WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS SOUTHERN . . .

- Gavin Ware (26) and I.J. Ready (25) had career highs against Eastern Washington. It was the first time since last February at Missouri that MSU had two players score 20-plus points in the same game Craig Sword and Roquez Johnson each had 22.
- The Bulldogs are 24-3 all-time against the 10 teams that currently comprise the SWAC.
- The Jaguars are one of two SWAC teams MSU has never faced, with Grambling being the other.
- The last SWAC team the Bulldogs faced was Jackson State in 2013-14, a 58-56 win in Starkville.
- MSU had five players against Eastern Washington make their Maroon & White debuts Carter Holmes, Jett Jobe, Reggie Patterson, Quinndary Weatherspoon and Johnny Zuppardo.
- Three players missed the opener with injuries Malik Newman (turf toe), Aric Holman (knee) and Joe Strugg (foot).
- After losing 13 games a year ago when trailing at the half, MSU rallied from a 51-48 deficit at the break to beat the Eagles.
- Also against the Eagles, MSU shot 62.1 percent (41-66) from the floor. It was the first time it shot 60 percent or better since hitting 60.4 percent (29-48) against Auburn on Feb. 4, 2012.
- Gavin Ware, who was tabbed SEC Player of the Week, now ranks 15th all-time with 667 rebounds
 and is 73 points shy of becoming the 35th player in school history to score 1,000 for a career.
- MSU scored 100 points in a season opener for the first time since opening the 1998-99 campaign with a 105-53 win against Arkansas-Pine Bluff.
- Only once last year did MSU overcome a double-digit deficit to post a win 12 vs. Vanderbilt.
- Against Eastern Washington, MSU had its first sellout since the Kentucky game on Feb. 21, 2012.



■ Last year, Craig Sword became the 34th player in school history to score 1,000 points for career.

He currently ranks 31st all-time with 1,098. He needs just 18 more points to tie W.D. "Red" Stroud for the 20th most in MSU history.

■ Mississippi State took advantage of the early signing period on Nov. 11 and signed five players — one 5-star and four 4-stars — to give MSU one of its best classes in school history.

5-star standout Mario Kegler, a Mississippi native and former Callaway teammate with Malik Newman, is in his final year at Oak Hill Academy in Virginia. He is joined by heralded 4-stars Tyson Carter (Starkville, Miss.), Lamar Peters (New Orleans), Eli Wright (Owensboro, Ky.) and Schnider Herard (Plano, Texas).

WARE CLOSING IN ON 1,000 POINTS

■ Currently, only four players in Mississippi State history have totaled 900 rebounds and 1,000 points.

However, senior forward Gavin Ware is on pace to join that group.

The four players who have achieved that feat are hall of famer Bailey Howell (2,030 pts, 1,277 rbs), Jarvis Varnado (1,403 pts, 1,096 rbs), Rickey Brown (1,838 pts, 1,092 rbs) and Wiley Peck (1,136 pts, 964 rbs).

Ware now has 927 points and 667 rebounds.

COACHING DEBUTS

■ Since 1948, Mississippi State has had 10 head coaches. Of the group, only five have had winning seasons in their first year at the helm.

And of that group, only one had 20 wins, and that was Rick Stansbury in 1999 when the Bulldogs posted a 20-13 ledger en route to advancing to the NIT, where they lost to Colorado State in the opening round, 69-56



Ben Howland 20th Season Overall 1st Season At Mississippi State 402-206 (1-0 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015, Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 402-206 record – Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (1-0).
- Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).
- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons.
- In 1997, the Lumberjacks had a school-record 21 victories, captured the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children Meredith and Adam (Brittney) and one grandson, Benjamin Clark Howland II.
