#### WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS ALCORN STATE . . .

- ✓ Mississippi State and Alcorn State are meeting for the fifth time overall, with the series tied at 2-apiece. ASU won the first meeting, 80-78 in Starkville. The two last met in 1991, with the Bulldogs claiming a 120-65 win. The 120 points scored ranks as the fourth-most in school history and the third-highest in Humphrey Coliseum history.
- ✓ MSU is 20-2 against SWAC foes.
- ▼ The Bulldogs returned from Maui 0-3 with losses to North Carolina, Marquette and Texas.
- ✓ In Maui, MSU lost to North Carolina by 46 points (95-49) and then to Marquette by 27 (89-62). The last time the Bulldogs had lost two-straight games by 25-plus points was in December of 2010 — 31 to Virginia Tech (88-57) and 26 to Washington State (83-57).
- ✓ Mississippi State is looking to avoid its first 1-5 start since opening the 1950-51 campaign 1-6.
- ✓ Senior forward Wendell Lewis entered the season having made just 32 of his 70 free throw attempts (45.7 percent). This year, he's a perfect 7 of 7.
- ✓ Walk-on Tyson Cunningham played a total of 14 minutes last season. This year, he's already logged 118 minutes.
- ✓ Last season, Roquez Johnson played a total of 45 minutes and scored 1 point. In four games this year (missed the season opener at Troy due to a concussion), he's totaled 63 points in 116 minutes. He's also scored in double-digits all four games.
- ✓ MSU is back to seven scholarship players and two walk-ons with the return of junior forward. Colin Borchert, who was suspended for the Maui Invitational.
- ▼ Due to injuries, MSU has lost freshmen DeAndre Applewhite (ACL) and Jacoby Davis (ACL) for the year, while junior Jalen Steele is out 6-8 weeks with a fractured wrist.

#### **BULLDOGS ARE 20-2 AGAINST THE SWAC**

Entering Tuesday's showdown against Alcorn State, the Bulldogs are a dominant 20-2 against the 10 teams that currently comprise the Southwestern Athletic Conference.

**GAME 6: ALCORN STATE** 

Mississippi State has played every league foe except Grambling and Southern.

The most common teams MSU has played are Jackson State (4-0), Alabama A&M (4-0) and Alcorn State (2-2).

The last SWAC team MSU faced was Alabama State in December of 2010, a game the Bulldogs won, 67-46.

The Braves are the first of two SWAC teams MSU faces this year as Alabama A&M visits Humphrey Coliseum on Dec. 30 in a game televised by CSS.

#### **NOVEMBER DOMINANCE LAST 25 YEARS**

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 79-25 (.760) in November.

### **SCOUTING ALCORN STATE**

Alcorn State comes to Starkville after claiming a 69-65 overtime win against Samford last Thursday to improve to 2-4 on the season.

Down 32-28 at the break, the Braves rallied to in the second half to force overtime.

ASU hit 24 of its 56 shots from the floor and were 7 of 19 from 3-point

Defensively, the Braves held the Bulldogs to 37.3 percent shooting (22-59), while forcing 14 turnovers and being credited with 9 steals.

LeAntwan Luckett led Alcorn State with 24 points on 8-of-20 shooting, while Anthony Evens totaled 17 points to round out the double-digit scor-

On the boards, Josh Nicholas grabbed a team-high 10 rebounds and was just one point shy of a double-double.

### LAST TIME OUT FOR MSU . . .

Mississippi State concluded play at the Maui Invitational with a 69-55 setback to Texas.

Playing its third game in as many days, the Bulldogs hit just 17 of its 51 shots, but were 4 of 11 beyond the arc.

Defensively, MSU forced a season-high 22 turnovers and collected 12 steals, six by Roquez Johnson.

Johnson was just as effective on the offensive end, scoring a team-high 18 points on 7-of-12 shooting while hauling in 16 rebounds. He also had one blocked shot.

Also in double figures was Fred Thomas with 10 points.

On the boards, Gavin Ware paced the Bulldogs with 7 rebounds.

### **MSU-ASU SERIES HISTORY**

Despite being in the same state, Mississippi State and Alcorn State are meeting for just the fifth time.

And the two haven't played since December of 1990 when the Bulldogs claimed a 120-65 win at Humphrey Coliseum. That output was the fourth most in school history and the third highest in Humphrey Coliseum his-

The two first met in the 1978 NIT, with the Braves upsetting MSU at the Hump, 80-78.

The Bulldogs' first win in the series came the following year at the Babe McCarthy Tip-Off Tournament in Biloxi, with Mississippi State claiming a 83-80 victory. Later that same season, however, Alcorn State won 82-75 at the Senior Bowl Tournament in Mobile.



#### **Bulldogs Land Four Standouts In Early Signing Period**

STARKVILLE, Miss. - First year Mississippi State coach Rick Ray took advantage of the early signing period and landed four outstanding players who are expected to contribute immediately next season — Imara "I.J." Ready, Travis Daniels, Fallou Ndoye and Quantel Denson

Ready is a 5-foot-11 guard out of Little Rock whose high school coach Al Flanigan is the father of MSU assistant Wes Flanigan. Denson, a native of Grandview. Mo., is currently a power forward at Mineral Area Community College, while Daniels is a forward at Shelton State. Ndoye, a native of Senegal, is a 6-11 forward currently at Findley College Prep School in Las Vegas.

"First of all, I want to commend my staff for putting together a terrific recruiting class," Ray said. "Wes, George (Brooks), and Chris (Hollender) all played significant roles in us recruiting and landing these outstanding studentathletes. It is rare in this business that you identify your top targets and are able to recruit and sign those same top targets, and my staff was successful in getting it done.

#### IMARA READY

Ready has led Parkview Magnet High School to back-to-back Arkansas 6A State Championship titles the last two years. In the 2012 title game, he paced Parkview with 21 points, five assists and four steals in a 69-65 doubleovertime victory.

As a junior, Ready averaged 20.1 points, 5.2 assists and four steals. A year earlier, Ready registered 17 points, seven assists and five rebounds a contest as a sophomore.

During the summer of 2012, Ready played for coach Billy Ingram's Arkansas Hawks AAU program. The Hawks claimed runner-up honors at the prestigious Adidas Fab 48 in Las Vegas. while Ready averaged 25 points and seven assists during the summer.

Ready also held offers from Alabama, Nebraska, Oregon, Texas Tech and Arkansas-Little Rock.

"He's just a flat out winner," Ray said. "I.J. has a competitive fire and spirit that will really help our team next year and for years to come. I am excited about the talent and intangibles he will provide for us. Our team will love playing with him because he is a consummate play maker.

The Russellville, Ala., native selected the Bulldogs over Southern Miss, Western Kentucky and Wichita State.

"Travis is a young man that can dribble, pass, and shoot," Ray said. "It ... seems simple but not many players at . his size can do all three equally well. . He is a jack of all trades that can play . multiple positions and affect the game • in many ways."

#### QUANTEL DENSON

Denson, a 6-foot-9 forward, spent his freshman year at Hutchinson Community College in Kan., before transferring to Mineral Area Community College in Park Hills, Mo., this past year.

Already this year he's hit two gamewinning shots for the Cardinals.

"This kid can really shoot the three well and knows how to handle the ball," Tate said.

Prior to his college journey, Denson was ranked fourth in the state as a senior at Grandview High School. The standout averaged 14.4 points and 9.5 rebounds per game during his last year . for the Bulldogs, tallying 316 points.

"Quantel is a rare talent because . of his versatility, skill and length," Ray . said. "He can do a lot of different things • on the court that will help your team . win. He is a match-up problem for the • opposing team because of his unique

#### Fallou Ndoye

Ndoye is in his first year at Findley after spending last season at Faith Baptist in Brandon, Fla.

Through the first seven games, he's averaged 7 points and 7 rebounds for a team that uses an 11-man rotation.

"Fallou was our No. 1 target in filling our frontcourt needs," Ray said. "He has a long, big, active body that will continue to get better because he . plays and works hard"

### **MSU COACH RICK RAY**

#### **Head Coach Rick Ray**

- On April 1, 2012, Rick Ray was named the 19th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- On the staff of three different teams that have advanced to the NCAA Tournament — Indiana State, Purdue and Clemson.



- As an assistant at Clemson for two years, the Tigers won 38 games and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2011.
- During his time at Purdue as an assistant, the Boilermakers won 103 games in four years.
- All four teams at Purdue earned a berth in the NCAA Tournament, with the last two advancing to the Sweet 16.

- In 2001, Indiana State won the MVC Tournament before upsetting Oklahoma in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- ▶ Ray also spent two seasons at Northern Illinois (2005 and 2006).
- Ray's first coaching job was at Nebraska-Omaha.
- Ray and his wife, Breyana, have a son, Deacon and a daughter, Katriece.

Mississippi State ushered in the Rick Ray era with an 80-74 exhibition win against William Carev Sunday at the Humphrey Coliseum.

The Bulldogs never trailed in the game's final half but were not assured of victory against the NAIA Crusaders until Wendell Lewis sank six free throws in the final 2:05 of regulation time.

MSU placed four players in double figures. Jalen Steele led the way with 17 points, followed by 15 points apiece from Lewis, Fred Thomas and Colin Borchert. MSU played a total of nine players, with each logging a minimum of 11 minutes apiece.

Fresh off a season-opening victory over Blue Mountain College, the Crusaders scored the game's first six points. MSU battled back for a 7-6 lead on a jumper by Colin Borchert. Things stayed nip-and-tuck with Carey eventually sprinting out to an 18-11 advantage.

The Bulldogs would trail by as many as eight before a 14-6 run by MSU tied the game at 32. Fred Thomas scored back-to-back baskets, including a 3-pointer to knot the contest.

MSU shot 43.3 percent from the floor in the first half and eased out to a 41-36 advantage at halftime

Ray continued to look at different rotations in the game's final half. The Maroon and White scored the second half's first five points to grab a 46-36 lead with 18:11 remaining.

Carey remained patient on offense and eventually fought its way back into the contest. The Crusaders closed within three at 54-51 and later forced a tie at 63. Steele guickly answered with a 3-point basket and the Bulldogs were not headed after that.
