#### BULLDOGS LOOK TO AVOID TWO-GAME SLIDE AT THE HUMP

After dropping a 70-64 decision to Charlotte on Wednesday for its first home loss of the season, Mississippi State now looks to avoid its first two-game losing streak at the Hump since losing back-to-back games against Florida and South Carolina in January of 2007. The Bulldogs had won nine games in a row, dating back to last year, and 13 of their last 14.

Junior forward Jarvis Varnado has made a name for himself in blocking shots, and rightfully so. After all, he leads the nation with 56 and swatted away a school-record 157 last year. But he's also shown the propensity to be a great rebounder. Against Charlotte on Wednesday, he hauled in nine boards to give him 507 for his career. To move into the school's Top 20 list, he needs 64 more to tie Cameron Burns (1989-91) total of 571 set in 87 games. Hall of Famer Bailey Howell (1957-59) owns the record with 1.277 in just 75 games. In the last four years, Lawrence Roberts (654), Jamont Gordon (677) and Charles Rhodes (691) all joined the club.

#### LOWEST FG PRODUCTION SINCE . . .

Against Charlotte, Mississippi State hit just 17 of its 55 field-goal attempts. In the Rick Stansbury era (10plus years), that's the fifth fewest made. Four times MSU has managed to connect on just 17 shots, with the last coming against Loyola-Marymount in Starkville on Nov. 13, 2006.

Junior guard Barry Stewart has now attempted 406 career 3-pointers, the ninth most in school history. With two more, he'll tie Tang Hamilton's total of 408 set from 1998-01 for the eighth most in the MSU books. And with 16 more made 3-pointers, he'll move into a tie for sixth all-time with Winsome Frazier, who drained 160 from 2002-05. Then there's point guard Dee Bost, who needs just nine more assists to give him 50 on the year, which would put him in a tie for 10th with Tony Watts for the most by an Mississippi State freshman.

#### RARE LOSS TO BELOW .500 TEAM

Mississippi State's first two setbacks of the year came against two teams that had a combined one loss at the time - Washington State (4-0) and Texas Tech (5-1). Against the 49ers, the Bulldogs lost to a team for the first time with a losing record since dropping a 64-60 decision to Georgia in the semifinals of last year's SEC Tournament in Atlanta. That was MSU's only loss to a below-.500 team a year ago.

#### MSTATE 66-13 AGAINST SUN BELT CONFERENCE FOES

Entering Saturday's showdown against South Alabama, the Bulldogs are 66-13 against the 13 teams that currently comprise the Sun Belt Conference. The only league team MSU has yet to battle is Florida Atlantic.

MSU has faced Louisiana-Lafayette the most (15 games) and holds an 11-4 advantage. The second-most common foe are the Warkhawks of Louisiana-Monroe (14), a team the Bulldogs defeated earlier this year, 78-49. Mississippi State has also faced the Jaguars and Arkansas State 11 times.

#### MSU AIMS FOR CONTINUED NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 11-7 ledger against non-conference foes, Mississippi State has now compiled a dominant 118-37 (.761) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 108-28 (.794) regular-season mark versus non-league foes.

#### DECEMBER AND HOME DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 5-2 December record, the Bulldogs are 62-13 (.827) in the month of December since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 120-37 (.764) in December.

At home, MSU has put together a 127-29 (.814) mark at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's guidance, including a 60-20 (.750) SEC record and 67-9 (.882) ledger at home against non-conference foes.

The Bulldogs, who are 5-1 this year, had their nine-game winning streak at the Hump on Wednesday against Charlotte but have still won 13 out of the last 15. Prior to Wednesday's setback, MSU's last loss on its home floor came on Feb. 2, 2008, against Tennessee, 76-71. The Volunteers entered the game 18-2 and ranked No. 7 nationally.

#### MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era of Mississippi State hoops, the Bulldogs are: 171-25 when leading at halftime (6-0 this year); 151-30 when shooting 45 percent or better from the field (5-0); 176-55 when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field (6-2); 178-67 when out-rebounding or tying the opponent (5-1); and 132-24 when holding the opponent to 65 points or less (4-1).

#### NOW THAT HAS A FAMILIAR RING

Last year, the Bulldogs led the Southeastern Conference in scoring defense (65.5), field goal percentage defense (.370), rebounding offense (40.7) and blocked shots (7.85).

Compared to their nine games this season, the statistical numbers are quite similiar. So far, MSU is yielding just 63.4 points on just 35.4 percent shooting from the floor and grabbing 44 rebounds to go along with its 97 blocked shots. Jarvis Varnado, who led the nation a year ago with a school-record 157 blocks, has 56.

#### ALABAMA-MISSISSIPPI CONNECTIONS

Although South Alabama doesn't have any players on its roster from the Magnolia State, senior forward Ronald Douglas played at Gulf Coast Community College for two years.

Mississippi State has just one player on its roster from Alabama – walkon guard Rod Bryant (Birmingham), who prepped at G.W Carver High School. Bryant hasn't seen any action this year due to an injury he suffered in the preseason.

#### MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 31-7 mark for an .816 winning percentage. The Bulldogs reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's previous 10 seasons at the MSU helm and are on pace to do so again this year.

Mississippi State is now 127-29 (.814) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 60-20 (.750) SEC mark and a 67-9 (.882) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 32-season composite record of 333-127 (.724) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

Prior to Wednesday's loss to Charlotte, the Bulldogs had won nine games in a row at home, the longest streak since winning 12 straight at Humphrey Coliseum from Feb. 25, 2004, to Feb. 12, 2005. That streak started with an 84-58 win against LSU and ended with an 80-72 setback to LSU (Feb. 16, 2005).



#### MISSISSIPPI STATE PRESEASON AWARDS

In the 2008 Southeastern Conference media poll, Mississippi State, the two-time defending Western Division champions, was picked to finish fourth in the West behind Alabama, LSU and Ole Miss, respectively. From an individual standpoint, Bulldogs junior forward Jarvis Varnado was named first-team All-SEC by the league coaches, while the media voted him second-team back in October. Nationally, true freshman Dee Bost of Concord, N.C., was tabbed honorable mention freshman All-American by CollegeHoops.net.

### **EXHIBITION 1**

### MSU 88, Montevallo 59 Nov. 1, 2008 • Starkville, MS

In the season's first of two exhibition contests, Mississippi State rode a double-double performance from junior Jarvis Varnado to take care of visiting Montevallo 88-59 at Humphrey Coliseum.

Varnado, the reigning National Defensive Player of the Year, recorded 17 points on 7-of-9 shooting from the floor to go along with his game-high 12 rebounds. He also blocked eight shots after leading the nation in blocked shots a year ago with 157. Sophomore Ravern Johnson led all scorers on the night with an 8-of-14 performance from the field for a total of 19 points, while freshman Romero Osby pitched in the team's second double-double with 10 points and 11 boards. Dee Bost scored 13 points and handed out seven assists to just three turnovers in the win.

Junior guards Marcus Lancaster and Freddy Little led Montevallo in scoring with 10 points apiece on a collective 8-of-25 shooting performance, while junior forward Nate Flowers led the squad in rebounding with nine boards.

Ranking second nationally in team field-goal percentage defense last year, the Bulldogs followed suit by holding Montevallo to just 23-of-71 shooting from the floor for a 32.6% mark. Also specializing in blocks as a team by ranking second nationally in that category a year ago, MSU swatted 13 shots on the evening. Leading Montevallo in rebounding at halftime 32-21, State never let up and finished the game with a 62-37 advantage.

### **EXHIBITION 2**

### MSU 67, OKLAHOMA CITY 65 Nov. 8, 2008 • STARKVILLE, MS

Mississippi State utilized an 18-5 rally in the final minutes to overcome two-time defending NAIA national champion Oklahoma City 67-65 at Humphrey Coliseum in the season's final exhibition outing.

Junior Jarvis Varnado once again flirted with triple-double status in the contest by scoring 12 points, claiming a game-high 13 rebounds, and swatting eight shots after leading the nation in blocks a year ago. Varnado amassed 29 points, 25 rebounds and 16 blocks in State's two exhibition contests.

Senior Brian Johnson fell just a rebound shy of a double-double performance for the Bulldogs with 10 points on 5-of-7 shooting, while standout freshman Dee Bost tallied 11 points and six assists. Junior Barry Stewart and sophomore Ravern Johnson rounded out State scorers in double digits with 11 and 10 points, respectively.

Forward Jamarcus Ellis led the Stars with a game-high 26 points on 10-of-24 shooting along with five rebounds. Senior Sao Paulo, Brazil native Ricardo De Bem pitched in 11 points and seven rebounds while junior Davell Jackson also contributed 11 points.

The Bulldogs never led until the 1:41 mark of the second half when Ravern Johnson drained a 3-pointer for a 65-63 advantage. However, the Stars answered and evened the score on an Ellis jumper, but with 1:23 left, Varnado gave MSU the lead for good on a dunk.

### GAME 1

### MSU 77, CENTENARY 55 Nov. 15, 2008 • STARKVILLE, MS

Mississippi State's Ravern Johnson hit five 3-point baskets and scored a team-high 15 points as the Bulldogs defeated Centenary College 77-55 in a season-opening men's basketball game at Humphrey Coliseum.

The Bulldogs scored the game's first seven points and never trailed in the contest. MSU improved to 9-2 in season openers under coach Rick Stansbury and 76-21 all-time.

MSU set the tone from 3-point range early. Dee Bost and Johnson hit back-to-back 3-pointers to help the Bulldogs spring from the gates. Those two treys would be the first of 10 for the hosts in the contest. The early lead stretched to double digits at 17-7 on a jumper from Riley Benock.

In the opening half, the Bulldogs used a five-on-five rotation as the search for consistency and set lineups will continue in non-conference play. Another 7-0 run allowed the Bulldogs to take their largest first-half lead, at 30-15. In the opening half, the Bulldogs only shot 36.7 percent from the field, yet managed a 34-20 lead at the intermission.

In the second half, the defensive pressure allowed the lead to grow quickly. A jumper by Jacquiese Holcombe ran the advantage to 51-31 with 13:03 remaining. MSU took its largest lead at 27 points on two different occasions in the closing minutes.

Also scoring in double-digits for MSU were Barry Stewart and Elgin Bailey with 13 and 10 points, respectively.

Nick Stallings paced the Gents with 16 points.

### MSU 78, LOUISIANA-MONROE 49 Nov. 17, 2008 • STARKVILLE, MS

Junior guard Barry Stewart connected on three of his six attempts from long range and scored 17 points to lead the Mississippi State Bulldogs to a commanding 78-49 victory against the visiting Louisiana-Monroe Warhawks.

Stewart finished the game 6-of-9 shooting to go along with an assist, block and steal. Jarvis Varnado swatted nine shots by halftime and finished with that total to go with 11 rebounds for the game. Outstanding freshman point guard Dee Bost handed out seven assists and shot 3 of 6 from behind the arc to score 14 points.

Sophomore big men Elgin Bailey and Kodi Augustus notched nine and eight boards, respectively, while sophomore shooting specialist Ravern Johnson grabbed four rebounds and scored 10 points. Augustus also scored a career-high 12 points.

Starkville native, junior Jarvis Hill led the Warhawks with 19 points on 8-of-17 shooting and four rebounds.

State suffocated ULM from the tip as the Warhawks connected on just three of their first 16 attempts from the floor. Conversely, State drained five of their first seven treys and never trailed en route to a 35-24 advantage at the half.

MSU quickly stormed out to a 55-35 lead in the second stanza on an 18-4 run, capped by a made three-point conversion from the charity stripe by Bailey. From that point forward the Bulldogs dominated the game, finishing on a 10-2 streak.

### GAME 3

### MSU 102, NORTH ALABAMA 61 Nov. 19, 2008 • STARKVILLE, MS

Junior Jarvis Varnado blocked seven shots and matched a career-high 16 points to power the Bulldogs to a 102-61 victory against the North Alabama Lions in first-round action of the Legends Classic at Humphrey Coliseum.

He also slammed the boards for 14 rebounds to record his first double-double of the young season. Tying for the team lead was fellow junior Barry Stewart, who drained 3of-5 treys for 16 points. Sophomores Elgin Bailey and Kodi Augustus continued their solid play with a combined 18 points and 12 rebounds, while Bailey had 10 points.

Freshman Romero Osby finished with 15 points, while Dee Bost tallied 10 assists.

MSU, which hasn't trailed at all this year, stormed out of the gates behind three Varnado blocks in the first three minutes, while hitting five of their first seven attempts from the floor. Midway through the first half, State staked a 20-2 run, sparked by back-to-back threes from Osby and sophomore Riley Benock to hold a 48-30 halftime advantage.

North Alabama took the initiative into the second stanza, however, by scoring six straight points to start the half.

MSU eclipsed the 100-point mark for the first time since scoring 101 against Bradley in the second round of the NIT in 2007, while State's bench accomplished a rare feat by combining for an impressive total of 47 points

Following suit, the Dawgs put up an outstanding number on the boards, outrebounding UNA, 51-27.

Junior Jarvis Varnado blocked eight shots and became Mississippi State's all-time leader in that category as the Bulldogs upended Fairleigh Dickinson in the second round of the Legends Classic, 84-58, at Humphrey Coliseum.

Varnado, who also recorded his second-straight doubledouble with 14 points and 16 rebounds, broke Erick Dampier's total of 249 blocks set from 1994-96.

As a team, MSU swatted away 15 shots, one shy of tying the school record set last year against Georgia.

The Bulldogs, who led from start to finish, also forced 19 turnovers and collected seven steals, while limiting the Knights to 16-of-66 shooting after misfiring on their first 16

Offensively, Barry Stewart and Ravern Johnson rounded out the double-digit scoring with 12 and 11 points, respectively.

Sophomore Phil Turner tied a season high with eight points on 3-of-4 shooting while freshman Twany Beckham notched two steals and four points in his Maroon and White debut

FDU junior guard Cameron Tyler hit just 3 of his 15 attempts from the floor but managed 16 points to lead the Knights in scoring, followed by Terence Grier with 10.

MSU freshman point guard Dee Bost handed out six assists to give him an SEC-best 27, and the Bulldogs improved to 4-0 for the first time since 2003-04.

The Bulldogs won their first road game of the young season and moved to 5-0 for the first time since the 2003-04 squad won their first 13 games. Still, the contest was not without its dramatic moments at the end. MSU appeared to have things well in hand, taking a 63-48 lead with 9:31 remaining.

A spirited second-half rally fell short as Mississippi State dropped a 63-52 decision to Washington State in a semifinal round matchup of the Legends Classic at the Prudential Center.

The Bulldogs trailed by as many as 17 midway through the second half. A 9-0 run helped MSU cut the deficit to six before a more-experienced Cougars squad pulled away for the final margin.

MSU lost for the first time on the young season, falling to 5-1. Washington State, a member of the Pac 10 Conference, improved to 5-0.

The lead changed hands on a couple of occasions in the opening half. A Barry Stewart 3-point basket gave MSU its largest lead of the afternoon at 18-15, but WSU ended the half on a 20-8 run. That run including a pair of baskets from Aron Baynes, who was 6 of 6 in the opening half.

Varnado recorded several career highs in the game, including 22 points on a career-most 10 made field goals in just 13 attempts. Varnado also notched nine boards and eight swats.

Following just behind Varnado was outstanding sophomore shooting guard Ravern Johnson, who also set a new career mark in points scored with 21 on a career-best seven field goals made.
