#### IT'S TIME FOR TIP

Mississippi State returns to the hardcourt at 2 p.m. on Saturday when it hosts Georgetown College in the final exhibition game of the year. The Bulldogs, under the direction of 12th-year coach Rick Stansbury, are coming off a 23-13 campaign that was highlighted by the 2009 SEC Tournament crown and a second-straight berth to the NCAA Tournament. The Bulldogs return all five starters from last year's squad, including seniors All-SEC standout forward Jarvis Varnado and SEC All-Tournament team selection Barry Stewart.

The Tigers, ranked No. 7 in the NAIA Top 25 Coaches' Poll, posted a 27-5 ledger last year and finished the season ranked No. 5 after losing to Central Methodist in the first round of the NAIA National Tournament.

This year, Georgetown College got off to a good start when it defeated Temple Baptist in its season opener, 115-47. The Tigers also turned heads when they dropped a hard-fought 80-68 decision to No. 19 Louisville after leading 35-31 at the break

#### **EXHIBITION SUCCESS UNDER STANSBURY**

Entering his 12th season at the helm of the MSU program, Rick Stansbury has guided the Bulldogs to a 20-2 record in exhibition play. Last year, Mississippi State was 2-0, defeating Montevallo, 88-59, and Oklahoma City, 67-65.

#### **NEWBIES SEE THE COURT**

Although the Bulldogs are a veteran-laden squad, four players saw action for the first time wearing the Maroon & White - true freshmen Wendell Lewis and Shaun Smith and walk-ons Baxter Price and Charles Parker.

#### **BULLDOGS IN THE POLLS**

In the Associated Press, MSU is No. 18. In the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' poll, the Bulldogs are No. 19. It's the first time Mississippi State made the prease-ason polls since coming in at No. 12 in 2004-05.

#### **PRESEASON HONORS**

In the media poll released on Oct. 22, Mississippi State was picked to win the Western Division and received three votes to take the overall title, while Jarvis Varnado was tabbed first-team All-SEC by both the media and coaches.

The senior forward was also named first-team All-SEC earlier this week by the league coaches.

#### MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 39-11 mark for an .780 winning percentage. With a 13-5 mark this year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's 11 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 135-33 (.804) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 65-23 (.739) SEC mark and a 70-10 (.875) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 32-season composite record of 341-131 (.722) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

Junior Ravern Johnson's 23 points sparked a convincing 82-54 win by 18th-ranked Mississippi State against Oklahoma City in the exhibition opener for both teams at Humphrey Coliseum.

Johnson drained 6-of-10 threepointers, shot 8-of-15 from the floor and grabbed five rebounds.

Three other Bulldogs recorded double-digit efforts in the win, led by junior Kodi Augustus' 16 points. Sophomore Dee Bost joined senior Barry Stewart by scoring 11 points, while Bost added 6 assists.

All-SEC senior Jarvis Varnado grabbed 11 rebounds, notched 8 points and blocked 4 shots. Freshman Wendell Lewis continued his impressive preseason performance by claiming 8 rebounds in just 13 minutes.

OCU point guard Chris Brown led the game with 24 points.

The Bulldogs struggled with their opponents in the first half, but never trailed in the game. After scoring the first eight points, State saw two free-throws from OCU's Brown spark a 10-0 run that pulled the game within a point. At the break, MSU led 38-33 half.
