#### WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS AT FAU . . .

- ✓ Mississippi State and Florida Atlantic are meeting for the third time in as many years, all at Humphrey Coliseum.
- → The first two games in this series have been decided by a total of nine points.
- ✓ MSU is looking to avoid its first 0-2 start since 1967-68.
- ✓ Since 1930, the Bulldogs have started a season 0-2 just our times: 1945-46, 1950-51, 1965-
- ✓ Dating back to last season, MSU has now lost three-straight games, its longest streak since losing five straight and dropping out the Top 25 polls last February.
- → Rick Ray became the first coach since Joe Dan Gold in 1965 to lose in his debut (56-53 at Troy), a span of eight coaches.
- ✓ Against Troy, five MSU players saw their first collegiate action: Colin Borchert, Fred Thomas, Trivante Bloodman, Gavin Ware and Craig Sword.
- ▼ The Bulldogs' lineup at Troy featured three first-time starters: Colin Borchert, Fred Thomas and Trivante Bloodman
- ✓ Fred Thomas became just the fourth true freshman since 2005 to start on opening day, joining. Jamont Gordon in 2005, Dee Bost in 2008 and Rodney Hood in 2011.
- ✓ Due to injuries, MSU had just seven scholarship players available for the Troy game. Out for the year are freshmen DeAndre Applewhite (ACL) and Jacoby Davis (ACL), while sophomore Roquez Johnson missed the game at Troy due to a concussion suffered in practice.
- → MSU is 68-15 against Sun Belt Conference teams.

✓ Against Troy, senior forward Wendell Lewis fouled out for just the second time in his career.

#### **BULLDOGS ARE 68-15 AGAINST SUN BELT FOES**

Mississippi State has experienced a wealth of great success against teams that currently comprise the Sun Belt Conference, as it holds a 68-15 advantage.

Tuesday's matchup against Troy is the second of two Sun Belt foes for MSU this season, as Troy upended MSU on Friday in the season opener for both teams, 56-53.

The team the Bulldogs have played the most from the league is Louisiana Lafayette, with MSU winning 11 of the 15 outings.

Last year, Mississippi State went 5-0 against the league.

#### **NOVEMBER DOMINANCE LAST 25 YEARS**

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 78-22 (.780) in November

#### **SCOUTING FLORIDA ATLANTIC**

Florida Atlantic comes to Starkville following an 80-56 setback at No. 11 North Carolina on Sunday in the season opener for the Owls.

The Tar Heels led 32-24 at the break.

Florida Atlantic shot just 27.9 percent from the floor (17-61) and were out-rebounded 49-34. The Owls also committed 17 turnovers.

Guard Greg Gantt lead FAU with 18 points and was his team's only player in double digits. Center Dragan Sekelia and guard Pablo Bertone did have 9 points each, while forward Jordan McCoy hauled in 10 rebounds.

Defensively, Florida Atlantic held North Carolina to 43.7 percent shooting (31-71) from the floor and 40 percent beyond the arc (6-15).

The Owls were 9 of 29 from long range.

#### LAST TIME OUT FOR MSU . . .

Mississippi State rallied from a 16-point deficit to tie the game late at 53-apiece, but Troy claimed a 56-53 win thanks to a shot by Emil Jones with 1.6 seconds to play.

The Bulldogs jumped out to a 5-0 behind two baskets from Colin Borchert.

But with 12:38 left in the opening frame, a 3-pointer by Jeff Mullahey gave the Trojans a 10-8 advantage.

It was a lead they wouldn't relinquish until 1:08 left in the game when Jalen Steele tied the score with two free throws.

Steele led MSU with 16 points and seven rebounds, while Trivante Bloodman and Gavin Ware added 11 and 10 points, respectively. Ware also hauled in seven rebounds in his MSU debut.

#### BULLDOGS' DEFENSE ONE OF SEC BEST . . .

While opening day didn't provide Mississippi State with a victory, the Bulldogs' defense did prove to be one of the best in SEC play.

Of the 14 teams in the leauge, MSU yielded the third fewest points in Game 1 with its 56-53 setback at Troy.

Florida proved to be the stinglest, giving up just 35 to Alabama State in an 84-35 victory.

Auburn allowed the second fewest in its 61-50 win against IPFW.

#### **BULLDOGS OPENED** TROY'S NEW ARENA

■ Last Friday's matchup between Mississippi State and Troy marked the grand opening of Trojan Arena, Troy's new \$40 million basketball facility.

Historical matchups such as these are not uncommon for MSU.

While they weren't debuts, Mississippi State has been a part of two games that closed out arenas.

The first came in 1976, when the Bulldogs lost 94-93 in overtime to Kentucky in the final game at Memorial Coliseum in Lexington.

Then in 2002, MSU defeated South Carolina 64-47 in the final game at Carolina Coliseum.

## MSU TO MAKE FIRST APPEARANCE IN MAUI INVITIONAL LATER THIS MONTH

■ Thanksgiving week, Mississippi State will be in Hawaii participating in the prestigious Maui Invitational for the first time in school history.

The Bulldogs open play against national powerhouse North Carolina on Nov. 19 and will then play either Marquette or Butler on Nov. 20. They will also play a game on Nov. 21 to conclude action.

MSU last played in Hawaii in 2010, when it went 1-2 in the Diamondhead Classic. The Dawgs lost to Washington State and Hawaii and beat San Diego.

## STEELE EXTENDS FREE THROWS MADE STREAK TO 23 STRAIGHT

■ With his 4-of-4 performance at the free throw line at Troy, junior guard Jalen Steele has now made 23-straight free throws dating back to last season.

His last miss came with 5:13 to play against Northwestern State on Dec. 22, 2012, in Jackson.

## BULLDOGS 2012-13 ROSTER FEATURES A LOT OF NEW FACES

■ When the Bulldogs open the regular season on the road at Troy on Nov. 9, the roster will feature seven new players.

Only five players return from last year's squad that posted 21 wins, a total that includes walk-ons Baxter Price and Tyson Cunningham. The other three returnees are Wendell Lewis, Roquez Johnson and Jalen Steele.

Of the seven newcomers this season, five are freshmen.

## INCOMING FRESHMEN APPLEWHITE, DAVIS OUT FOR THE ENTIRE SEASON

■ Incoming freshman point guard Jacoby Davis and DeAndre Applewhite will miss the entire season after tearing their ACLs.

Applewhite's setback, which also includes a torn meniscus, happed this past Friday during practice, while Davis' injury occurred back in July

Davis was Rick Ray's first signee and he came to MSU after averaging 21 points and 5 assists at St. John's Military Academy in Wisconsin. Applewhite came to MSU following a stellar career at Central High School in Memphis.

#### **NBA DRAFT TAKES ARNETT MOULTRIE**

■ This past June, Arnett Moultrie became the second MSU player to be drafted in the NBA in the last three years.

Moultrie, an All-SEC standout who played at Mississippi State just one season after transferring from UTEP, was the 27th overall pick by the Miami Heat. However, moments after the selection, the Heat traded the Memphis native to Philadelphia.

Moultrie was the first MSU player taken in the first round since 1996, when Erick Dampier

(Indiana, 10th) and Dontae' Jones (New York, 21st) were both drafted.


- Give Rick Ray his first victory as a head coach.

#### **MSU COACH RICK RAY**

#### **Head Coach Rick Ray**

- On April 1, 2012, Rick Ray was named the 19th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- On the staff of three different teams that have advanced to the NCAA Tournament — Indiana State, Purdue and Clemson.



- As an assistant at Clemson for two years, the Tigers won 38 games and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2011.
- During his time at Purdue as an assistant, the Boilermakers won 103 games in four years.
- All four teams at Purdue earned a berth in the NCAA Tournament, with the last two advancing to the Sweet 16.
- The 2009 Purdue team won 28 games and the Big 10 Tournament en route to garnering a No. 5 seed.
- While at Purdue, Ray was an assistant with second-year Tennessee coach Cuonzo Martin.
- The 2007 Purdue recruiting was considered one of the tops in the country, earning national rankings of No. 5 and No. 6 by Scout and Rivals, respectively.
- Ray was an assistant at Indiana State for seven years.
- In 2000 and 2001, the Sycamores won 20plus games and made the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2000, the ISU won the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title with a 14-4 ledger.
- In 2001, Indiana State won the MVC Tournament before upsetting Oklahoma in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- ▶ Ray also spent two seasons at Northern Illinois (2005 and 2006).
- Ray's first coaching job was at Nebraska-Omaha.
- ▶ Ray and his wife, Breyana, have a son, Deacon and a daughter, Katriece.

Mississippi State ushered in the Rick Ray era with an 80-74 exhibition win against William Carey Sunday at the Humphrey Coliseum.

The Bulldogs never trailed in the game's final half but were not assured of victory against the NAIA Crusaders until Wendell Lewis sank six free throws in the final 2:05 of regulation time.

MSU placed four players in double figures. Jalen Steele led the way with 17 points, followed by 15 points apiece from Lewis, Fred Thomas and Colin Borchert. MSU played a total of nine players, with each logging a minimum of 11 minutes apiece.

Fresh off a season-opening victory over Blue Mountain College, the Crusaders scored the game's first six points. MSU battled back for a 7-6 lead on a jumper by Colin Borchert. Things stayed nip-and-tuck with Carey eventually sprinting out to an 18-11 advantage.

The Bulldogs would trail by as many as eight before a 14-6 run by MSU tied the game at 32. Fred Thomas scored back-to-back baskets, including a 3-pointer to knot the contest.

MSU shot 43.3 percent from the floor in the first half and eased out to a 41-36 advantage at halftime.

Ray continued to look at different rotations in the game's final half. The Maroon and White scored the second half's first five points to grab a 46-36 lead with 18:11 remaining.

Carey remained patient on offense and eventually fought its way back into the contest. The Crusaders closed within three at 54-51 and later forced a tie at 63. Steele quickly answered with a 3-point basket and the Bulldogs were not headed after that.

The Bulldogs trailed by as many as 16 points in the game's opening half. A gritty defensive effort allowed the short-handed squad to hang tough. MSU forced a tie at 53-all and actually had possession but could not get the go-ahead points in the final minute.

Alas, Emil Jones did convert with his jumper just inside the foul line with 1.6 seconds left in regulation.

The victory snapped MSU's nine-game win streak in the series and also ruined the debut of new MSU head coach Rick Ray.
