WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS LEHIGH . . .

- Sophomore All-SEC quard Quinndary Weatherspoon's season has ended due to a possible tear of the scapholunate ligament in his right wrist. Through four games, he led MSU and was fourth in the SEC with his 18.8 scoring clip.
- In the Charleston Classic, the Bulldogs won two in-season tournament games for the first time since winning the 2011 2K Sports Classic. Quinndary Weatherspoon was also named to the All-Tournament team.
- Lehigh is one of five teams on MSU's schedule the Bulldogs are facing for the first time. Boise State, Norfolk State, Central Florida and UTEP are the other four. MSU posted a 3-1 mark against
- MSU is 2-0 against the 10 teams that currently comprise the Patriot League. In 2005-06, the Bulldogs defeated Holy Cross 76-75 in the San Juan Shootout, while in 1994-95 they defeated Colgate 80-76 in the Missoulian/Coca Cola Classic.
- Against UTEP on Sunday, Mississippi State committed just 8 turnovers, its fewest since also having 8 last February at home against Vanderbilt.
- Also against UTEP, both Aric Holman and Lamar Peters had careers with 18 and 13 points, respectively.
- •I.J. Ready is now 283 points shy of becoming the 37th player in MSU history to score 1,000 for a career. He also needs just 32 assists to move into the MSU all-time Top 10. In addition, he is 26 steals shy of moving in the MSU Top 10 record book.
- According to KenPom.com, Mississippi State is the second-least experienced team (.74) out of all 351 Division I programs. The least experienced squad is North Dakota State.
- Through the first four games, the Bulldogs have used the same starting lineup.
- MSU has been tied at the half twice this year after being tied none a year ago.
- Of current SEC players, I.J. Ready is 10th with 717 points, third with 13 steals and fourth with 294 assists.



LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

■ In the season-opener against Norfolk State, freshman guard Tyson Carter drew the start.

28 years ago, his father, Greg, drew a start on opening day against Christian Brothers as a fresman.

While Tyson poured in 17 points on 6-of-8 shooting with five made 3-pointers, Greg was 5-6 with 10 points.

Tyson's 17 points were the most by a freshman on opening day since that same game his father played, when Chancellor Nichols also totaled 17.

HOWLAND LOOKING TO JOIN ELITE CLUB

■ Ben Howland enters his second season at Mississippi State looking to achieve a feat only 12 coaches have ever done, and that's lead four different teams to the NCAA Tournament.

Howland has already guided Northern Arizona, Pittsburgh and UCLA to the Big Dance.

A CLOSER LOOK AT MSU

WEATHERSPOON REACHES 400

■ In the loss to Central Florida on Nov. 17, Quinndary Weatherspoon scored 19 points to give him 400 for his career.

Through his first 34 games, he now has 437 points.

FRESHMAN SCORING

■ Tyson Carter is averaging 12.3 points, the most for a freshman since Jamont Gordon averaged 13.8 in 2005-06.

Right now, that would rank sixth best all-time. Rickey Brown's average of 19.3 in 1977 is the freshman record.

BULLDOGS SIGN 3

Weatherspoon is the younger brother MSU sophomore standout **Quinndary Weatherspoon**, while Brooks is the son of MSU assistant coach, **George Brooks**.

BROOKS NOTED FOR RECRUITING

■ In this year's Sporting News preseason basketball publication, MSU assistant **George Brooks** was named the second best recruiting in the SEC.

Brooks, a 1996 MSU graudate, has been an assistant with the Bulldogs for seven years after serving as head coach at Meridian Community

He's been responsible for signing top talent such as **Quinndary Weatherspoon**, **Mario Kegler** and Garrison Brooks.

MSU IN ITALY

■ This past August, Mississippi State spent two weeks traveling across Italy playing games.

Quinndary Weatherspoon averaged a team-high 23.3 points, followed by Tyson Carter at 20.5 and Eli Wright at 15.3.

Aric Holman was the top rebounder at 7.8 boards.

Ben Howland 21th Season Overall | 2nd Season At Mississippi State 418-224 (16-18 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015, Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 418-224 record – Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (17-18).
- Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division

I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).

- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- This past year, Howland was inducted into both the Northern Arizona and Weber State hall of fames.
- Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children Meredith and Adam (Brittney) – and two grandsons, Benjamin Clark Howland II and Elijah Howland.
