WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS MISSOURI . . .

- At Tennessee, Schnider Herard recorded his first-career double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds. Aric Holman has accounted for Mississippi State's other two.
- MSU has won its last three games against Missouri and is looking for its first four-game winning streak against the Tigers.
- Mizzou is one of three SEC teams the Bulldogs are .500 or better against, with Ole Miss and South Carolina being the other two.
- Four times this year, MSU has rallied from deficits of 10 points or more en route to victory.
- In his last three games, Schnider Herard has totaled 37 points and 20 rebounds, the best threegame stretch of his career.
- At Tennessee, MSU forced a season-low 7 turnovers and collected a season-low 4 steals while allowing a season-high 91 points.
- •I.J. Ready has made 23-straight free throws.
- Lamar Peters had a career-high 7 assists at Tennessee. He's second on the team with 49.
- Quinndary Weatherspoon is 11-of-19 in his last four games from 3-point range.
- KenPom.com has MSU as the second-least experienced team of all 351 DI programs.
- When is Mississippi State successful? When outrebounding foes (9-0), shooting 45 percent or better (10-1) and winning or being tied at the half (11-0).
- Of current SEC players, I.J. Ready is 12th with 842 points, third with 142 steals and third with 360 assists.
- Lamar Peters, Quinndary Weatherspoon, Mario Kegler, Schnider Herard and Aric Holman have started five-straight games, the longest stretch of any of the six lineups.
- Sophomore guard Quinndary Weatherspoon is fourth in the SEC with his 17.3 scoring clip.
 MSU hasn't had a player average 18-plus since Darryl Wilson in 1996 (18.0).

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Last year, MSU was 10-5, including a 5-1 mark against non-conference foes. This year, MSU is 7-4.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 42-season composite record of 425-175 (.708) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

A CLOSER LOOK AT MSU

Q POW

■ On Jan. 16, Quinndary Weatherspoon was tabbed the SEC's player of the week after scoring 25 points at Arkansas and 13 versus Kentucky.

Last year, he earned freshman of the week honors.

OFF THE SCHNIDE

■ After coming off the bench the first 12 games, freshman forward Schnider Herard has started the first six SEC games.

During that stretch, the Haiti native is averaging 8.8 points and 5.5 rebounds, while on the year he's averaging 5.0 points and 5.2 boards.

He scored a career-high 16 points against Texas A&M, while recording his first-career double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds at Tennessee.

HARDCOURT ROBBERY

■ Four times this year, MSU has collected 11 or more steals.

Against Oregon State, the Bulldogs were credited with 17 steals, the most since also having 17 against Florida Atlantic on 11-13-12.

The Bulldogs are third in the SEC with their 7.9 average, 39th nationally.

Individually, **Quinndary Weatherspoon** is fifth in the SEC with his 1.9 steals, while **I.J. Ready** is sixth at 1.9.

Q ECLIPSES 600

■ After surpassing 500-career points against Southern Miss back in December, Quinndary Weatherspoon reached 600 after scoring 25 points in the win at Arkansas.

He has 647 points in 47 games.

Just ONE 3

■ Against Texas A&M, Mississippi State limited the Aggies to just one 3-pointer, which came late in the second half.

It was the fewest treys allowed since Arkansas had only one on Feb. 9, 2016, at the Hump.

LOTS OF ROAD POINTS

■ Mississippi State collected its first road win of the season with a 95-78 win at LSU, its most points in league play since totaling 91 at Auburn in 1994.

The 95 points were also the most in SEC action since pouring in 94 at home against LSU in 2009.

STREAKS SNAPPED

■ Mississippi State entered SEC play having lost four straight at both LSU and Arkansas, dating back to 2011.

In a span of four days, both ended as the Bulldogs won at LSU (95-78) and at Arkansas (84-78). The two road wins have already matched last year's total.

■ Against Norfolk State in the season opener, sophomore forward Aric Holman totaled 5 blocked shots before having 5 against Northwestern State on Nov. 28.

That was the most by an MSU player since Gavin Ware also had 5 at Loyola-Chicago on 12-5-12.

On the year, he currently has 41, the third most in the SEC.

20 X 2

■ Against Morehead State and UMKC, Quinndary Weatherspoon nearly scored at will.

After totaling a career-high 27 points against Morehead State, he poured in 25 against UMKC.

The last MSU player who totaled 20-plus points in back-to-back games was Craig Sword last year — 20 versus Kentucky, 21 at Arkansas.

Sword is also the last player to achieve the feat in three-straight games.

On the year, Weatherspoon has eclipsed the 20-point mark six times, with MSU winning all six games.

.500 x 2, x 2

■ On Dec. 22, both Mississippi State and Morehead State shot 50 percent from the floor in the Bulldogs' 85-76 victory.

MSU was .534, while the Eagles were .500.

And then against No. 5 Kentucky, it happened again when MSU shot .542 and Kentucky .508

Prior to this season, the last time both MSU and its opponent shot 50 percent was last January at Kentucky (.529/.509).

SEEING DOUBLE

■ Sophomore forward **Aric Holman** has recorded two of MSU's three double-doubles this year.

His first came in the season opener against Norfolk State, where he had 11 points and 11 rebounds. Then at Arkansas, he totaled 13 points and 11 rebounds.

Schnider Herard then posted his first at Tennessee with 14 points and 11 rebounds.

SOLID FIRST HALF AT LSU

■ At LSU, the Bulldogs had their best first half of the year, scoring 52 points, surpassing the 45 totaled against Oregon State, en route to a 95-78 win.

In the opening frame, MSU was 20-34 shooting, with a 7-12 mark from 3-point range.

35 STRAIGHT POINTS

■ Against Southern Miss in and 86-44 win, Mississippi State did something no other team in school history during the modern era has achieved — score 35-straight points.

Up 41-29 in the second half, the Bulldogs pulled ahead 76-29 before the Golden Eagles scored again. It was the largest margin of victory since beating New Orleans by 51 (97-46) on 1-3-13.

DEFENSIVE EFFORT

■ Mississippi State held Southern Miss to a season-low 44 points.

It was the fewest points the Bulldogs have allowed since Mississippi Valley State managed just 45 on Dec. 28, 2009.

The Golden Eagles totaled just 19 second-half points, also the fewest MSU has yielded this season.

HOLMAN'S HIGHS

■ Sophomore **Aric Holman** had a career game against UTEP in terms of scoring, totaling 18 points in the Bulldogs' 61-54 victory.

Holman has scored 10-plus points in 10 games, something he didn't do last year in 16 outings.

LONG-RANGE SUCCESS

■ Seven times this year, Mississippi State has made 11 or more 3-pointers and is 7-0 in those games.

The school record of 17 came in Jackson against Southern Miss on Dec. 19.

The Bulldogs have three players with 25 or made 3-pointers. Quinndary Weatherspoon and Lamar Peters lead the way with 34 each while Tyson Carter has 26.

Weatherspoon and Peters are tied for sixth in the SEC with their 2.1 average.

As a team, Mississippi State is third in the league 7.9

FORCING TURNOVERS

■ On the year, MSU has forced 261 turnovers to rank 5th in the SEC in turnover margin (+2.2).

On the year, the high mark was 22 against Texas A&M, which MSU converted into 21 points.

Ben Howland 21th Season Overall | 2nd Season At Mississippi State 427-229 (26-23 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015, Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 427-229 record – Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (26-23).
- Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division

I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).

- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
