6 THINGS TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS ARIZONA

- ✓ In their fourth trip at Madison Square Garden, the Bulldogs are 3-2 all-time following Thursday's win against No. 18 Texas A&M. Prior to Thursday, the Bulldogs' last appearance at MSG resulted in a 63-62 loss to West Virginia in the 2007 NIT semifinals. In MSU's first appearance at the Garden, the 22nd-ranked Bulldogs upended No. 11 Xavier, 76-71, on Dec. 14, 2002. In the 2004 Coaches vs. Cancer Classic, No. 12 MSU dropped a 71-58 affair to No. 5 Syracuse before knocking off St. Mary's 67-54 in the consolation game.
- ✓ **Rick Stansbury** currently ranks 11th in the SEC with 275 wins, five behind Ray Mears (Tennessee) and Roy Skinner (Vanderbilt) for the 9th most.
- ✓ Texas A&M was the first ranked team MSU defeated since it beat No. 24 Florida last year at Humphrey Coliseum, 71-64. Under Rick Stansbury, the Bulldogs are now 21-50 against ranked teams, including a 9-12 mark on neutral courts. Against teams ranked No. 15, the Bulldogs are 1-3. The last time MSU defeated ranked teams two-straight times was in 2004 at No. 17 Florida (79-68) and at No. 22 South Carolina (79-75, OT).
- ✓ With his 10 points against the Aggies, **Rodney Hood** became the first true freshman to score in double-digits in his first four games wearing the Maroon & White since Rickey Brown in 1976-77, when he opened his career scoring in double-digits 12-straight games.
- ✓ **Dee Bost**, who was tabbed preseason first-team All-SEC in the media and coaches polls, is now just 53 assists shy of breaking the school record of 514 held by Derrick Zimmerman (2000-03).
- ✓ The last time MSU and Arizona met was in 2004 John Wooden Classic in Anaheim, Calif., with the Wildcats claiming a hard-fought 68-64 victory.

BULLDOGS ARE 7-11 AGAINST PACE-12 FOES

Mississippi State has posted an all-time record of 7-11 against current Pac-12 foes,

The team the Bulldogs have played the most is Arizona, with today's meeting marking the fourth outing.

The last Pac-12 team the Bulldogs faced was Washington State last year in the Diamondhead Classic in Honolulu, with WSU coming from behind in the second half to claim an 83-57 win. State's last win was against UCLA in the 2009 John Wooden Classic, 72-54.

Rick Stansbury-coached squads are 4-6 against Pac-12 teams — Arizona (1-1), California (0-1), Oregon (1-0), Stanford (1-1), Washington (0-1), Washington State (0-2) and UCLA (1-0).

NOVEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 4-1 mark, coupled with this season's 3-1 ledger, the Bulldogs are 52-18 (.743) in the month of November since Rick Stansbury was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1986-87 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 78-21 (.788) in November.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 8-6 mark in non-conference action, coupled with this year's 3-1 record, Mississippi State has compiled a 145-50 (.744) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 135-40 (.771) regular-season mark.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 214-38 (3-0 this year) when leading at halftime; 154-37 (1-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 231-72 (2-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 214-81 (3-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 167-31 (2-0) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

BOMBS AWAY . . . AGAIN AND AGAIN

In 2009-10, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers, an average of 8.2 an outing.

In 31 games last year, the Bulldogs were nearly on the same pace, having drained 246 of their 680 attempts for an 7.9 average.

Early this year, the Bulldogs are off that torrid pace somewhat, as they've drained 24 in four games, including six on Wednesday against No. 18 Texas A&M in a 69-60 victory.

BOST, MOULTRIE CLIMBING THE SCORING CHARTS

On Feb. 9, 2011, against Arkansas at Humphrey Coliseum, junior guard **Dee Bost** became the 33rd MSU player to score 1,000 points for a career. He reached the milestone with 3:34 left in the first half on a 3-pointer that tied the game at 25-apiece.

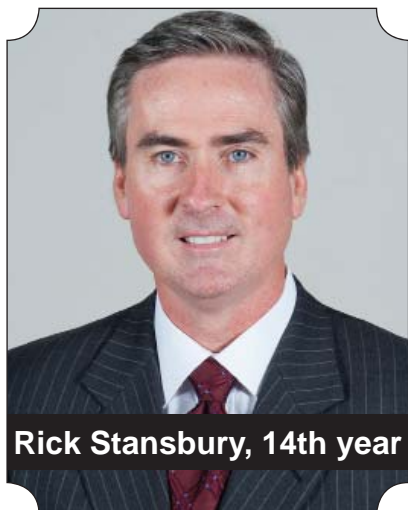
Arnett Moultrie came to MSU after transferring from UTEP, where he totaled 650 points his first two seasons. After scoring 57 points in his first four games, including a career-best 28 against South Alabama on Saturday, he is on pace to eclipse 1,000 points for his career this season.

BOST MOVING UP SCORING/STEALS RECORD BOOKS

Senior guard **Dee Bost** scored 20 points against Texas A&M on Thursday to give him 1,192 points for his career, leaving him 7 shy of tying Mario Austin (2001-03) for the 23rd most points at 1,192.

He also had a season-high 4 steals to give him 137 for his career, two shy of tying Terry Lewis (1980-83) for the 9th most in school history. He needs just 24 more to crack the Top 5. Timmy Bowers (2001-04) is No. 5 with 161 steals.

MEET THE HEAD COACH



Rick Stansbury, 14th year

Consistency is a key ingredient to the recent success enjoyed by the Mississippi State University basketball program, one that is stressed in the players' daily activities on and off the basketball floor that has translated into the program's recent run of national prominence gained under head coach Rick Stansbury.

That consistency was brought to the forefront four years ago when MSU's 14th-year head basketball coach became the all-time winningest basketball coach in school history, surpassing Richard Williams' mark of 191. Now with a 14-year coaching record of 275-155 at the Bulldog helm, the 11th-most wins in SEC history, Stansbury has guided 10 State squads (6 NCAA & 4 NIT) to postseason tournament appearances and nine clubs to 20-plus wins campaigns.

MSU has averaged 21.3 wins the last six years (2006-11), including winning an outright SEC overall championship in 2004, along with back-to-back SEC West crowns in the 2003-2004 and 2007-2008 seasons and another in 2010, and SEC Tournament titles in 2002 and 2009.

Most recently, Stansbury piloted last year's 17-14 State squad to a second place finish in the Western Division, but missed out on a post-season berth for the first time in five seasons.

From 2001-05, he guided MSU to five-consecutive postseason tournament appearances for the first time in school history, including a streak of four straight NCAA Tournament berths from 2002 through 2005.
