WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS DAYTON . . .

- Mississippi State is looking to start 7-0 for the first time since beginning the 2003-04 campaign 13-0.
- •MSU is 13-10 all-time versus the 14 teams that comprise the Atlantic 10 Conference. The Bulldogs have played 11 of the teams, St. Joseph's and Richmond the most at four games each.
- The last Atlantic 10 Mississippi State played was St. Louis on Nov. 28, 2014, in Corpus Christi, a 75-50 win.
- Mississippi State is one of only four schools nationally whose men's and women's basketball teams are undefeated — Villanova, Florida State and Kansas.
- Freshman guard Nick Weatherspoon has scored in double-digits all six games.
- Against North Dakota State, junior All-SEC guard Quinndary Weatherspoon had a career-high 10 assists and was one point shy of a double-double.
- Also against the Bison, sophomore guard Tyson Carter had a career-high 35 points, the most by an MSU player since Darryl Wilson had 35 against Alabama on 3-4-95.
- Quinndary Weatherspoon is now 78 points shy of becoming the 37th player in school history to reach 1,000 for a career following his 9-point performance against North Dakota State.
- Aric Holman needs 2 more blocks to tie Marcus Campbell for the 10th most in school history.
- The Bulldogs lead the SEC in points allowed at 62.3.
- Freshman Abdul Ado leads the SEC with this 3.3 blocks per game.
- Through six games, the Bulldogs have used three different lineups. The only players to start all games are **Nick Weatherspoon** and **Quinndary Weatherspoon**.
- Nick Weatherspoon's 12.0 average is currently tied for the sixth-best average in school history for a freshman with his brother, Quinndary.
- Schnider Herard's 6 blocks against Florida A&M are the most by an SEC player in a single game this year.
- The six November wins tie for the second-most in school history seven in 2012 and six in 1998.

A CLOSER LOOK AT MSU

Q & GAME WINNERS

■ Against Jacksonville State back in November, junior All-SEC guard Quinndary Weatherspoon drained a 3-pointer with 0.7 seconds left to give the Bulldogs a dramatic 59-56 win.

It was the second time in his career he hit a last-second, gamewinning shot.

The first was against Vanderbilt in February his freshman camaign, this time a buzzer beater for a 75-74 win

Both shots came from the left side.

BLOCK PARTY

■ Against Florida A&M on Nov. 18, Mississippi State recorded 13 blocked shots, with sophomore forward **Schnider Herard** leading the way with a career-high 6.

For MSU, it was the most blocks since also having 13 against Arkansas on Jan. 14, 2010.

The 6 blocks by Herard were also the most since Aric Holman had 5 last year against Northwestern St.

SEEING DOUBLE

■ Last year, Aric Holman and Schnider Herard recorded four of MSU's five double-doubles, while Xavian Stapleton had one.

In the season opener against Alabama State, Holman wasted little time adding to his total.

The junior forward tied his career highs in points (18) and rebounds (11) to give him three for his career.

Against Green Bay, Abdul Ado broke into the category for his first with 12 points and 11 rebounds in just his second game at MSU.

Mississippi State is one of seven SEC schools with two or more players to record a double-double this year. Florida and Kentucky lead the way with three each.

BROTHERLY LOVE

■ Mississippi State is one of 29 schools nationally with brothers on the same team.

They've also started all five games.

The last time MSU had two brothers start in the same game was Reginald and Reggie Delk against West Virginia in the NIT Final Four on March 27, 2007.

YOUTHFULL GROUP

■ The Bulldogs are one of five teams without any scholarship seniors, along with Kentucky, Holy Cross, Chattanooga and Robert Morris.

MSU's experience is ranked No. 333 out of 351 schools.

2 FOR 20

■ Against Green Bay, MSU had two players score 20-plus points — Tyson Carter (25) and Quinndary Weatherspoon (20).

It was the first time the Bulldogs had two players score 20-plus points in the same game since **Quinndary Weatherspoon** had 25 and **Lamar Peters** 23 at Auburn on Feb. 7, 2017.

On the year, those are the only two times the Bulldogs have had players reach 20 points.

JUST 6 AT CHARITY STRIPE

■ In the 59-56 win against Jacksonville State, Mississippi State limited the Gamecocks to just six free throw attempts.

It was the fewest attempts by an opponent since Georgia State had only six last year on Dec. 4, 2016.

JSU's six made were also the fewest since Georgia State had four on the same date.

■ When junior guard Quinndary

Weatherspoon scores 20 or more points, Mississippi State benefits.

■ Mississippi State took advantage of the early signing period and landed 5-star forward Reggie Perry and 4-star forwards DJ Stewart and Robert Woodard.

Perry, a 6-foot-8, 240-pound Thomasville, Ga., native, is the son of former MSU great Al Perry (1975-78), who ranks third all-time at MSU with 510 steals

He's rated as the No. 1 prospect out of the state of Georgia and listed as the No. 4 small forward nationally.

ESPN has him as the 16th best player regardless of position.

Woodard, the top-ranked player in Mississippi and a Dandy Dozen selection, is ranked 56th overall nationally and is the son of Robert Woodard, Sr., who played at MSU from 1987-90.

He led Columbus to the Class 6A crown in 2016 and was last year's Gatorade Player of the year.

The 6-6, 187-pound Stewart is listed as the 33rd best small forward.

As a junior at Riverside last year, he averaged 18.9 points, 9.7 rebounds and 3.1 assists.

Nationally, Scout has him as the 103rd best player overall, while Rivals has him at 103.


- On March 23, 2015. Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 435-239 record Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (36-33).
- · Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division I his-

tory to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).


- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regularseason title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
