- Rick Stansbury passed Ray Mears (Tennessee) and Roy Skinner (Vanderbilt) with the victory against North Texas Sunday for the 9th most wins in SEC history with 279.
- ✓ Mississippi State won seven games in November for the first time in school history.
- ✓ MSU is looking for its best start since opening the 2003-04 campaign 13-0.
- Mississippi State has shot 50 percent or better from the floor the last three games. The last time that happened in three consecutive games was in 2004-05 (@ Xavier, .540; vs. Florida A&M, .540; vs. Jacksonville State, .544).
- → Arnett Moultrie leads the SEC in rebounding at 10.8 boards an outing.
- Rodney Hood currently has the sixth-best scoring average in school history for freshmen at 13.0. Rickey Brown (1976-77) is tops at 19.3. Hood's 33.9 minutes is currently fourth best and is tops this year in SEC play.
- Dee Bost is now just 35 assists shy of breaking the school record of 514 held by Derrick Zimmerman (2000-03).
- On Monday, MSU moved into both the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today Coaches Top 25 polls for the first time since 2009-10.

BULLDOGS ARE 9-13 AGAINST BIG EAST FOES

Entering Saturday's showdown against West Virginia, the Bulldogs are 9-13 against the 16 teams that currently comprise the Big East Conference.

GAME 9: WEST VIRGINIA

However, Mississippi State has only played against 10 of the teams. The six the Bulldogs have never faced are Georgetown, Marquette, Notre Dame, Providence, Seton Hall and St. John's.

MSU has played Cincinnati and Louisville the most. State is 2-2 against the Bearcats and 1-3 against the Cardinals.

The last Big East team Mississippi State has faced DePaul last in 2009-10 in the SEC/Big East Challenge. The Bulldogs won that game in Tampa, 76-45. MSU has never played a Big East team at Humphrey Coliseum.

NOVEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 4-1 mark, coupled with this season's 7-1 ledger, the Bulldogs are 56-18 (.757) in the month of November since Rick Stansbury was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1986-87 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 82-21 (.796) in November.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 8-6 mark in non-conference action, coupled with this year's 7-1 record, Mississippi State has compiled a 149-50 (.749) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 139-40 (.777) regular-season mark.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 218-38 (7-0 this year) when leading at halftime; 158-37 (5-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 234-72 (5-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 218-81 (7-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 171-31 (6-0) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

BOMBS AWAY . . . AGAIN AND AGAIN

In 2009-10, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers, an average of 8.2 an outing.

In 31 games last year, the Bulldogs were nearly on the same pace, having drained 246 of their 680 attempts for an 7.9 average.

Early this year, the Bulldogs are off that torrid pace somewhat, as they've drained 51 in seven games, including the nine on Sunday against North Texas in an 82-59 victory.

SCOUTING WEST VIRGINIA

West Virginia won its third-straight game on Monday night, defeating Akron 77-56 to improve to 4-1 on the year.

Jabarie Hinds paced the Mountaineers with 19 points, while Kevin Jones added 18 to go along with his 12 rebounds. Also in double-digits were Deniz Kilicli and Darryl Bryant with 11 points each.

WVU shot 47.6 percent (30-63) from the floor, while limiting the Zips to 20-of-56 shooting (35.7).

West Virginia also scored 32 points off of 20 Akron turnovers.

LAST TIME OUT FOR MSU . . .

Mississippi State built as much as a 34-point lead and never looked back en route to a convincing 82-59 win against North Texas on Sunday.

Arnett Moultrie, playing for the first time after sitting out two games due to injury, paced the Bulldogs with 20 points, while Dee Bost added 18, followed by Rodney Hood and Jalen Steele with 11 each.

MSU shot 51.9 percent (27-52) from the floor, while holding the Mean Green to 32.3 percent shooting (20-62).

Bulldog Hoops Turns 100

- MSU is celebrating its 100th season of basksetball this year. The first year the Bulldogs fielded a team was in 1908-09, when they posted a 5-5 ledger. The first game was against the Columbus Athletic Club on Jan. 1, 1909, with Mississippi State claiming a 35-6 win in Starkville. The coach that year was T.H. Werner. It was Werner's only year at the helm.
- It will be a year-long celebration, as former players and coaches will be recognized. In addition, a "Starting 5" will be announced as will the "5 Greatest Games" in school history, as voted on by the fans.

PRESESON HONORS

In October, the media predicted MSU to finish 5th in the overall standings. In addition, senior guard **Dee Bost** was tabbed first-team All-SEC. Two weeks later, the league coaches voted Bost first team All-SEC

and junior forward **Renardo Sidney** second-team.

BULLDOGS GRAB TOURNAMENT TITLE IN NEW YORK

Mississippi State knocked off No. 19 Texas A&M and No. 15 Arizona in back-to-back nights last week to win the 2011 2K Sports Classic, benefitting Coaches vs. Cancer.

It was the 18th in-season tournament title the Bulldogs have won, while improving their record to 86-73 following Friday's 67-57 win against Arizona. It was MSU's first tournament crown since the 2000 Bank One Fiesta Bowl Classic, when it also upended Arizona.

1,000-POINT CLUB HAS BOST; MOULTRIE CLOSING

On Feb. 9, 2011, against Arkansas at Humphrey Coliseum, junior guard **Dee Bost** became the 33rd MSU player to score 1,000 points for a career. He reached the milestone with 3:34 left in the first half on a 3-pointer that tied the game at 25-apiece.

Arnett Moultrie came to MSU after transferring from UTEP, where he totaled 650 points his first two seasons. After scoring 96 points in his first six games, including a career-best 28 against South Alabama on Nov. 12, he is on pace to eclipse 1,000 points for his career this season.

He currently has 746 career points and 587 rebounds.

BOST MOVING UP SCORING/STEAL RECORD BOOKS

Senior guard **Dee Bost** scored 18 points against North Texas on Sunday to give him 1,256 points for his career, as he moved past Jerry Graves for the 19th most in school history.

He also had 3 steals to give him 147 for his career, which ties him with Winsome Frazier (2002-05) for the 7th most in the record bookds. He needs just 14 more to crack the Top 5. Timmy Bowers (2001-04) is No. 5 with 161 steals.

MOULTRIE IMPRESSIVE IN DEBUT

Arnett Moultrie became the first Mississippi State player to record a double-double in his Bulldog debut since Lawrence Roberts (26 points, 15 rebounds) in 2002-03 against UT Martin.

Against EKU, Moultrie had 13 points and 10 rebounds.

HOOD TURNING HEADS FROM DAY 1

Guard Rodney Hood became the first true freshman to score in double-digits his first four games since Rickey Brown in 1976-77 when he opened his career by scoring 10-plus points his first 12 games.


The record is held by Ray White in 1975-76 when he scored in double-digits all 28 games.

BULLDOGS IN ELITE COMPANY...

Mississippi State is one of only two SEC schools to post winning conference records in each of the last three seasons. In the "Super 6" conferences, the Bulldogs find themselves in elite company, as only 18 of the 73 teams who have competed in those leagues the last three years have accomplished the feat.

MEET THE HEAD COACH



onsistency is a key ingredient to the recent success enjoyed by the Mississippi State University basketball program, one that is stressed in the players' daily activities on and off the basketball floor that has translated into the program's recent run of national prominence gained under head coach Rick Stansbury.

That consistency was brought to the forefront four years ago when MSU's 14th-year head basketball coach became the all-time winningest basketball coach in school history, surpassing Richard Williams' mark of 191. Now with a 14-year coaching record of 279-155 at the Bulldog helm, the 9th-most wins in SEC history, Stansbury has guided 10 State squads (6 NCAA & 4 NIT) to postseason tournament appearances and nine clubs to 20-plus wins campaigns.

MSU has averaged 21.3 wins the last six years (2006-11), including winning an outright SEC overall championship in 2004, along with back-to-back SEC West crowns in the 2003-2004 and 2007-2008 seasons an another in 2010, and SEC Tournament titles in 2002 and 2009.

Most recently, Stansbury piloted last year's 17-14 State squad to a second place finish in the Western Division, but missed out on a post-season berth for the first time in five seasons.

From 2001-05, he guided MSU to five-consecutive postseason tournament appearances for the first time in school history, including a streak of four straight NCAA Tournament berths from 2002 through 2005.

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. With the 12-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's 13 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 165-43 (.793) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 76-28 (.731) SEC mark and a 89-15 (.856) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 371-141 (.725) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

Mississippi State traveled the world this season, spending time in the Netherlands, Belgium and France playing basketball against pro and club teams.

In five games, the Bulldogs posted a 5-0 record and averaged 93.6 points while allowing just 71.4 points.

MSU had four players that averaged in double-digits, led by Arnett Moultrie's 16.8 clip. DeVille Smith was next at 15.4, followed by Wendell Lewis and Rodney Hood and 13.4 and 11.0 points, respectively.

From a rebounding standpoint, Moultrie led the way with his 11.2 average, followed by Lewis and Bryant at 6.0 and 4.8 boards, respectively.
