MISSISSIPPI STATE LOOKING FOR 18TH TITLE

Mississippi State enters the South Padre Island Invitational sporting an all-time record of 82-70 in regular-season tournament play. The Bulldogs have also won 17 titles, the last coming at the 2000 Bank One Fiesta Bowl Classic.

Last year, MSU participated in the Legends Classic in Newark, N.J., and lost to Washington State (63-52) and Texas Tech (77-73).

Friday also marks the second time the Bulldogs and Spiders have met in tournament play. In the 2001 Las Vegas Classic, Mississippi State claimed a thrilling 74-72 win.

A LOOK AHEAD TO MISSOURI/OLD DOMINION

On Saturday, the Bulldogs will play either Missouri or Old Dominion in the finals or consolation outing. MSU has battled Missouri three times, with the Tigers holding a 2-1 advantage. The two last met on Dec. 30, 2007, in Starkville, with MSU claiming an 87-75 victory.

Mississippi State and the Monarchs have split their four games, with MSU winning the last time out, 62-57 in Norfolk, Va., on Dec. 18, 1997. They've met twice in tournament play, with ODU staking an 82-78 win in the 1976 Old Dominion Classic and a 72-71 OT victory at the 1996 Puerto Rico Holiday Classic in San Juan.

VARNADO'S COUNTDOWN TO HISTORY

Following his eight-block performance against Texas-Pan American on Tuesday night, senior forward **Jarvis Varnado** now has a nation-best 27 for the year and 421 for his career.

As a result, the Brownsville, Tenn., native is now just 114 shy of tying the NCAA mark of 535 held by former Louisiana-Monroe standout Wojciech Mydra (1998-2002).

Varnado, who has led the nation the past two years in this category, is currently 16th all-time, one behind Duke's Shelden Williams.

To get the record by the end of the regular season, Varnado needs to average 4.2 blocks in the next 27 games.

MSTATE 15-8 AGAINST ATLANTIC-10 FOES

Entering Friday's showdown against Richmond, the Bulldogs are 15-8 against the 14 teams that currently comprise the Atlantic-10 Conference.

The only league foes MSU hasn't faced are Duquense, La Salle, Temple, Massachusetts and Fordham.

Last year, the Bulldogs played against two Altantic-10 members, beating St. Bonaventure 76-71 and losing to Charlotte 70-64.

The most common team out of the Atlantic-10 MSU has faced is Xavier. The Bulldogs are 4-1 against the Musketeers, and the two last met on Dec. 18, 2004, when MSU claimed an 80-74 win in Cincinnati.

On Dec. 5, MSU plays another Atlantic-10 foe, St. Bonaventure.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 10-6 ledger against non-conference foes coupled with this year's 3-1 mark, MSU has compiled a dominant 124-40 (.756) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 116-31 (.789) regular-season mark versus non-league foes.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 185-27 when leading at halftime (3-0 this year); 164-32 (2-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 193-61 (3-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 187-68 (3-0) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 142-25 (2-0) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

NOVEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 5-2 mark coupled with this year's 3-1 record, the Bulldogs are 44-15 (.746) in the month of November since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1986-87 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 67-18 (.788) in November.

DEFENSE STARTING TO GET QUITE STINGY

After Rider torched the Bulldogs in the season opener by hitting 50.8 percent (30 of 59) of its shots overall, including a sizzling 62.5 percent (10 of 16) from 3-point range, MSU's defense has rebounded nicely.

In the last three games against Southeastern Louisiana, Bethune-Cookman and Texas-Pan American, the Bulldogs have limited their opponents to 34.4 percent (63 of 183) shooting overall and 35.8 percent (19 of 53) accuracy beyond the arc, while giving up an average of 56 points.

MOVING ON UP THE SCORING CHARTS

After scoring 20-plus points in back-to-back games to open the year, including a 22-point effort against Rider, and 12 against Texas-Pan American, **Jarvis Varnado** is now 29 points shy of becoming the 31st MSU player to score 1,000 or more for a career as he now has 971.

Also moving up the record book is senior guard **Barry Stewart**. With his 12 points against the Broncs, he now has 1,220 for his career, the 18th most in school history and 11 behind Erick Dampier for the 17th most.

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 42-12 mark for an .778 winning percentage. With a 13-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's first 11 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 138-34 (.802) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 65-23 (.739) SEC mark and a 73-11 (.869) record against non-conference opponents.

He was also selected to play in the Georgia North-South All-Star Game.


"He is the complete package of talent, athleticism, character and work ethic." 13th-year Raiders coach Bruce Stewart said. "He is a winner."


