7 THINGS TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS TEXAS A&M

- ✓ Mississippi State is making its fourth trip to the "Big Apple" to play at famed Madison Square Garden. The Bulldogs are 2-2 at MSG, with their last appearance resulting in a 63-62 loss to West Virginia in the 2007 NIT semifinals. In MSU's first appearance at the Garden, the 22nd-ranked Bulldogs upended No. 11 Xavier, 76-71, on Dec. 14, 2002. In the 2004 Coaches vs. Cancer Classic, No. 12 MSU dropped a 71-58 affair to No. 5 Syracuse before knocking off St. Mary's 67-54 in the consolation game.
- ✓ **Rick Stansbury** currently ranks 11th in the SEC with 274 wins, five behind Ray Mears (Tennessee) and Roy Skinner (Vanderbilt) for the 9th most.
- ✓ Texas A&M is the first of two Big 12 teams Mississippi State will play this season. On Dec. 28 in Dallas, the Bulldogs battle Baylor at American Airlines Center.
- ✓ **Rodney Hood** is the first true freshman to score in double-digits in his first three games wearing the Maroon & White since Mario Austin in 2000-01. The last player to achieve the feat in four-straight games was Rickey Brown in 1976-77, when he opened his career scoring in double-digits 12-straight games.
- ✓ **Dee Bost**, who was tabbed preseason first-team All-SEC in the media and coaches polls, is now just 55 assists shy of breaking the school record of 514 held by Derrick Zimmerman (2000-03).
- ✓ **Dee Bost** scored 16 points against South Alabama to move into 24th place in the MSU record books with 1,172 points. He moved past Marckell Patterson (1,168).
- ✓ Texas A&M coach Billy Kennedy is certainly familiar with MSU. He's played the Bulldogs at three different schools (Southeastern Louisiana, Murray State and Centenary), and is 0-5 in those outings. In fact, his first game as a head coach was at Starkville when at Centenary. MSU won that game, 64-40.

- ◆ Mississippi State played its first in-season tournament at the Carrousel Classic in Charlotte, N.C., in 1955.
- Since then, the Bulldogs have won 17 titles and have posted an 84-73 record.
- Their last tournament crown was the 2000 Bank One Fiesta Bowl Classic, when they upset host Arizona 75-74 behind the play of Antonio Jackson, tournament MVP.

BULLDOGS HAVE FARED WELL AGAINST BIG 12 FOES

Mississippi State has enjoyed success against Big 12 foes over the years, posting a 15-11 record.

Thursday's matchup is the first of two Big 12 opponents for MSU this season, as the Bulldogs play Baylor in Dallas on Dec. 28.

The team the Bulldogs have played the most is Texas, with the Longhorns winning 4 of the 7 outings. The most wins for MSU is Baylor (5-0).

The last Big 12 team the Bulldogs faced was Texas Tech in the 2008 Legends Classic in Newark, N.J. The Red Raiders won that contest, 77-73.

Rick Stansbury-coached squads are 2-4 against Big 12 Teams — Missouri (1-1), Oklahoma (1-0), Texas Tech (0-1) and Texas (0-2).

NOVEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 4-1 mark, coupled with this season's 2-1 ledger, the Bulldogs are 51-18 (.739) in the month of November since Rick Stansbury was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1986-87 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 77-21 (.786) in November.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 8-6 mark in non-conference action, coupled with this year's 2-1 record, Mississippi State has compiled a 144-50 (.742) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 134-40 (.770) regular-season mark.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 213-38 (2-0 this year) when leading at halftime; 154-37 (1-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 230-72 (1-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 213-81 (2-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 166-31 (1-0) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

BOMBS AWAY . . . AGAIN AND AGAIN

In 2009-10, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers, an average of 8.2 an outing.

In 31 games last year, the Bulldogs were nearly on the same pace, having drained 246 of their 680 attempts for an 7.9 average.

Early this year, the Bulldogs are off that torrid pace somewhat, as they've drained 18 in three games, including eight on Saturday against South Alabama in an 80-65 victory.

BOST, MOULTRIE CLIMBING THE SCORING CHARTS

On Feb. 9, 2011, against Arkansas at Humphrey Coliseum, junior guard **Dee Bost** became the 33rd MSU player to score 1,000 points for a career. He reached the milestone with 3:34 left in the first half on a 3-pointer that tied the game at 25-apiece.

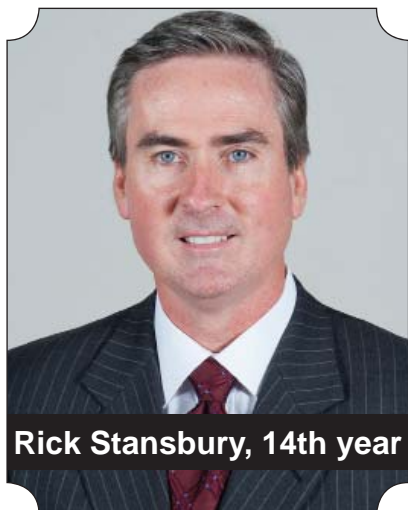
Arnett Moultrie came to MSU after transferring from UTEP, where he totaled 650 points his first two seasons. After scoring 49 points in his first three games, including a career-best 28 against South Alabama on Saturday, he is on pace to eclipse 1,000 points for his career this season.

TEXAS/MISSISSIPPI CONNECTIONS

Although Texas A&M has no one on their roster from the state of Mississippi, MSU has one player that hails from the Longstar State — junior walk-on Charles "Tex" Parker.

Junior guard Elston Turner has played against MSU, in the first round of the 2009 NCAA Tournament in Portland, Ore., when he was at Washington. Elston, whose father played at Ole Miss from 1978-81, had 7 points and 3 assists in 18 minutes of action.

MEET THE HEAD COACH



Rick Stansbury, 14th year

Consistency is a key ingredient to the recent success enjoyed by the Mississippi State University basketball program, one that is stressed in the players' daily activities on and off the basketball floor that has translated into the program's recent run of national prominence gained under head coach Rick Stansbury.

That consistency was brought to the forefront four years ago when MSU's 14th-year head basketball coach became the all-time winningest basketball coach in school history, surpassing Richard Williams' mark of 191. Now with a 14-year coaching record of 274-155 at the Bulldog helm, the 11th-most wins in SEC history, Stansbury has guided 10 State squads (6 NCAA & 4 NIT) to postseason tournament appearances and nine clubs to 20-plus wins campaigns.

MSU has averaged 21.3 wins the last six years (2006-11), including winning an outright SEC overall championship in 2004, along with back-to-back SEC West crowns in the 2003-2004 and 2007-2008 seasons and another in 2010, and SEC Tournament titles in 2002 and 2009.

Most recently, Stansbury piloted last year's 17-14 State squad to a second place finish in the Western Division, but missed out on a post-season berth for the first time in five seasons.

From 2001-05, he guided MSU to five-consecutive postseason tournament appearances for the first time in school history, including a streak of four straight NCAA Tournament berths from 2002 through 2005.

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. With the 12-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's 13 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 162-43 (.790) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 76-28 (.731) SEC mark and a 86-15 (.851) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 368-141 (.723) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

The Bulldogs failed to lead in the final 26 minutes of the contest. Thanks to the outside play of Quincy Diggs and inside play of 7-footer Zeke Marshall, the Zips had an answer for most of the night. Akron led 37-29 at halftime and lead by as many as 12 points in the final half of play.
