NO. 32 BECOMES MEMBER 31 OF ELITE CLUB

With 14 points against St. Bonaventure on Saturday afternoon, senior All-SEC forward Jarvis Varnado became the 31st player in Mississippi State history to score 1.000 for a career.

He reached the milestone with 6:55 left in the first half on a free throw. The Brownsville, Tenn., native has scored 1,008 points in his illustrious career and needs to total 34 more to tie Greg Lockhart (1986-89) for the 30th most. Jeff Malone (1980-83) is tops with 2,142.

Varnado joins teammate Barry Stewart in this elite club.

VARNADO'S COUNTDOWN TO HISTORY

Following his four-block performance against St. Bonaventure, Jarvis Varnado now has a nation-best 37 for the year and 431 for his career.

As a result, the Brownsville, Tenn., native is now just 104 shy of tying the NCAA mark of 535 held by former Louisiana-Monroe standout Wojciech Mydra (1998-2002).

Varnado, who has led the nation the past two years in this category, is currently 10th all-time, six behind Lorenzo Coleman (Tennessee Tech) for the 9th most.

To get the record by the end of the regular season, Varnado needs to average 4.3 blocks in the next 24 games.

NOW THAT'S SHARING THE BALL

Mississippi State dished out a season-high 25 assists against St. Bonaventure, surpassing the previous best of 15 the Bulldogs had against Rider in the season opener.

It was the most assist since totaling 25 against Loyola Marymount on Dec. 19, 2007. The single-game record of 34 came against Chicago St. on Dec. 4, 1975. Sophomore Dee Bost paced MSU against the Bonnies with seven to give him 32 for the year and 188 for his career, the 32nd most in school history.

MSU BY THE NUMBER

52 — The Bulldogs' 52-point win (105-53) against St. Bonaventure tied the largest margin of victory under Rick Stansbury. MSU won by the same score against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Nov. 17, 1998.

MSTATE 8-13 AGAINST BIG EAST FOES

Entering today's showdown against DePaul, the Bulldogs are 8-13 against the 16 teams that currently comprise the Big East Conference.

However, Mississippi State has only played against 10 of the teams. The six the Bulldogs have never faced are Georgetown, Marquette, Notre Dame, Providence, Seton Hall and St. John's.

MSU has played Cincinnati and Louisville the most. State is 2-2 against the Bearcats and 1-3 against the Cardinals.

The last Big East team Mississippi State has faced was Cincinnati last year in the SEC/Big East Challenge in Cincinnati, won by the Bearcats, 75-63.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 10-6 ledger against non-conference foes coupled with this year's 5-2 mark, MSU has compiled a dominant 126-41 (.754) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 118-32 (.787) regular-season.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 187-27 when leading at halftime (5-0 this year); 166-32 (4-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 195-61 (5-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 189-69 (5-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 144-26 (4-1) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

DECEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 3-3 mark coupled with this year's 1-0 record, the Bulldogs are 65-15 (.813) in the month of December since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 123-39 (.759) in December.

D-E-F-E-N-S-E GETTING THE JOB DONE FOR MSU

The Bulldogs have always prided themselves on defense and rebounding. This year is no different.

Currently, MSU is second in the SEC in points allowed (61.0), fourth in field goal percentage defense (.387), second in rebounding (40.6), first in defensive rebounds (29.3) and first in blocked shots (8.3)

BULLDOGS STRONG ON OFFENSIVE END, TOO

Mississippi State currently ranks sixth in the Southeastern Conference in scoring at 76.3 and is fourth in scoring margin at +15.3 following its 52-point win against St. Bonaventure

Helping that stat is the fact the Bulldogs have three players ranked in the league's Top 30 in scoring — Jarvis Varnado (15th), Dee Bost (23rd) and Ravern Johnson (27th).

Bost and Johnson also rank third and fourth, respectively, in 3-point accuracy at 52.5 and 42.9, while Bost's 3.0 made treys is tied for second most. Johnson's 2.7 average is fifth best in the SEC.

Nationally, Bost is 45 with 21 made 3-pointers, which is tied for 45 with 15 other players.

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 43-12 mark for an .782 winning percentage. With a 13-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's first 11 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 139-34 (.803) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 65-23 (.739) SEC mark and a 74-11 (.871) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 345-132 (.723) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

BRYANT BECOMES FIRST MSU SIGNEE OF 2009-10 SIGNING CLASS

Mississippi State men's basketball coach Rick Stansbury has announced his first signee of the 2009-10 class, standout guard Brian Bryant.

The 6-foot-3, 165-pound Albany, Ga., native is currently a sophomore at Northwest Florida State College, where he has guided his team to a 5-0 start and is averaging 20 points, 7.6 rebounds and 5.4 assists, while shooting 41 percent from 3-point territory.

Last year as a freshman, he was limited due to a hand injury.

Prior to enrolling at Northwest Florida, previously known as Okaloosa Walton, Bryant prepped four years at Dougherty High School, where he led his team to two regional titles and four playoff appearances.

As a senior, he averaged 29.6 points, 9.3 rebounds, 3.6 steals and 3.6 assists en route to garnering team MVP honors and earning Albany

Herald Play of the Year honors for the second-straight season.

He was also selected to play in the Georgia North-South All-Star Game.

"He is the complete package of talent, athleticism, character and work ethic." 13th-year Raiders coach Bruce Stewart said. "He is a winner."

Bryant chose MSU over Auburn and Southern Miss.

Bryant is the fifth NWF State College men's player to head to the SEC in the last three seasons, following in the footsteps of Auburn's Tay Waller and Johnnie Lett, Alabama's Charvez Davis and South Carolina's Johndre Jefferson.

He's also the second player MSU signed from Northwest Florida, as he joins forward Branden Vincent, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003- 04
