WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS TROY . . .

- ✓ Troy is the fourth Sun Belt Conference team MSU has played this year. Currently, the Bulldogs are 3-0 this season against Sun Belt members.
- ✓ The 8-1 start is MSU's best since opening the 2003-04 campaign 13-0.
- ✓ MSU is ranked in the Top 20 of both polls for the first since 2009-10 preseason.
- ✓ **Arnett Moultrie** leads the SEC in rebounding (11.1) and double-doubles (4).
- ✓ **Rodney Hood** currently has the sixth-best scoring average in school history for freshmen at 12.3. Rickey Brown (1976-77) is tops at 19.3. Hood's 34.3 minutes is currently third best and is second this year in SEC play.
- ✓ **Dee Bost** is now just 28 assists shy of breaking the school record of 514 held by Derrick Zimmerman (2000-03).
- ✓ The Bulldogs' note of out-rebounding all of their opponents ended on Saturday against West Virginia, when the Mountaineers won the battle of the boards, 36-31. MSU still has a rebounding margin of +5.6.
- ✓ During its current seven-game winning streak, MSU has held all six opponents to 65 points or less and is yielding just 59.4 points during that stretch.
- ✓ The numbers don't lie. When holding opponents to 65 points or less, MSU is now 7-0 on the year. It's also 6-0 when holding foes to less than 45 percent shooting.
- ✓ Sophomore guard **Jalen Steele** has scored 10-plus points the last two games, marking the first time in his career he's done that in back-to-back games.
- ✓ In just nine games, the Bulldogs have already utilized four different lineups.
- ✓ MSU is two-straight wins shy of matching its nine-game winning streak from the 2009-10 season. State hasn't won 10 straight since opening 2003-04 13-0.
- ✓ The Bulldogs are three wins shy of 1,300 all-time victories.

- ◆ Of all the players currently in the SEC, MSU senior guard Dee Bost is tops in the last four years with 152 steals and 487 assists.

The Concord, N.C., native is also fourth with 1,273 points. Vanderbilt's Jeffery Taylor is first with 1,435 points, followed by Florida's Erving Walker (1,427) and Alabama's JaMychal Green (1,399).

BULLDOGS ARE 66-14 AGAINST SUN BELT FOES

Mississippi State has experienced a wealth of great success against teams that currently comprise the Sun Belt Conference, as it holds a 66-14 advantage.

Saturday's matchup against Troy is the fourth of five Sun Belt foes for MSU this season, as it also plays Florida Atlantic on Tuesday. Earlier this month, Mississippi State defeated South Alabama, 80-65, and Louisiana-Monroe, 78-63, and North Texas, 82-59.

The team the Bulldogs have played the most is Louisiana Lafayette, winning 11 of the 15 outings.

Last year, Mississippi State went 1-1 against the league, defeating Troy before losing to Florida Atlantic.

DECEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 4-5 mark, coupled with this year's 1-0 ledger, the Bulldogs are 77-20 (.794) in the month of December since Rick Stansbury was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 135-44 (.754) in December.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 8-6 mark in non-conference action, coupled with this year's 8-1 record, Mississippi State has compiled a 150-50 (.750) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 140-40 (.778) regular-season mark.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 219-38 (8-0 this year) when leading at halftime; 159-37 (6-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 235-72 (6-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 218-81 (7-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 172-31 (7-0) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

BOMBS AWAY . . . AGAIN AND AGAIN

In 2009-10, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers, an average of 8.2 an outing.

In 31 games last year, the Bulldogs were nearly on the same pace, having drained 246 of their 680 attempts for an 7.9 average.

Early this year, the Bulldogs are off that torrid pace somewhat, as they've drained 56 in seven games, including the five on Saturday against West Virginia in a 75-62 victory.

SCOUTING TROY

Troy won its third-straight game on Saturday night, defeating Miami (OH) 73-60 to improve to 4-3 on the year.

Justin Wright paced the Trojans with 18 points, while Alan Jones added 13, followed by Emil Jones and R.J. Scott with 12 and 11, respectively.

Troy shot 44.8 percent from the floor (26-58) and were a blistering 14 of 26 from 3-point range.

The Trojans also got 31 points from its bench.

LAST TIME OUT FOR MSU . . .

Mississippi State led all but a few seconds as it defeated West Virginia 75-62 in the Big East/SEC Challenge. The win improved the Bulldogs to 2-1 in this event.

Arnett Moultrie paced MSU with 21 points and 13 rebounds as he collected his fourth double-double of the year. Dee Bost followed with 17 points, while Jalen Steele added 10.

The Bulldogs were also solid from the foul line, where they drained 20 of their 24 attempts.

**Bulldog Hoops Turns 100**

● MSU is celebrating its 100th season of basketball this year. The first year the Bulldogs fielded a team was in 1908-09, when they posted a 5-5 ledger. The first game was against the Columbus Athletic Club on Jan. 1, 1909, with Mississippi State claiming a 35-6 win in Starkville. The coach that year was T.H. Werner. It was Werner's only year at the helm.

● It will be a year-long celebration, as former players and coaches will be recognized. In addition, a "Starting 5" will be announced as will the "5 Greatest Games" in school history, as voted on by the fans.

PRESEASON HONORS

In October, the media predicted MSU to finish 5th in the overall standings. In addition, senior guard **Dee Bost** was tabbed first-team All-SEC.

Two weeks later, the league coaches voted Bost first team All-SEC and junior forward **Renardo Sidney** second-team.

BULLDOGS GRAB TOURNAMENT TITLE IN NEW YORK

Mississippi State knocked off No. 19 Texas A&M and No. 15 Arizona in back-to-back nights last week to win the 2011 2K Sports Classic, benefitting Coaches vs. Cancer.

It was the 18th in-season tournament title the Bulldogs have won, while improving their record to 86-73 following Friday's 67-57 win against Arizona. It was MSU's first tournament crown since the 2000 Bank One Fiesta Bowl Classic, when it also upended Arizona.

1,000-POINT CLUB HAS BOST; MOULTRIE CLOSING

On Feb. 9, 2011, against Arkansas at Humphrey Coliseum, junior guard **Dee Bost** became the 33rd MSU player to score 1,000 points for a career. He reached the milestone with 3:34 left in the first half on a 3-pointer that tied the game at 25-apiece.

Arnett Moultrie came to MSU after transferring from UTEP, where he totaled 650 points his first two seasons. After scoring 117 points in his first seven games, including a career-best 28 against South Alabama on Nov. 12, he is on pace to eclipse 1,000 points for his career this season.

He currently has 767 career points and 600 rebounds.

BOST MOVING UP SCORING/STEAL RECORD BOOKS

Senior guard **Dee Bost** scored 17 points against West Virginia on Saturday to give him 1,273 points for his career, as he moved past Jack Bouldin for the 18th most in school history.

He also had 5 steals to give him 152 for his career, which leaves him two shy of tying Tony Watts (1989-92) for the 6th most in the record books. He needs just nine more to crack the Top 5. Timmy Bowers (2001-04) is No. 5 with 161 steals.

MOULTRIE IMPRESSIVE IN DEBUT

Arnett Moultrie became the first Mississippi State player to record a double-double in his Bulldog debut since Lawrence Roberts (26 points, 15 rebounds) in 2002-03 against UT Martin.

Against ECU, Moultrie had 13 points and 10 rebounds.

HOOD TURNING HEADS FROM DAY 1

Guard Rodney Hood became the first true freshman to score in double-digits his first four games since Rickey Brown in 1976-77 when he opened his career by scoring 10-plus points his first 12 games.

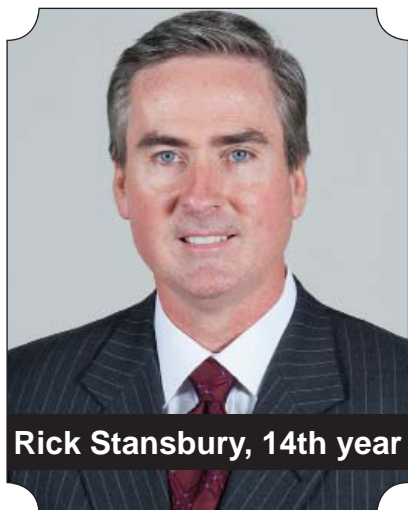
The record is held by Ray White in 1975-76 when he scored in double-digits all 28 games.

BULLDOGS IN ELITE COMPANY . . .

Mississippi State is one of only two SEC schools to post winning conference records in each of the last three seasons. In the "Super 6" conferences, the Bulldogs find themselves in elite company, as only 18 of the 73 teams who have competed in those leagues the last three years have accomplished the feat.

MEET THE HEAD COACH



Rick Stansbury, 14th year

Consistency is a key ingredient to the recent success enjoyed by the Mississippi State University basketball program, one that is stressed in the players' daily activities on and off the basketball floor that has translated into the program's recent run of national prominence gained under head coach Rick Stansbury.

That consistency was brought to the forefront four years ago when MSU's 14th-year head basketball coach became the all-time winningest basketball coach in school history, surpassing Richard Williams' mark of 191. Now with a 14-year coaching record of 280-155 at the Bulldog helm, the 9th-most wins in SEC history, Stansbury has guided 10 State squads (6 NCAA & 4 NIT) to postseason tournament appearances and nine clubs to 20-plus wins campaigns.

MSU has averaged 21.3 wins the last six years (2006-11), including winning an outright SEC overall championship in 2004, along with back-to-back SEC West crowns in the 2003-2004 and 2007-2008 seasons and another in 2010, and SEC Tournament titles in 2002 and 2009.

Most recently, Stansbury piloted last year's 17-14 State squad to a second place finish in the Western Division, but missed out on a post-season berth for the first time in five seasons.

From 2001-05, he guided MSU to five-consecutive postseason tournament appearances for the first time in school history, including a streak of four straight NCAA Tournament berths from 2002 through 2005.

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. With the 12-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's 13 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 166-43 (.794) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 76-28 (.731) SEC mark and a 90-15 (.857) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 372-141 (.725) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S SUMMER SPENT PLAYING FIVE GAMES IN THREE EUROPEAN COUNTRIES

Mississippi State traveled the world this season, spending time in the Netherlands, Belgium and France playing basketball against pro and club teams.

In five games, the Bulldogs posted a 5-0 record and averaged 93.6 points while allowing just 71.4 points.

MSU had four players that averaged in double-digits, led by Arnett Moultrie's 16.8 clip. DeVille Smith was next at 15.4, followed by Wendell Lewis and Rodney Hood and 13.4 and 11.0 points, respectively.

From a rebounding standpoint, Moultrie led the way with his 11.2 average, followed by Lewis and Bryant at 6.0 and 4.8 boards, respectively.

Since Rick Stansbury took over at MSU, only Kentucky and Florida won more games.
