### 10 THINGS TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS LOUISIANA-MONROE

- ✓ Mississippi State has won the last eight meetings against the Warhawks.
- ✓ **Rick Stansbury** currently ranks 11th in the SEC with 276 wins, four behind Ray Mears (Tennessee) and Roy Skinner (Vanderbilt) for the 9th most.
- ✓ The wins against No. 19 Texas A&M and No. 15 Arizona marked the first time since 2004 MSU won back-to-back games against ranked foes. That year, the Bulldogs won at No. 17 Florida (79-68) and at No. 22 South Carolina (79-75, OT).
- ✓ **Rick Stansbury**-coached teams are now 22-50 against ranked teams.
- ✓ **Rodney Hood** opened his promising MSU career by scoring in double-digits his first four games. The streak ended against Arizona when he totaled just 9 points. He was the first true freshman to score in double-digits his first four games since Rickey Brown in 1976-77, when he opened his career scoring in double-digits 12-straight games.
- ✓ **Dee Bost**, who was tabbed preseason first-team All-SEC in the media and coaches polls, is now just 47 assists shy of breaking the school record of 514 held by Derrick Zimmerman (2000-03).
- ✓ **Arnett Moultrie** now has a team-best three double-doubles on the year following the Arizona game, where he was named tournament MVP after scoring 19 points and grabbing 10 rebounds.
- ✓ The Bulldogs have out-rebounded their opponents in all five games this year and have a rebounding margin of +7.4. Last year in 31 games, MSU won the battle of the boards 16 times and had rebounding margin of -2.4.
- ✓ MSU is looking to start a season 5-1 for the first time since the 2008-09 season.
- ✓ ULM coach Keith Richard is 0-2 against MSU, with both setbacks coming when he was at Louisiana Tech.

#### BULLDOGS RETURN FROM NEW YORK WITH 18TH IN-SEASON TOURNAMENT TITLE

- ◆ Mississippi State knocked off No. 19 Texas A&M and No. 15 Arizona in back-to-back nights last week to win the 2011 2K Sports Classic, benefitting Coaches vs. Cancer.
- It was the 18th in-season tournament title the Bulldogs have won, while improving their record to 86-73 following Friday's 67-57 win against Arizona. It was MSU's first tournament crown since the 2000 Bank One Fiesta Bowl Classic.

**BULLDOGS ARE 64-14 AGAINST SUN BELT FOES**

Mississippi State has experienced a wealth of great success against teams that currently comprise the Sun Belt Conference, as it holds a 64-14 advantage.

Monday's matchup against ULM is the second of five Sun Belt foes for MSU this season, as it plays Florida Atlantic, Troy and North Texas. Earlier this month, Mississippi State defeated South Alabama, 80-65.

The team the Bulldogs have played the most is Louisiana Lafayette, winning 11 of the 15 outings.

Last year, Mississippi State went 1-1 against the league, defeating Troy before losing to Florida Atlantic.

**NOVEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY**

Including last year's 4-1 mark, coupled with this season's 4-1 ledger, the Bulldogs are 53-18 (.746) in the month of November since Rick Stansbury was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1986-87 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 79-21 (.790) in November.

**MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS**

Including last year's 8-6 mark in non-conference action, coupled with this year's 4-1 record, Mississippi State has compiled a 146-50 (.745) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 136-40 (.773) regular-season mark.

**MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .**

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 215-38 (4-0 this year) when leading at halftime; 155-37 (2-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 232-72 (3-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 215-81 (4-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 168-31 (3-0) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

**BOMBS AWAY . . . AGAIN AND AGAIN**

In 2009-10, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers, an average of 8.2 an outing.

In 31 games last year, the Bulldogs were nearly on the same pace, having drained 246 of their 680 attempts for an 7.9 average.

Early this year, the Bulldogs are off that torrid pace somewhat, as they've drained 28 in five games, including four on Friday against No. 15 Arizona in a 67-57 victory.

**SCOUTING LOUISIANA-MONROE**

Monday marks the 15th meeting between the Bulldogs and Warhawks, with MSU winning the last eight by a margin of 16.4 points. The last three, though, have been by an average of 30 points.

The Warhawks' last victory in this series came on Dec. 5, 1977, at the Hump when they won 89-78. They were known as Northeast Louisiana then.

This year, ULM is 0-4 after losing on a last-second shot at Southeastern La., 63-60, on Saturday. MSU is also the third SEC team the Warhawks have played. They opened the season at Ole Miss (60-38) and last week dropped an 85-62 decision at Tennessee.

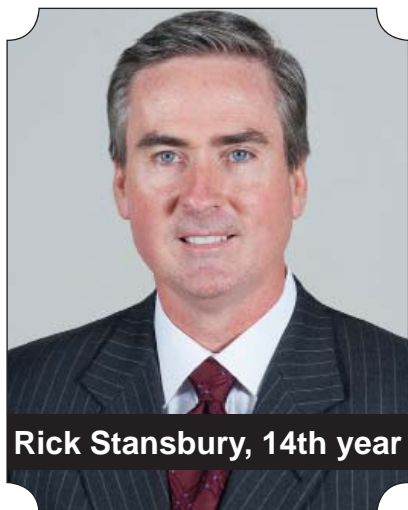
**LAST TIME OUT FOR MSU . . .**

Arnett Moultrie had 19 points and 11 rebounds as MSU upset No. 15 Arizona 67-57 at Madison Square Garden to win the 2011 2K Sports Classic on Friday night in New York.

The Bulldogs led from start-to-finish en route to evening the series against the Wildcats, 2-2.

The win also gave MSU a 4-2 ledger at Madison Square Garden.

# MEET THE HEAD COACH



**Rick Stansbury, 14th year**

Consistency is a key ingredient to the recent success enjoyed by the Mississippi State University basketball program, one that is stressed in the players' daily activities on and off the basketball floor that has translated into the program's recent run of national prominence gained under head coach Rick Stansbury.

That consistency was brought to the forefront four years ago when MSU's 14th-year head basketball coach became the all-time winningest basketball coach in school history, surpassing Richard Williams' mark of 191. Now with a 14-year coaching record of 276-155 at the Bulldog helm, the 11th-most wins in SEC history, Stansbury has guided 10 State squads (6 NCAA & 4 NIT) to postseason tournament appearances and nine clubs to 20-plus wins campaigns.

MSU has averaged 21.3 wins the last six years (2006-11), including winning an outright SEC overall championship in 2004, along with back-to-back SEC West crowns in the 2003-2004 and 2007-2008 seasons and another in 2010, and SEC Tournament titles in 2002 and 2009.

Most recently, Stansbury piloted last year's 17-14 State squad to a second place finish in the Western Division, but missed out on a post-season berth for the first time in five seasons.

From 2001-05, he guided MSU to five-consecutive postseason tournament appearances for the first time in school history, including a streak of four straight NCAA Tournament berths from 2002 through 2005.

**MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'**

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. With the 12-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's 13 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 162-43 (.790) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 76-28 (.731) SEC mark and a 86-15 (.851) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 368-141 (.723) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

## BOST, MOULTRIE CLIMBING THE SCORING CHARTS

On Feb. 9, 2011, against Arkansas at Humphrey Coliseum, junior guard **Dee Bost** became the 33rd MSU player to score 1,000 points for a career. He reached the milestone with 3:34 left in the first half on a 3-pointer that tied the game at 25-apiece.

**Arnett Moultrie** came to MSU after transferring from UTEP, where he totaled 650 points his first two seasons. After scoring 76 points in his first five games, including a career-best 28 against South Alabama on Nov. 12, he is on pace to eclipse 1,000 points for his career this season.

## BOST MOVING UP SCORING/STEALS RECORD BOOKS

Senior guard **Dee Bost** scored 8 points against Arizona on Friday to give him 1,200 points for his career, as he moved past Mario Austin (1,199) for the 23rd most in school history.

He also had 1 steal to give him 138 for his career, one shy of tying Terry Lewis (1980-83) for the 9th most in school history. He needs just 23 more to crack the Top 5. Timmy Bowers (2001-04) is No. 5 with 161 steals.

## BULLDOGS IN ELITE COMPANY

Mississippi State is one of only two SEC schools to post winning conference records in each of the last three seasons. In the "Super 6" conferences, the Bulldogs find themselves in elite company, as only 18 of the 73 teams who have competed in those leagues the last three years have accomplished the feat.
