- → The Bulldogs are looking to avoid their first 1-2 start since the 1977-78 season when Ron Greene was the coach. That year, MSU finished 18-9 overall and 13-5 in the SEC.
- → Rick Stansbury currently ranks 11th in the SEC with 273 wins, five behind Ray Mears (Tennessee) and Roy Skinner (Vanderbilt) for the 9th most.
- ✓ In the loss to Akron, MSU made just two 3-pointers. The last time MSU was limited to just two treys was in January of 2010 against Alabama.
- ✓ South Alabama is the first of five Sun Belt Conference teams Mississippi State will play
- → Rodney Hood is the true freshman to score in double-digits in his first two games wearing the Maroon & White since Mario Austin in 2000-01. Austin opened his career by scoring in double-digits in his first three games.
- → Dee Bost, who was tabbed preseason first-team All-SEC in the media and coaches polls, is now just 57 assists shy of breaking the school record of 514 held by Derrick Zimmerman (2000-03).
- → Renardo Sidney was named second-team All-SEC earlier this week by the coaches.
- ✓ Dee Bost scored 13 points against Akron to move into 25th place in the MSU record books with 1,156 points. He moved past Gary Hooker (1,144).
- ✓ South Alabama returns just one starter from last year's team that posted a 12-16 record, and that's 2011 Sun Belt Freshman of the Year, Augustine Rubit. Last year marked USA's first losing season since the 2005 campaign.
- Rick Stansbury has six victories against the Jaguars, the most against any non-conference team in his 14 years at the helm.

✓ In season openers, South Alabama is 29-14 all-time and has won six in a row.

To date, Bost rankes 10th all-time with 132 steals. To crack the Top 5, he needs 29 more to tie Timmy Bowers. Atop the record book is Ray White (1976-79) with 217. If Bost maintains his 2.5 average, he'll finish with 207 to rank second.

# BULLDOGS HAVE ENJOYED GREAT SUCCESS AGAINST SUN BELT FOES

**GAME 3: SOUTH ALABAMA** 

Mississippi State has experienced a wealth of great success against teams that currently comprise the Sun Belt Conference, as it holds a 62-14 advantage.

Saturday s matchup against South Alabama is the first of five Sun Belt foes for MSU this season, as it plays Florida Atlantic, Troy, North Texas and Louisiana-Monroe later in the season.

The team the Bulldogs have played the most is Louisiana Lafayette, winning 11 of the 15 outings.

Last year, Mississippi State went 1-1 against the league, defeating Troy before losing to Florida Atlantic.

### NOVEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 4-1 mark, coupled with this season's 1-1 ledger, the Bulldogs are 50-18 (.735) in the month of November since Rick Stansbury was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1986-87 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 76-21 (.784) in November.

### MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 8-6 mark in non-conference action, coupled with this year's 1-1 record, Mississippi State has compiled a 143-50 (.741) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 133-40 (.769) regular-season mark.

### MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 212-38 (1-0 this year) when leading at halftime; 154-37 (1-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 230-72 (1-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 212-81 (1-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 165-31 when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

### **BOMBS AWAY...AGAIN AND AGAIN**

In 2009-10, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers, an average of 8.2 an outing.

In 31 games last year, the Bulldogs were nearly on the same pace, having drained 246 of their 680 attempts for an 7.9 average.

Early this year, the Bulldogs are off that torrid pace somewhat, as they've drained just 10 in two games, including two on Wednesday against Akron in a 68-58 setback.

### 1,000 POINT CLUB WELCOMED NEWEST MEMBERS

On Feb. 9 against Arkansas at Humphrey Coliseum, junior guard **Dee Bost** became the 33rd MSU player to score 1,000 points for a career. He reached the milestone with 3:34 left in the first half on a 3-pointer that tied the game at 25-apiece.

Arnett Moultrie came to MSU after transferring from UTEP after scroing 650 points. After scoring 13 points against EKU on Monday and 8 against Akron on Wednesday, he is on pace to eclipse 1,000 points for his career this season.

### STANSBURY JOINS THE TWITTER WORLD

# MEET THE HEAD COACH



onsistency is a key ingredient to the recent success enjoyed by the Mississippi State University basketball program, one that is stressed in the players' daily activities on and off the basketball floor that has translated into the program's recent run of national prominence gained under head coach Rick Stansbury.

That consistency was brought to the forefront four years ago when MSU's 14th-year head basketball coach became the all-time winningest basketball coach in school history, surpassing Richard Williams' mark of 191. Now with a 14-year coaching record of 273-155 at the Bulldog helm, the 11th-most wins in SEC history, Stansbury has guided 10 State squads (6 NCAA & 4 NIT) to postseason tournament appearances and nine clubs to 20-plus wins campaigns.

MSU has averaged 21.3 wins the last six years (2006-11), including winning an outright SEC overall championship in 2004, along with back-to-back SEC West crowns in the 2003-2004 and 2007-2008 seasons an another in 2010, and SEC Tournament titles in 2002 and 2009.

Most recently, Stansbury piloted last year's 17-14 State squad to a second place finish in the Western Division, but missed out on a post-season berth for the first time in five seasons.

From 2001-05, he guided MSU to five-consecutive postseason tournament appearances for the first time in school history, including a streak of four straight NCAA Tournament berths from 2002 through 2005.

### MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. With the 12-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's 13 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 161-43 (.789) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 76-28 (.731) SEC mark and a 85-15 (.850) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 367-141 (.722) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.
