


WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS DELTA STATE . . .

- ✓ Mississippi State enters its 103rd season of basketball having won 28 of its last 30 exhibition games.
- ✓ Mississippi State and Delta State have met 16 times in regular-season play, with the Bulldogs holding a 15-1 advantage. MSU won the first 14 meetings before DSU claimed its first victory in 1985, 56-53 in Starkville.
- ✓ Last year, the Bulldogs won their only exhibition game, knocking off Auburn-Montgomery, 86-57. MSU placed four players in double-digits, with Colin Borchert scoring a game-high 23 points.
- ✓ Bulldogs coach **Rick Ray** is 2-0 in exhibition games.
- ✓ Mississippi State returns seven players who saw action last year, including leading scorer **Craig Sword** (13.7). **De'Runnya Wilson** is expected to return to the team when football concludes.
- ✓ The Bulldogs welcome six first-year players to this year's active roster — **Fallou Ndoye**, **Travis Daniels**, **Maurice Dunlap**, **Demetrius Houston**, **Oliver Black**, and **Elijah Staley**
- ✓ The injury bug struck MSU early this year. **Craig Sword** and **I.J. Ready** missed all preseason following back surgery to repair bulging disks. Sword is expected to miss just one or two games, while Ready is expected back in mid-December. Junior college transfer **Johnny Zuppardo** is out for the year after tearing the ACL and meniscus in his left knee.
- ✓ Mississippi State is looking to avoid three-straight losing seasons for the first time since having six in a row from 1984-89.
- ✓ The Bulldogs ended last season by going 1-1 in the SEC Tournament.
- ✓ **Craig Sword** is just 228 points shy of becoming the 4th player in school history to reach 1,000.
- ✓ **Gavin Ware** is 58 rebounds shy of joining the 500 Club. He's on pace to move in to the Top 15 all-time in school history.





The Bulldogs have compiled a 37-season composite record of 399-157 (.718) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

MSU COACH RICK RAY

Head Coach Rick Ray

- On April 1, 2012, Rick Ray was named the 19th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In his first season at MSU, produced two players to the SEC All-Freshman team — Gavin Ware and Craig Sword.
- Entering his third season, he is 24-41 in the rebuilding process.
- On the staff of three different teams that have advanced to the NCAA Tournament — Indiana State, Purdue and Clemson.
- As an assistant at Clemson for two years, the Tigers won 38 games and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2011.
- During his time at Purdue as an assistant, the Boilermakers won 103 games in four years.
- All four teams at Purdue earned a berth in the NCAA Tournament, with the last two advancing to the Sweet 16.
- The 2009 Purdue team won 28 games and the Big 10 Tournament en route to garnering a No. 5 seed.
- While at Purdue, Ray was an assistant with second-year Tennessee coach Cuonzo Martin.
- The 2007 Purdue recruiting was considered one of the tops in the country, earning national rankings of No. 5 and No. 6 by Scout and Rivals, respectively.
- Ray was an assistant at Indiana State for seven years.
- In 2000 and 2001, the Sycamores won 20-plus games and made the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2000, the ISU won the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title with a 14-4 ledger.
- In 2001, Indiana State won the MVC Tournament before upsetting Oklahoma in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Ray also spent two seasons at Northern Illinois (2005 and 2006), while his first Ray's coaching job was at Nebraska-Omaha.
- Ray and his wife, Breyana, have two sons, Deacon and Mason, and one daughter, Katriece.
