

WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS LOYOLA...

- Sunday marks just the third meeting between the two, with the first game coming in the historic 1963 NCAA Tournament as the Ramblers won, 61-51.
- → MSU is 7-9 against teams that currently comprise the Missouri Valley Conference.
- This is also the second-consecutive year the two have met and both are to celebrate the 50-year reunion of that game in East Lansing, Mich. Players from both 1963 teams will be recognized at the half.
- That 1963 matchup was historic because MSU, under the direction of legendary coach Babe McCarthy, had to sneak out of town due to an unwritten law that Mississippi teams couldn't compete against schools with African-American players.
- → The two games between the two have been decided by an average of 9.0 points.
- → Dating back to last season, MSU has won six-straight games at home.
- ✓ Against Jackson State, MSU won for the first time under Rick Ray when trailing at the half.
- → Dating back to 2011-12, the Bulldogs had lost 23-consecutive games when trailing at halftime.
- → MSU is looking to start at least 5-1 for the 10th time in the last 20 years.
- The Bulldogs have used three different lineups this season. For the first time, they used the same lineup in back-to-back games the last two games.
- ✓ Gavin Ware's 11.5 rebounds are tied for second in the SEC and tied for 14th nationally.
- → Ware's 66.7 shooting percentage is second in the SEC and 17th nationally.
- ✓ MSU is second in the SEC and 47th nationally with 16.0 assists an outing.
- ✓ In the last three games, Trivante Bloodman has dished out 14 assists.

MSU IS 7-9 AGAINST MISSOURI VALLEY CONERENCE

Entering Sunday's historic game against Loyola University Chicago, the Bulldogs are 7-9 against the 10 teams that currently comprise the Missouri Valley Conference.

MSU has played seven of the teams. The most common foe is Southern Illinois, a team the Bulldogs are 2-2 against.

Outside of Loyola, the last MVC team MSU faced was Southern Illinois at the 2007 Anaheim Classic, won by SIU, 63-49.

NOVEMBER DOMINANCE LAST 26 YEARS

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 83-26 (.762) in November. Under **Rick Ray**, the Bulldogs are 6-5.

MSU BREAKS TREND AGAINST KSU & MVSU

After losing 16-straight games when the opponent shoots 45 percent or better, Mississippi State won two straight under the same circumstances prior to Utah State.

Against Kennesaw State, MSU won despite the Owls shooting 45.5 percent from the floor.

Then against Mississippi Valley State, the Bulldogs claimed a 94-72 victory with the Delta Devils shooting 47.5 percent (28-59).

Utah State, though, won after hitting 28 of its 54 shots (.519).

SCOUTING LOYOLA

Loyola overcame a 35-33 halftime deficit to beat Southern Illinois-Edwardsville on Tuesday, 73-72.

Christian Thomas and Jeff White paced the Ramblers with 14 points each. Thomas also had a team-high 6 rebounds.

Loyola won the battle of the boards, 30-23.

The Ramblers also shot extremely well, hitting 28 of their 49 attemps (.571). They also did a nice job of distributing the basketball as they were credited with 22 assists. Milton Doyle accounted for 7 of those assists.

LAST TIME OUT FOR MSU . . .

Mississippi State overcame an early 7-0 deficit to get back into the win column with a 58-56 win against Jackson State on Wednesday.

Craig Sword broke a 55-all tie with 1:21 left on a shot inside for what proved to be the winning shot. He finished with a game-high 12 points, all coming in the second half.

Gavin Ware led the Bulldogs on the boards with 7 rebounds.

Also scoring in double-digits for MSU were **Fred Thomas** and **Roquez Johnson** with 11 points each.

The Bulldogs forced 15 turnovers and won the battle of boards, 33-32. MSU held the Tigers to 37 percent shooting (20-54), including a 1-of-10 mark beyond the arc.

MSU hit 20 of its 46 shots and recorded a season-high 6 blocked shots to go along with its 6 steals.

A difficult ending to the first half led to Mississippi State losing 59-51 at Loyola.

The Bulldogs went more than five minutes without scoring late in that half, and the Ramblers took advantage with a 20-0

The teams were playing 50 years after a historic meeting between the two universities in the 1963 NCAA Tournament.

Loyola trailed 17-14 before scoring 20 straight points to remove all doubt from the contest. The Ramblers led 34-20 at halftime and did not lead by less than eight points in the game's final half.

MSU scored the game's first six points. Loyola went the first five minutes of the contest without scoring. The Ramblers finally broke the ice and scored four straight points. Thanks to a couple of 3-point baskets by Fred Thomas, the Bulldogs built a 12-7 lead and later held their last lead at 17-14.

The Bulldogs closed within 11 in the early stages of the second half but could not close within single digits until Tyson Cunningham rammed home a 3-point basket in the closing seconds.

Loyola held a 40-28 rebounding advantage. The Bulldogs had seven assists and 15 turnovers, while the Ramblers had 13 assists and 16 turnovers.

SECOND-HALF SCORING UP

■ In four of Mississippi State's five games this season, it has scored more points in the second half.

In the first half, the Bulldogs are averaging 33.6 points, compared to 40.2 in the second half.

POINT PRODUCTION HIGH VS MVSU

■ The 94 points scored against Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 19 were the second most in the Rick Ray era.

The most came against New Orleans a year ago when the Bulldogs totaled 97.

BULLDOGS ANNOUNCE NEW SIGNEES

■ Last Wednesday, Rick Ray announced the signing of three future Bulldogs – Demetrius Houston, Oliver Black, and Maurice Dunlap II.

Houston is a 6-foot-7 forward out of Carver High School in Montgomery, Ala., the same high school that produced current Bulldogs **Craig Sword** and **Roquez Johnson**. Black is a power forward from Jackson who is currently at IMG Academy in Florida, while Dunlap is a guard from Amanda Elzy High in Greenwood.

MSU TO MAKE APPEARANCE IN LAS VE-GAS CLASSIC IN DECEMBER

■ The week of Christmas, Mississippi State will travel to Nevada to participate in the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic.

The Bulldogs open with South Florida and will then play either Santa Clara or UNLV.

MSU last played in the Classic in 2001, posting a 3-1 mark with wins against UL-Monroe, Richmond and Illinois-Chicago while losing to Cncinnati.

BULLDOGS 2013-14 ROSTER FEATURES FEW NEW FACES

■ The Bulldogs roster features just one new scholarship player eligible for this season - freshman point guard I.J. Ready.

The Bulldogs also signed Fallou Ndoye, but he is redshirting this season.

Back from injury, though, are redshirt freshman Dre Applewhite and Jacoby Davis, who missed all of last year due to injuries.

BULLDOGS IN THE NBA

■ MSU currently has one player on an NBA roster — Arnett Moultriee.

Moultrie is with the Philadelphia 76ers but is out with an ankle injury until January.

Jarvis Varnado, who was with the Miami Heat during their championship run last year, is with the Iowa Energy of the NBADL.

Head Coach Rick Ray

- On April 1, 2012, Rick Ray was named the 19th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In his first season at MSU, produced two players to the SEC All-Freshman team — Gavin Ware and Craig Sword.



- On the staff of three different teams that have advanced to the NCAA Tournament – Indiana State, Purdue and Clemson.
- As an assistant at Clemson for two years, the Tigers won 38 games and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2011.
- During his time at Purdue as an assistant, the Boilermakers won 103 games in four years.
- All four teams at Purdue earned a berth in the NCAA Tournament, with the last two advancing to the Sweet 16.
- The 2009 Purdue team won 28 games and the Big 10 Tournament en route to garnering a No. 5 seed.
- While at Purdue, Ray was an assistant with second-year Tennessee coach Cuonzo Martin.
- The 2007 Purdue recruiting was considered one of the tops in the country, earning national rankings of No. 5 and No. 6 by Scout and Rivals, respectively.
- Ray was an assistant at Indiana State for seven years.
- In 2000 and 2001, the Sycamores won 20plus games and made the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2000, the ISU won the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title with a 14-4 ledger
- In 2001, Indiana State won the MVC Tournament before upsetting Oklahoma in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- ▶ Ray also spent two seasons at Northern Illinois (2005 and 2006).
- Ray's first coaching job was at Nebraska-Omaha.
- Ray and his wife, Breyana, have two sons, Deacon and Mason, and one daughter, Katriece.




