BULLDOGS OPEN THREE-GAME HOMESTAND IN IMPRESSIVE STYLE

Mississippi State snapped a two-game losing streak with a 76-67 victory against Alabama State on Saturday. Now, the focus is Charlotte, a team the Bulldogs are 3-0 against. At 6-2, MSU now looks to start a season 7-2 for the first time since 2006-07 when it was 9-2. Under 11th-year coach Rick Stansbury, the Bulldogs have failed to reach eight wins in their first 10 games just twice – 1999-00 and 2007-08.

Through the first seven games, Mississippi State didn't have a single player to score 20 points, but against Alabama State, both Jarvis Varnado and Ravern Johnson achieved the feat with 22 and 21 points, respectively. The production was careerhighs for both. Prior to the Alabama State game, the last time MSU had a player total 20 points was Jamont Gordon (21) against Memphis last year in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The last time the Bulldogs had two players score 20-plus points in the same game was last year at home against LSU when Charles Rhodes finished with 27 and Gordon had 23.

D-E-F-E-N-S-E . . . D-E-F-E-N-S-E

Mississippi State currently ranks fifth in the SEC in points allowed (62.6). And what a difference playing at home makes. In five games at the Hump, MSU is yielding just 58 points an outing and hasn't allowed more than 67 points by any one team. On the road, opponents are averaging 70.3 points.

Jarvis Varnado has already set a school record with 277 career blocked shots, the sixth most in SEC history. He's now 145 blocks away from tying former LSU standout Shaquille O'Neal's league record of 412. With 144 made 3-pointers, Barry Stewart is just 17 away from moving into the Top 5 of MSU's record books. Then there's Dee Bost, who needs just 10 assists to move into the school's freshman Top 10 charts. He currently has 40, and Tony Watts (1989-90) is 10th with 50. Jamont Gordon owns the rookie record with 129 set in 2005-06.

HEY, LOOK WHO WAS TRAILING

Through the first four games at Humphrey Coliseum, Mississippi State never trailed, a span of 160 minutes. However, that all changed early against Alabama State. With 18:11 to play in the opening frame, Chief Kickingstallionsims connected on a shot to give the Hornets a 4-2 lead, marking the first time MSU fell behind at home. No sweat as MSU extended its home winning streak to nine games.

MSTATE 15-7 AGAINST ATLANTIC-10 FOES

Entering Wednesday's showdown against Charlotte, the Bulldogs are 15-7 against the 14 teams that currently comprise the Atlantic-10 Conference. The only league foes the Bulldogs haven't faced are Duquense, LaSalle, Temple, Massuchusettes and Fordham.

The last time MSU battled an Atlantic-10 member was two weeks ago, when it claimed an exciting 76-71 victory against St. Bonaventure in Olean, N.Y., on Nov. 25.

The most common team out of the Atlantic-10 MSU has faced is Xavier. The Bulldogs are 4-1 against Musketeers, and the two last met on Dec. 18, 2004 when MSU claimed an 80-74 victory in Cincinnati.

MSU AIMS FOR CONTINUED NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 11-7 ledger against non-conference foes, Mississippi State has now compiled a dominant 118-36 (.766) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 108-27 (.800) regular-season mark versus non-league foes.

DECEMBER AND HOME DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 5-2 December record, the Bulldogs are 62-12 (.838) in the month of December since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 120-36 (.769) in December.

At home, MSU has put together a 127-28 (.819) mark at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's guidance, including a 60-20 (.750) SEC record and 67-8 (.893) ledger at home against non-conference foes.

The Bulldogs, who are 5-0 this year, currently own a nine-game winning streak at the Hump and have won 13 out of the last 14. MSU's last setback on its home floor came on Feb. 2, 2008, against Tennessee, 76-71. The Volunteers entered the game 18-2 and ranked No. 7 nationally.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era of Mississippi State hoops, the Bulldogs are: 171-25 when leading at halftime (6-0 this year); 151-30 when shooting 45 percent or better from the field (5-0); 176-54 when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field (6-1); 178-67 when out-rebounding or tying the opponent (5-1); and 132-24 when holding the opponent to 65 points or less (4-1).

NOW THAT HAS A FAMILIAR RING

Last year, the Bulldogs led the Southeastern Conference in scoring defense (65.5), field goal percentage defense (.370), rebounding offense (40.7) and blocked shots (7.85).

Compared to their eight games this season, the statistical numbers are quite similiar. So far, MSU is yielding just 62.6 points on just 35.0 percent shooting from the floor and grabbing 44.2 rebounds to go along with its 91 blocked shots. Jarvis Varnado, who led the nation a year ago with a school-record 157 blocks, has 53.

NORTH CAROLINA-MISSISSIPPI CONNECTIONS

Although Charlotte doesn't have any players on its roster from the Magnolia State, MSU currently has two players from the Tar Heel State – freshman point guard Dee Bost (Concord) and senior forward Brian Johnson (Laurinburg).

Bost was a two-sport standout in football and basketball at Concord H.S. and led both squads to Class 3A titles as a senior. Johnson prepped at Bishop O'Connell H.S. and guided his team to a three-year composite ledger of 72-25.

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 31-6 mark for an .837 winning percentage. The Bulldogs reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's previous 10 seasons at the MSU helm and are on pace to do so again this year.

Mississippi State is now 127-28 (.819) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 60-20 (.750) SEC mark and a 67-8 (.893) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 32-season composite record of 333-126 (.725) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

Mississippi State coach Rick Stansbury, now in his 11th season, is 23 games shy of tying Richard Williams' record mark of 354 games coached. Williams coached at MSU from 1986-87 to 1997-98.

DID YOU KNOW, Part II . . .

The Bulldogs have currently won nine games in a row at home. It's the longest streak since winning 12 straight at Humphrey Coliseum from Feb. 25, 2004, to Feb. 12, 2005. The streak started with an 84-58 win against LSU and ended with an 80-72 setback to LSU (Feb. 16, 2005).



Sophomore Ravern Johnson led all scorers on the night with an 8-of-14 performance from the field for a total of 19 points, while freshman Romero Osby pitched in the team's second double-double with 10 points and 11 boards. Dee Bost scored 13 points and handed out seven assists to just three turnovers in the win.

Junior guards Marcus Lancaster and Freddy Little led Montevallo in scoring with 10 points apiece on a collective 8-of-25 shooting performance, while junior forward Nate Flowers led the squad in rebounding with nine boards.

Ranking second nationally in team field-goal percentage defense last year, the Bulldogs followed suit by holding Montevallo to just 23-of-71 shooting from the floor for a 32.6% mark. Also specializing in blocks as a team by ranking second nationally in that category a year ago, MSU swatted 13 shots on the evening. Leading Montevallo in rebounding at halftime 32-21, State never let up and finished the game with a 62-37 advantage.

Junior Jarvis Varnado once again flirted with triple-double status in the contest by scoring 12 points, claiming a game-high 13 rebounds, and swatting eight shots after leading the nation in blocks a year ago. Varnado amassed 29 points, 25 rebounds and 16 blocks in State's two exhibition contests.

Senior Brian Johnson fell just a rebound shy of a double-double performance for the Bulldogs with 10 points on 5-of-7 shooting, while standout freshman Dee Bost tallied 11 points and six assists. The Bulldogs trailed by as many as 17 midway through the second half. A 9-0 run helped MSU cut the deficit to six before a more-experienced Cougars squad pulled away for the final margin.

MSU lost for the first time on the young season, falling to 5-1. Washington State, a member of the Pac 10 Conference, improved to 5-0.
