WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS KENNESAW STATE . . .

- → Mississippi State is 10-3 all-time against Atlantic Sun Conference foes.
- → The last time MSU played an Atlantic Sun team was in December of 2011, 63-62 setback to East Tennessee State.
- ✓ The Bulldogs are looking to start 2-0 for the first time since 2010-11 and the sixth time in the last 10 years.
- → Dating back to last season, MSU is looking to extend its home-winning streak to four games, which would be the longest under Rick Ray.
- ▼ The Owls are one of three first-time opponents for Mississippi State, joining Florida Gulf Coast and Maryland-Eastern Shore.
- ✓ In the season-opening win against Prairie View A&M, two players made their Maroon & White debuts — true freshman I.J. Ready and redshirt freshman Dre Applewhite.
- ✓ I.J. Ready finished with 14 points, the most by a true freshman in their first-career game since Barry Stewart poured in 14 points against Nicholls on Nov. 11, 2006, in a 90-55 win.
- ✓ Sophomore forward **Gavin Ware** recorded his third-career double-double with 15 points and 15 rebounds (Alabama A&M, Dec. 30, 2012; Central Arkansas, Dec. 22, 2012). The 15 boards were the most by an MSU player since Arnett Moultrie also had 15 vs. Akron on Nov. 9, 2012.
- ▼ The Bulldogs had 51 rebounds against the Panthers, the most under Rick Ray and the highest total since having 59 at Houston on Dec. 19, 2009.
- ✓ MSU's plus-24 rebounding margin was its highest since producing a plus-30 margin last year against Alcorn State.

BULLDOGS ARE 20-2 AGAINST THE ASC

Mississippi State is currently 10-3 against the 10 foes that comprise the Atlantic Sun Conference.

However, the Bulldogs have battled just four of the teams.

Mercer has been MSU's most common opponent, with the Bulldogs enjoying a 5-1 advantage.

State is 1-2 against East Tennessee State, 3-0 against Jacksonville and 1-0 versus Stetson.

NOVEMBER DOMINANCE LAST 26 YEARS

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 80-25 (.762) in November. Under Rick Ray, the Bulldogs are 3-4.

SCOUTING KENNESAW STATE

Kennesaw State enters the game sporting a 1-3 ledger following its 92-48 win against Warren Wilson.

On the year, Delbert Love leads the Owls with a 15.0 scoring clip, while Orlando Coleman is tops on the board at 7.0.

Against Warren Wilson, Coleman recorded a double-double with 26 points and 10 boards, while Niegel Pruitt added 23 points, 3 steals and 3 assists.

LAST TIME OUT FOR MSU . . .

Mississippi State led from start to finish as it opened its 2013-14 campaign with a 71-56 win against Prairie View A&M.

Sophomore forward Gavin Ware paced the Bulldogs with his third-career double-double, scoring 15 points and grabbing 15 rebounds.

Also in double-digits for MSU were I.J. Ready (14) and Roquez Johnson (11).

The Bulldogs won the battle of the boards 51-27, while forcing 19 turnovers and turning those miscues into 26 points.

MSU COACH RICK RAY

Diek Day Veer Dy Veer

Head Coach Rick Ray

- On April 1, 2012, Rick Ray was named the 19th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In his first season at MSU, produced two players to the SEC All-Freshman team Gavin Ware and Craig Sword



- On the staff of three different teams that have advanced to the NCAA Tournament — Indiana State, Purdue and Clemson.
- As an assistant at Clemson for two years, the Tigers won 38 games and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2011.
- During his time at Purdue as an assistant, the Boilermakers won 103 games in four years.
- All four teams at Purdue earned a berth in the NCAA Tournament, with the last two advancing to the Sweet 16.
- The 2009 Purdue team won 28 games and the Big 10 Tournament en route to garnering a No. 5 seed.
- While at Purdue, Ray was an assistant with second-year Tennessee coach Cuonzo Martin.
- The 2007 Purdue recruiting was considered one of the tops in the country, earning national rankings of No. 5 and No. 6 by Scout and Rivals, respectively.
- Ray was an assistant at Indiana State for seven years.
- In 2000 and 2001, the Sycamores won 20plus games and made the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2000, the ISU won the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title with a 14-4 ledger
- In 2001, Indiana State won the MVC Tournament before upsetting Oklahoma in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Ray also spent two seasons at Northern Illinois (2005 and 2006).
- Ray's first coaching job was at Nebraska-Omaha.
- Ray and his wife, Breyana, have two sons, Deacon and Mason, and one daughter, Katriece.





Colin Borchert scored 23 points and Gavin Ware posted a double-double as Mississippi State Auburn-Montgomery 86-57.

MSU scored the game's first five points and never trailed in the contest. The Bulldogs shot 51.7 percent from the floor and used its significant height advantage to post plus-11 rebounding advantage against the Division II Warhawks

In his MSU point guard debut, I.J. Ready had a solid start. In 22 minutes of play, Ready scored only two points but was credited with four assists and two steals, with only one turnover

For the contest, the Bulldogs shot better than 50 percent each half and hit 42.9 percent from 3-point range. Borchert led the offensive attack with an 8-for-9 night from the field and a 5-of-6 night from the free throw line.

Ware, a sophomore from Starkville, scored 10 points and collected a game-high 12 rebounds for the double-double.

The Bulldogs used defensive pressure to key a 12-2 run early. A free throw by Ware capped the run and pushed the MSU advantage to 21-10 with 8:49 left in the half. AUM hit a couple of 3-point baskets to fight back within 12.

Leading 33-19, MSU ended the half with an 11-3 run for a 44-22 halftime advantage.

The Bulldogs continued the strong offensive play to start the second half, as the lead was quickly pushed out to 56-24 at the first media timeout of the second half.

MSU held a 42-31 rebounding advantage.

Gavin Ware posted his third career double-double (15 points and 15 rebounds).

In his MSU debut, freshman guard I.J. Ready added 14 points, two assists and three steals in 30 minutes of work.

MSU shot 42.2 percent from the floor but was plagued by 21 turnovers. Despite the tighter restrictions on foul calling, the Bulldogs did well there, only being called for 19 personals.

Leading 62-55, the Bulldogs followed a timeout with three straight defensive turnovers and three baskets on the other end for a gameclinching 7-0 run.

MSU scored the game's first five points and held a sizeable lead throughout the contest. A layup by Johnson capped an 11-2 run and extended the lead to 18-9. Prairie View closed within five at 22-17 only to see more full-court pressure lead to a 7-1 run and a 29-18 lead for the Bulldogs.

That last spurt helped push MSU to a 38-28 lead at the intermission.

MSU extended the lead to 45-29 on an old-fashioned 3-point play by Ware. Still, the Panthers had a couple of strong offensive possessions where they beat the Bulldogs back down the court to stay in the contest.

A 3-point basket by Montrael Scott whittled the lead to 62-55 before the game-decisive run. That run included a layup by Trivante Bloodman, a 3-pointer by Ready and a layup by Colin Borchert.

MSU held a 51-27 rebounding advantage.
