4-0 For A Fourth Time Under Stansbury?

After opening the season with three wins by an impressive average margin of 30.7 points, Mississippi State is going for its first 4-0 start against Fairleigh Dickinson since the 2003-04 campaign when it started 13-0 en route to winng the overall SEC regular-season title. Since Rick Stansbury took over in 1998-99, the Bulldogs have bolted out to a 4-0 start three times - 1998-99 (8-0); 2001-02 (11-0); and 2003-04 (13-0).

Mississippi State tipped off the opening round of the Legends Classic on Wednesday with a convincing 102-61 victory against North Alabama. Fairleigh Dickinson traveled out West and dropped a 55-33 decision at Washington State, the Bulldogs' opponent on Nov. 28. MSU, along with WSU, are two of the four teams guaranteed to advance to the championship rounds at the Prudential Center in Newark, N.J., joining Texas Tech and Pittsburgh.

In just three games this year, junior forward Jarvis Varnado has already swatted away 23 blocked shots, tops in both the Southeastern Conference and the nation. Wednesday against North Alabama, he totaled seven. The junior standout now has 247career blocked shots, two shy of Erick Dampier's school record of 249 he set from 1994-96. Varnado also finds himself tied for 11th in the SEC's record books with Georgia's Charles Claxton (1992-95).

HEY, DON'T FORGET ABOUT BAILEY, TOO

While Jarvis Varnado is garnering the national attention for his production, sophomore reserve Elgin Bailey has guietly totaled eight blocks and is tied for the 12th most in the country.

SPEAKING OF NATIONAL, SEC RANKINGS

With 21 assists, freshman Dee Bost is tops in the SEC and fifth nationally. From a freshman standpoints, he's tied for the second-most in the country with North Carolina-Ashville's J.P. Primm.

MSTATE 2-0 AGAINST NORTHEAST CONFERENCE FOES

Of the 11 teams that currently comprise the Northeast Conference, the Bulldogs own 2-0 record and have played just two of the league members.

The last time MSU played a Northeast Conference foe was in the opening round of the 2004 NCAA Tournament in Orlando when it claimed an 85-52 victory against Monmouth. In the 1992-93 season, the Bulldogs held off Long Island in the Amana-Hawkeye Classic in Iowa City, 61-52.

MSU AIMS FOR CONTINUED NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 11-7 ledger against non-conference foes, Mississippi State has now compiled a dominant 115-34 (.772) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 105-25 (.808) regular-season mark versus non-league foes.

NOVEMBER AND HOME DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 3-3 November record, the Bulldogs are 39-12 (.765) in the month of November since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach

Dating back to the 1986-87 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 62-15 (.805) in November.

And entering today's game against Fairleigh Dickinson, MSU has put together a 125-28 (.817) mark at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's guidance, including a 60-20 (.750) SEC record and 65-8 (.890) ledger at home against non-conference foes.

The Bulldogs currently own a seven-game winning streak at the Hump and have won 11 out of the last 12. MSU's last setback on its home floor came on Feb. 2, 2008, against Tennessee, 76-71. The Volunteers entered the game ranked No. 7 nationally and sporting an 18-2 record.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era of Mississippi State hoops, the Bulldogs are: 168-25 when leading at halftime (3-0 this year); 148-30 when shooting 45 percent or better from the field (3-0); 173-53 when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field (3-0); 176-66 when out-rebounding or tying the opponent (3-0); and 131-23 when holding the opponent to 65 points or less (3-0).

FRESHMAN ROMERO OSBY HAS NUMBER RETIRED

During his prep days at Northeast Lauderdale in Meridian, Miss., freshman forward **Romero Osby** played a major role in the Trojans' success. In early November, the school honored his accomplishments by retiring his No. 24 jersey.

It's only fitting considering he departed there with five major statistical records - points, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals.

He was also named first-team All-Division four times and first-team All-State on two occasions. He was also on the Mississippi Association of Coaches' North All-Star team in addition to representing his state in the Mississippi/Alabama All-Star game.

At Mississippi State, he wears the No. 5 jersey.

NOW THAT HAS A FAMILIAR RING

Last year, the Bulldogs led the Southeastern Conference in scoring defense (65.5), field goal percentage defense (.370), rebounding offense (40.7) and blocked shots (7.85).

Compared to their first two games this season, those same numbers were quite similiar. So far, MSU has yielded just 55.0 points on just 30.6 percent shooting from the floor, grabbed 49.0 rebounds and blocked a total of 40 shots. Jarvis Varnado, who led the nation a year ago with a school-record 157 blocks, has 23.

MISSISSIPPI-NEWJERSEY CONNECTIONS

Simply put, there are no connections. The closest MSU comes to any type of connection is Taylor Luczak, who is from Glens Falls, N.Y., 185 miles from Teaneck, N.J. The closest FDU comes is that assistant coach Ron Brown was once the head coach at Florida A&M (1993-96).

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07, the Bulldogs have posted a 30-6 mark for an .833 winning percentage. The Bulldogs have now reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's previous 10 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 125-28 (.817) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 60-20 (.750) SEC mark and a 65-8 (.890) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 32-season composite record of 331-126 (.724) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

EXHIBITION 1

MSU 88, Montevallo 59 Nov. 1, 2008 • Starkville, MS

In the season's first of two exhibition contests, Mississippi State rode a double-double performance from junior Jarvis Varnado to take care of visiting Montevallo 88-59 at Humphrey Coliseum.

Varnado, the reigning National Defensive Player of the Year, recorded 17 points on 7-of-9 shooting from the floor to go along with his game-high 12 rebounds. He also blocked eight shots after leading the nation in blocked shots a year ago with 157. Sophomore Ravern Johnson led all scorers on the night with an 8-of-14 performance from the field for a total of 19 points, while freshman Romero Osby pitched in the team's second double-double with 10 points and 11 boards. Dee Bost scored 13 points and handed out seven assists to just three turnovers in the win.

Junior guards Marcus Lancaster and Freddy Little led Montevallo in scoring with 10 points apiece on a collective 8-of-25 shooting performance, while junior forward Nate Flowers led the squad in rebounding with nine boards.

Ranking second nationally in team field-goal percentage defense last year, the Bulldogs followed suit by holding Montevallo to just 23-of-71 shooting from the floor for a 32.6% mark. Also specializing in blocks as a team by ranking second nationally in that category a year ago, MSU swatted 13 shots on the evening. Leading Montevallo in rebounding at halftime 32-21, State never let up and finished the game with a 62-37 advantage.

Junior Jarvis Varnado once again flirted with triple-double status in the contest by scoring 12 points, claiming a game-high 13 rebounds, and swatting eight shots after leading the nation in blocks a year ago. Varnado amassed 29 points, 25 rebounds and 16 blocks in State's two exhibition contests.

Senior Brian Johnson fell just a rebound shy of a double-double performance for the Bulldogs with 10 points on 5-of-7 shooting, while standout freshman Dee Bost tallied 11 points and six assists. Junior Barry Stewart and sophomore Ravern Johnson rounded out State scorers in double digits with 11 and 10 points, respectively.

Forward Jamarcus Ellis led the Stars with a game-high 26 points on 10-of-24 shooting along with five rebounds. Senior Sao Paulo, Brazil native Ricardo De Bem pitched in 11 points and seven rebounds while junior Davell Jackson also contributed 11 points.

Mississippi State's Ravern Johnson hit five 3-point baskets and scored a team-high 15 points as the Bulldogs defeated Centenary College 77-55 in a season-opening men's basketball game at Humphrey Coliseum.

The Bulldogs scored the game's first seven points and never trailed in the contest. MSU improved to 9-2 in season openers under Coach Rick Stansbury and 76-21 all-time.

MSU set the tone from 3-point range early. Dee Bost and Johnson hit back-to-back 3-pointers to help the Bulldogs spring from the gates. Those two treys would be the first of 10 for the hosts in the contest. The early lead stretched to double digits at 17-7 on a jumper from Riley Benock.

In the opening half, the Bulldogs used a five-on-five rotation as the search for consistency and set lineups will continue in non-conference play. Freshman Romero Osby finished with 15 points, while Dee Bost tallied 10 assists.

Following suit, the Dawgs put up an outstanding number on the boards, outrebounding UNA, 51-27.


