MSU NO STRANGER TO WOODEN CLASSIC, ANAHEIM

Mississippi State is playing in the Wooden Classic for the second time in school history, while also visiting Anaheim for the third time.

The Bulldogs' first action in the Wooden Classic resulted in a 68-64 loss to Arizona on Dec. 5, 2004. In December of 2007, MSU participated in the Anaheim Classic, defeating UC Irvine (68-53) before losing to Southern Illinois (63-49) and Miami-Ohio (67-60).

VARNADO'S COUNTDOWN TO HISTORY

Following his three-block performance against DePaul, **Jarvis Varnado** now has a nation-best 40 for the year and 434 for his career.

As a result, the Brownsville, Tenn., native is 101 shy of tying the NCAA mark of 535 held by former Louisiana-Monroe standout Wojciech Mydra (1998-2002).

Varnado, who has led the nation the past two years in this category, is currently 10th all-time, three behind Lorenzo Coleman (Tennessee Tech) for the 9th most.

To get the record by the end of the regular season, Varnado needs to average 4.4 blocks in the next 23 games.

JOINING ELITE COMPANY

With his 14-rebound effort against DePaul, **Jarvis Varnado** became on the fourth active player to have more than 800 rebounds (809), 1,000 points (1,020) and 100 blocks (434). He joins Damion James (Texas), Joseph Harris (Coastal Carolina) and Trevor Booker (Clemson).

GRANT'S LAST CALL

Mississippi State and UCLA have only met once on the hardcourt, and that came in the Sweet 16 round of the 1995 NCAA Tournament with the Bruins staking an 86-67 victory in Oakland, Calif.

Current head coach Rick Stansbury was an assistant for then head coach Richard Williams, while current assistant **Marcus Grant** was a starting guard.

The game was the last of Grant's collegiate career, and his final outing wearing the Maroon & White saw him score two points, dish out three assists and collect a game-high 10 rebounds in 27 minutes of action.

MSTATE 5-10 AGAINST Pac-10 FOES

Entering Saturday's showdown against UCLA, the Bulldogs are 5-10 against the 10 teams that currently comprise the Pacific-10 Conference.

Mississippi State has played every league foe and went 0-2 against conference members last year, losing 63-52 to Washington State in the Legends Classic in Newark, N.J., before dropping a 71-58 decision to Washington in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament in Portland, Ore.

MSU has face Arizona the most, going 1-2 against the Wildcats.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 10-6 ledger against non-conference foes coupled with this year's 6-2 mark, MSU has compiled a dominant 127-41 (.756) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 119-32 (.788) regular-season.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 188-27 when leading at halftime (6-0 this year); 166-32 (4-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 196-61 (6-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 190-69 (6-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 145-26 (5-1) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

DECEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 3-3 mark coupled with this year's 2-0 record, the Bulldogs are 66-15 (.815) in the month of December since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 124-39 (.761) in December.

STEWART, VARNADO CLOSING IN ON MILESTONES

From 2000-03, Derrick Zimmerman played in 127 games. From 1980-83, Kalpatrick Wells started 110 games.

Both are school records. Both are likely to fall later this year.

Currently, **Jarvis Varnado** has played in 113 and has drawn 91 starts, while fellow senior **Barry Stewart** has appeared in 113 games with 78 starts to his credit.

Stewart is also likely to break Jeff Malone's minutes-played record of 3,851. He currently has 3,463 and needs to average around 17 minutes for the rest of the regular season to set a new mark. Currently, he's averaging 32.9 minutes through the first eight games.

BULLDOGS TENACIOUS ON DEFENSE

After a rough start to open the year defensively, the Bulldogs have returned to their stingy form of play that's become synonymous under Rick Stansbury.

Mississippi State has held five opponents under 60 points and have won each outing. The 45 points MSU limited DePaul tied for the fifth fewest allowed under Stansbury.

The Bulldogs currently lead the SEC in scoring defense (59.), field goal defense (.373), rebounding (41.6) and rebounding margin (+9.5) and are second with 65 blocked shots.

2009-10 Bulldog Bites

AS THE MEN DO, SO DO THE WOMEN

●While the Mississippi State men led the SEC and was second in the nation in blocked shots (7.5) per outing last year, the Lady Bulldogs (6.2) finished tops in the SEC and fifth nationally. Jarvis Varnado leads the nation with 165 and Lady Bulldog standout Chanel Mokango was ninth with 97. MSU was the only BCS school where the men and the women led their conference in blocked shots.

MAKING THE 3S OFF THE COURT

●In the spring, MSU not only excelled on the court, it put up impressive numbers in the classroom, too. The 16 players on the roster posted an overall GPA of 2.68, the second-highest average in two years. Seven players finished with a GPA of 3.0 or better, while two had a 4.0.

OVERCOMING MAJOR DEFICITS

●Three times last year, MSU has rallied from double-digit deficits – Arkansas (15) and South Carolina twice (10 both times) . The most a Rick Stansbury-coached team has battled back from is 20 (Kentucky, 1-5-02).

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 43-12 mark for an .782 winning percentage. With a 13-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's first 11 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 139-34 (.803) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 65-23 (.739) SEC mark and a 74-11 (.871) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 345-132 (.723) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

BRYANT BECOMES FIRST MSU SIGNEE OF 2009-10 SIGNING CLASS

Mississippi State coach Rick Stansbury has announced his first signee of the 2009-10 class, standout guard Brian Bryant.

The 6-foot-3, 165-pound Albany, Ga., native is currently a sophomore at Northwest Florida State College, where he has guided his team to a 5-0 start and is averaging 20 points, 7.6 rebounds and 5.4 assists, while shooting 41 percent from 3-point territory.

Last year as a freshman, he was limited due to a hand injury.

Prior to enrolling at Northwest Florida, previously known as Okaloosa Walton, Bryant prepped four years at Dougherty High School, where he led his team to two regional titles and four playoff appearances.

As a senior, he averaged 29.6 points, 9.3 rebounds, 3.6 steals and

3.6 assists en route to garnering team MVP honors and earning Albany Herald Play of the Year honors for the second-straight season.

He was also selected to play in the Georgia North-South All-Star Game.

"He is the complete package of talent, athleticism, character and work ethic," 13th-year Raiders coach Bruce Stewart said. "He is a winner."

Bryant chose MSU over Auburn and Southern Miss.

Bryant is the fifth NWF State College men's player to head to the SEC in the last three seasons, following in the footsteps of Auburn's Tay Waller and Johnnie Lett, Alabama's Charvez Davis and South Carolina's Johnndre Jefferson.
