WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS NORFOLK STATE ...

- Mississippi State enters its 105th season of basketball having won 11 out of its last 14 season
- Overall, the Bulldogs are 81-23 in lid-lifters and have won 24 of their last 31 dating back to the 1985-86 campaign.
- MSU is opening at home for the 10th time in the last 11 years. The last time it opened on the road was 2012-13 at Troy, a 56-53 setback.
- Norfolk State is one of four possible teams on MSU's schedule the Bulldogs are facing for the first time. Central Florida, Boise State and LeHigh are the other three.
- MSU is 8-0 against the 13 teams that currently comprise the Mid-Eastern Atlantic Conference. The team the Bulldogs has played the most is Florida A&M (3-0), while the last MEAC foe MSU faced was North Carolina Central last year, a 71-48 victory.
- The last time MSU had two or more freshman start in a game was last year against Vanderbilt (2-16-16) — Quinndary Weatherspoon, Aric Holman and Malik Newman.
- Of the Bulldogs' roster, 12 have never seen action.
- After earning Freshman All-SEC honors last year, Quinndary Weatherspoon was tabbed firstteam All-SEC by the coaches and second-team by the league writers.
- I.J. Ready is 331 points shy of becoming the 37th player in MSU history to score 1,000 for a career. He also needs just 52 assists to move into the MSU all-time Top 10. In addition, he is 31 steals shy of moving in the MSU Top 10 record book.
- Last year's 2,323 points were the 9th-most in school history, while the 225 made 3-pointers with the 8th most. The Bulldogs also shot .725 from the charity stripe, the best since shooting .724 in
- In exhibition play last week, Mississippi State defeated Delta State 78-63 on Nov. 4 after leading by as many as 27 points. Freshman Mario Kegler paced MSU with 18 points, while Aric Holman added 15 to go along with his 10 rebounds.

Joining MSU next season are guards Nick Weatherspoon (Velma Jackson) of Canton, Miss., and KeyShawn Feazell (Lawrence County) of Monticello, Miss., and forward Garrison Brooks (Auburn High School) of Fayetteville, Ala.

Weatherspoon is the younger brother MSU sophomore standout Quinndary Weatherspoon, while Brooks is the son of MSU assistant coach, George Brooks.

Ben Howland 21th Season Overall | 2nd Season At Mississippi State 415-223 (14-17 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015, Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 415-223 record – Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (14-17).
- Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division

I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).

- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- This past year, Howland was inducted into both the Northern Arizona and Weber State hall of fames.
- Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children Meredith and Adam (Brittney) – and two grandsons, Benjamin Clark Howland II and Elijah Howland.
