WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS ST. LOUIS . . .

- Mississippi State is 88-77 all-time in mid-season tournaments with 19 titles. The Bulldogs' last crown came at the 2011 2K Sports Classic in New York City.
- MSU and St. Louis have met just once, with the Billikens claiming a 63-46 home win on Dec. 9, 1950.
- MSU assistant coach Chris Hollender was on Jim Crews' staff at Army for seven years, and he played for him at Evansville.
- ▼ The Bulldogs are 10-6 all-time against the 11 teams that comprise the Atlantic 10 Conference.
- MSU's most common foe is Richmond (4-4). The last team Mississippi State faced was St. Bonaventure in 2009 in a 105-53 victory at Humphrey Coliseum. MSU also played Richmond that year, dropping a 63-62 decision in South Padre, Texas.
- After scoring in double-digits the first four games, senior forward Roquez Johnson is tied for fifth in the SEC with his 16.5 scoring clip.
- ✓ After four games, MSU leads the SEC in free throws made (22.8) and attempted (30.8).
- ✓ In the final three minutes of the last two games, Trivante Bloodman has been clutch at the foul line, making all eight of his attempts to secure the win. He's currently fifth in the SEC in percent age at .917 (22-24).
- ✓ Fred Thomas' streak of scoring in double-digits ended at six against Clayton State.
- ▼ The Bulldogs have out-rebounded their opponents by 12 or more boards in all four games. The
 last time MSU won the rebounding battle four games in a row in the same season was 2009-10.

 Dating back to last year, MSU has out-rebounded its opponents six-consecutive games.
- → Mississippi State leads the SEC in fewest rebounds allowed at 25.8.
- Junior guard Craig Sword has missed the first three games of the year while recovering from back surgery back in October. His return has not yet been determined. Already out for the entire year is junior college transfer Johnny Zuppardo, who tore his ACL and meniscus in October.

STAFF CONSISTENCY

For the third-consecutive year, Rick Ray's staff remained intact during the offseason.

Back for their third year at Chris Hollender, George Brooks, Wes Flanigan, Adam Gordon and Adam Bauman.

ANOTHER CLEMSON CONNECTION

In his first year as a graduate assistant is Tanner Smith, a fouryear player at Clemson when Rick Ray was an assistant and Adam Gordon a graduate assistant.

Smith's duties include assisting with on-court workouts, video scouting, academic monitoring and on-campus recruiting.

He comes to MSU after spending the last two years overseas playing professionally.

At Clemson, Smith appeared in 127 games where he scored 986 points, grabbed 459 rebounds, dished out 320 assists and collected 159 steals en route to playing in three different NCAA Tournaments.

MORE ASSISTS; FEWER TURNOVERS

After dishing out just 321 assists and committing 545 turnovers two years ago, MSU improved drastically in both departments a year ago.

In 2013-14, MSU had 401 assists compared to just 459 turn-overs

Through four games this year, however, MSU has 40 assists and 65 turnovers.

MAN OF STEAL

In just two seasons, Craig Sword has collected 115 steals, including the 60 he had a year ago.

He needs just 24 more to crack the Top 10 in the MSU record books. Ray White (1976-79) is record holder with 217.

1,000 POINT CLUB

Mississippi State has two players that could join the 1,000-point club this year — Craig Sword and Gavin Ware

Sword, who has missed the first four games due to back surgery, needs just 228 more points after he totaled 437 a year ago.

Ware is now 344 points shy after he totaled 11 against Clayton State on Monday. Last year, he scored 330 points.

HOME LOSING SKID SNAPPED

Not only did Mississippi State open the year on a positive note, it snapped a six-game losing skid at Humphrey Coliseum.

Prior to the Bulldogs' 66-56 win agaisnt Western Carolina, their-last win at the Hump came on Jan. 22, 2014, against Auburn 82-74. MSU now owns a four-game winning streak at the Hump.

10 AND COUNTING

Against Western Carolina, junior forward Gavin Ware recorded his 10th-career double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds.

He's currently tied for 6th in the SEC in rebounding (9.0) and 10th in scoring (16.5).

400th WIN

On Dec. 1, 1975, the doors of Humphrey Coliseum officially opened with an 85-82 win against Indiana State.

Against Western Carolina on Friday, MSU collected win No. 400 with the 66-56 victory.

BULLDOGS SIGN THREE

In mid-November, Mississippi State took advantage of the early signing period by inking Quinndary Weatherspoon, Tookie Brown and Joe Strugg.

Brown is a 5-11, 170-pound guard out of Morgan County High School in Madison, Ga., while Strugg is a 6-8, 200-pound forward from G.W. Carver High School in Montgomery, Ala.

Weatherspoon, rated as the No. 2 overall player in Mississippi and 78th nationally, is a 6-4, 175-pound guard out of Velma Jackson. Recently, the Clinton, Miss., native was named to the Clarion Ledger's Dandy Dozen team.

Strugg is the fourth MSU signee out of Carver in the last four years, along with Roquez Johnson, Craig Sword and Demetrius Houston.

RARE TYPE OF WIN

Usually when MSU has fewer assists than its opponent, it loses. But against Western Carolina, the Bulldogs improved to 3-37 when having fewer assists (7/12).





- In his first season at MSU, produced two players to the SEC All-Freshman team -Gavin Ware and Craig



- ▶ Entering his third season, he is 27-41 in the rebuilding process.
- On the staff of three different teams that have advanced to the NCAA Tournament — Indiana State, Purdue and Clemson.
- As an assistant at Clemson for two years, the Tigers won 38 games and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2011.
- During his time at Purdue as an assistant, the Boilermakers won 103 games in four years.
- All four teams at Purdue earned a berth in the NCAA Tournament, with the last two advancing to the Sweet 16.
- ▶ The 2009 Purdue team won 28 games and the Big 10 Tournament en route to garnering a No. 5 seed.
- ► The 2007 Purdue recruiting was considered one of the tops in the country, earning national rankings of No. 5 and No. 6 by Scout and Rivals, respectively.
- Ray was an assistant at Indiana State for seven years.
- In 2000 and 2001, the Sycamores won 20plus games and made the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2000, ISU won the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title with a 14-4 ledger.
- In 2001, Indiana State won the MVC Tournament before upsetting Oklahoma in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Ray also spent two seasons at Northern Illinois (2005 and 2006), while his first coaching job was at Nebraska-Omaha.
- Ray and his wife, Breyana, have two sons, Deacon and Mason, and one daughter, Katriece.

MSU pushed its lead to double digits for the first time at 57-47 thanks to a pair of free throws from Johnson. WCU would cut it as close as six in the final moments of the game, but clutch free throw shooting by the Bulldogs would seal the contest.

The Lakers hit 18 of 52 shots from the field (34.6 percent), 4 of 21 shots from 3-point range (19.0 percent) and 6 of 15 shots from the foul line (40.0 percent).

MSU held a 43-30 rebounding advantage. The Bulldogs had five assists and 11 turnovers, while the Lakers had five assists and 12 turnovers.
