. The school record is 76.9 percent in 1967-68. The Bulldogs haven't eclipsed .700 since 2011-12 when they were .710.

In its last outing at Kentucky, MSU was 14-16.

### **READY HAS FIRST DOUBLE-DOUBLE**

■ Junior guard I.J. Ready posted his first double-double against Missouri State in Puerto Rico with 13 points and a career-high 11 assists.

### **SEASON HIGHS IN STEALS, ASSISTS**

- Against Northern Colorado in a 91-68 win in Jackson on Dec. 23, the Bulldogs recorded season highs in assists (21) and steals (12).
- I.J. Ready accounted for 11 assists, which tied his career best set against Missouri State in Puerto Rico back in November.

The Bulldogs also had season highs in free throws made (21) and attempted (26).

### **MSU SHOOTS LIGHTS OUT VS. EWU**

■ Against Eastern Washington in a 106-88 victory, MSU shot 62.1 percent (41-66) from the floor. It was the first time it shot 60 percent or better since hitting 60.4 percent (29-48) against Auburn on Feb. 4, 2012.

It also marked the first time the Bulldogs scored 100 points in a season opener for the first time since opening the 1998-99 campaign with a 105-53 win against Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

All-time, the Bulldogs have eclipsed the 100-point mark 53 times.

### SWORD, WARE LEAD SEC

■ Of all current players in the SEC, Craig Sword leads all scorers with 1,282 points, while Gavin Ware is tops with 772 rebounds. Ware is also third with 1,153 points. In addition, Sword has 165 steals, second only to Texas A&M's Alex Caruso. who has 237.

### DOGS, FOE SHOOT 50 PERCENT +

■ Twice this season, both Mississippi State and its opponents have shot 50 percent or better from the floor.

The first time was in the seaosn opener when MSU was .621 (41-66) and Eastern Washington was .508 (33-65).

Then earlier this week at Kentucky, the Bulldogs were .529 (27-51), while the Wildcats were .509 (28-55).

### ARKANSAS SOLID FROM LONG RANGE

■ In the Bulldogs' 82-78 loss at Arkansas, the Razorbacks were 16-24 beyond the arc, with Dusty Hannahs connecting on 8 of his 13 attempts.

That's the most by a team since Troy drained 17 in 2005-06 and the most by an individual since Ole Miss' Stefan Moody made 8 last year.

#### PRESEASON ALL-SEC & POLL

■ In the preseason polls voted on by the media, freshman Malik Newman was tabbed second-team All-SEC. Last March, senior guard Craig Sword earned second-team honors but didn't make the preseason list this year.

As a team, the Bulldogs were picked to finish 8th under first-year coach Ben Howland after concluding the 2015 campaign tied for 11th.

In the Coaches Poll, both Sword and Newman were named second-team All-SEC.

## NEWMAN ONE OF 50 NAMED TO WOODEN WATCH LIST

■ Malik Newman has been named to the Men's Preseason Top 50 Wooden Award watch list.

He's is in his first season at MSU after a

standout prep career that saw him become a McDonald's All-American and ranked the No. 1 shooting guard in the country by ESPN after leading Callaway to four-straight state titles. The Jackson, Miss., native made his Bulldog debut against Southern on Nov. 16, tallying 6 points, 3 assists and 2 rebounds. On the year, he's averaging 13.1 points.

On the women's side, Victoria Vivians is on the Wooden Award Women's Preseason Top 30 watch list to make MSU one of only nine schools in the nation, including one of just two SEC programs, to boast candidates on each list.

Newman is also one of 50 players on the Naismith Trophy early season watch list.

### STALEY ADDED TO ROSTER

■ Freshman Elijah Staley was added to the roster in early December.

He saw his first action at Florida State, where in 6 minutes of action, he had one rebound and 1 steal and missed his long field goal attempt.

He scored his first point against North Carolina Central on a free throw late in the second

The redshirt freshman from Marietta, Ga., is also a back-up quarterback on the football team. He appeared in two games this season and rushed for 18 yards. He was also with the team for the 51-28 Belk Bowl win against N.C. State.

A year ago, he briefly practiced with the basketball team once football concluded, but a knee injury sidelined him in January.

In high school, Staley was a Class 6A first-team All-State selection by the Atlanta Journal-Constitution as a junior, averaging 18.0 points and 9.5 rebounds.

He led his Wheeler High School team to a 21-9 ledger and a berth to the state semifinals.

His career high of 40 points came against Etowah in 2013.

In football his senior season, he was ranked as the 18th-best quarterback in the country according to ESPN.

### HOUSTON, NDOYE LEAVE TEAM

■ Sophomore forwards Demetrius Houston and Fallou Ndoye are no longer on the team.

Houston appeared in just one game this season, scoring 2 points against Eastern Washington. Ndoye played in six games and had 2 points and 7 rebounds.

### STELLAR DEFENSIVE EFFORT

■ In the win against N.C. Central, MSU limited the Eagles to 48 points on 17-72 shooting. The .236 shooting percent was the lowest for an MSU opponent since LSU (.212, 14-66) on 1-9-08 in Baton Rouge and the fewest points the Bulldogs have allowed this season.

The last foe to shoot below 28 percent was Texas-San Antonio (.273, 15-55) on 12-4-12.

### **MSU YIELDS 105 POINTS TO MIAMI**

■ In the opening round of the Puerto Rico Tip-Off, Mississippi State dropped a 105-79 decision to the Miami Hurricanes.

It was the first time the Bulldogs allowed 100-plus point since a 101-96 setback to UMass in overtime on 3-13-12.

It was the 35th time in school history a team has scored 100-plus points against MSU.

#### **AUSTIN NAMED 2016 SEC LEGEND**

■ Mario Austin has been named the 2016 SEC Legend.

Austin, a native of York, Ala., played for the Bulldogs from 2001-03 and led MSU to the 2002 SEC Tournament title and two NCAA Tournaments.

- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).
- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons.
- In 1997, the Lumberjacks had a school-record 21 victories, captured the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- · Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children Meredith and Adam (Brittney) - and one grandson, Benjamin Clark Howland II.
