WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS OREGON STATE . . .

- Eli Wright earned his first-career start against Northwestern State and responded with 11 points on 4-of-5 shooting to go along with his 7 rebounds.
- Against the Demons, MSU overcame a 10-point deficit. It was the second time this year the Bulldogs overcame a double-digit deficit to win (UTEP, 11).
- MSU made just two 3-pointers against the Demons, the fewest since also having two against Kentucky on 2-25-15.
- Three times this season, MSU has been tied at halftime. In each outing, the Bulldogs won.
- MSU is 9-13 against the 12 teams that currently comprise the Pac-12. Arizona is the team the Bulldogs have played the most (2-2), while Oregon State is last foe MSU played (a 59-49 loss on Dec. 13, 2014). Ben Howland is 16-4 against Oregon State.
- Walk-on Nick Singleton had a career-high game against Northwestern State with 5 points in 13 minutes of play. He entered the game having played just 2 minutes on the year.
- In MSU's three home games, freshman guard Tyson Carter is averaging 14.3 points and has scored in double-digits all three games.
- •I.J. Ready is now 249 points shy of becoming the 37th player in MSU history to score 1,000 for a career. He also needs just 21 assists to move into the MSU all-time Top 10. In addition, he is 20 steals shy of moving in the MSU Top 10 record book.
- According to KenPom.com, Mississippi State is the least experienced team (.72) out of all 351 Division I programs.
- After using the same starting lineup the first four games, MSU has used three different lineups in the last three games. With the injury to Quinndary Weatherspoon, Lamar Peters started in his place once and the Eli Wright the last game.
- Key for Mississippi State is shooting 45 percent or better from the field 3-0 when that happens.
- Of current SEC players, I.J. Ready is 10th with 751 points, third with 119 steals and tied for third with 305 assists. He reached the 300 mark with assists against Northwestern State.

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Last year, MSU was 10-5, including a 5-1 mark against non-conference foes. This year, MSU is 2-1.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 41-season composite record of 420-172 (.710) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

While Tyson poured in 17 points on 6-of-8 shooting with five made 3-pointers, Greg was 5-6 with 10 points.

Through his first 34 games, he now has 437 points.

FRESHMAN SCORING

■ Tyson Carter is averaging 12.5 points, the most for a freshman since Jamont Gordon averaged 13.8 in 2005-06.

Right now, that would rank sixth best all-time. Rickey Brown's average of 19.3 in 1977 is the freshman record.

BULLDOGS SIGN 3

■ Mississippi State took advantage of the early signing period Wednesday and signed three players — two 4-stars and and one 3-star — to give MSU its second Top 15 signing class in a row.

Joining MSU next season are guards Nick Weatherspoon (Velma Jackson) of Canton, Miss., and KeyShawn Feazell (Lawrence County) of Monticello, Miss., and forward Garrison Brooks (Auburn High School) of Lafayette,

Weatherspoon is the younger brother MSU sophomore standout Quinndary Weatherspoon, while Brooks is the son of MSU assistant coach, George Brooks.

BROOKS NOTED FOR RECRUITING

■ In this year's Sporting News preseason basketball publication, MSU assistant George Brooks was named the second best recruiting in the SEC.

Brooks, a 1996 MSU graudate, has been an assistant with the Bulldogs for seven years after serving as head coach at Meridian Community

He's been responsible for signing top talent such as Quinndary Weatherspoon, Mario Kegler and Garrison Brooks.

2-1 IN CHARLESTON

■ Mississippi State posted a 2-1 ledger in the Charleston Classic with wins against Boise State and UTEP.

The lone loss came against Central Florida. MSU is now 92-81 all-time in regular-season tournaments

HIGH STEAL COUNT

■ In the 80-68 win against Boise State, MSU collected 13 steals.

That was the most since also having 13 last February in a home win against South Carolina.

MSU IN ITALY

■ This past August, Mississippi State spent two weeks traveling across Italy playing games.

Holman poured in 18 in the Bulldogs' 61-54 victory, while Peters totaled 13.

All four of Peters' field goals were from 3-point range. On the year, the New Orlreans native is 7-17 beyond the arc. In his last two games, he's averaging 12.0 points.

Holman has scored 10-plus points in four of MSU's five games. Last year in 26 appearances, he never reached double digits.

Ben Howland 21th Season Overall | 2nd Season At Mississippi State 419-225 (18-19 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015, Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 419-225 record – Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (18-19).
- Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division

I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).

- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- This past year, Howland was inducted into both the Northern Arizona and Weber State hall of fames.
- Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children Meredith and Adam (Brittney) – and two grandsons, Benjamin Clark Howland II and Elijah Howland.
