WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS BOISE STATE . . .

- Mississippi State is looking to avoid its second-straight 1-2 start.
- The Bulldogs are now 90-81 all-time in-season tournaments.
- Boise State is one of four teams on MSU's schedule the Bulldogs are facing for the first time. Norfolk State, Central Florida and LeHigh are the other three.
- MSU is 5-6 against the 11 teams that currently comprise the Mountain West Conference. The team the Bulldogs have played the most is Utah State (2-1). The Aggies are also the last MW team MSU faced, a 71-63 win in November of 2014.
- Thursday's 25-point loss to Central Florida was the second largest margin of defeat under Ben Howland. The largest is 26 to Miami last November in Puerto Rico.
- The Bulldogs are now 78-62 against American Athletic Conference foes.
- Sophomore guard Quinndary Weatherspoon has now scored in double-digits 22 times in his career, while junior guard I.J. Ready has 28 double-digit games to his credit.
- I.J. Ready is now 302 points shy of becoming the 37th player in MSU history to score 1,000 for a career. He also needs just 41 assists to move into the MSU all-time Top 10. In addition, he is 30 steals shy of moving in the MSU Top 10 record book.
- Freshman forward E.J. Datcher was impressive on the defensive end Thursday against the Knights with 3 blocked shots.
- In his first two games of the season, sophomore forward Aric Holman has collected 18 rebounds to go along with his 17 points.
- With his 19 points against Central Florida, Quinndary Weatherspoon eclipsed the 400 mark for his career. He has 412 points in 33 games.
- In this week's AP poll, Mississippi State received four votes.
- In his debut against Norfolk State, Tyson Carter scored 17 points, the most by a true freshman on opening day since Chancellor Nichols also had 17 against Christian Brothers on Nov. 28, 1987. Ray White owns the record of 34 against Indiana State on Dec. 1, 1975.



Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Last year, MSU was 10-5, including a 5-1 mark against non-conference foes. This year, MSU is 1-0.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 41-season composite record of 419-171 (.710) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

Ben Howland 21th Season Overall | 2nd Season At Mississippi State 416-224 (15-18 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015, Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 415-223 record – Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (15-18).
- Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division

I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).

- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- This past year, Howland was inducted into both the Northern Arizona and Weber State hall of fames.
- Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children Meredith and Adam (Brittney) – and two grandsons, Benjamin Clark Howland II and Elijah Howland.
