WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS CINCINNATI...

- The last time Mississippi State and Cincinnati met was in the 2008 SEC/Big East Challenge, while its last win against the Bearcats in March of 1996 punched a ticket to the Final Four.
- The Bulldogs are looking for their first 9-0 start since opening the 2003-04 campaign 13-0.
- MSU has played 10 of the 12 teams from the American Athletic Conference and is 78-65 against those squads. The last AAC team the Bulldogs played was Central Florida a year ago, an 88-61 loss in Charleston, S.C. MSU hasn't played Temple and SMU.
- The Bulldogs are the only undefeated SEC team and one of seven teams nationally.
- Mississippi State is one of only three schools nationally whose men's and women's basketball teams are undefeated — Villanova and Florida State.
- Freshman guard Nick Weatherspoon has accounted for seven of MSU's nine charges taken.
- After collecting 9 blocked shots against North Georgia, MSU moved atop the SEC standings and is now sixth nationally at 6.6.
- For the first time in his career, MSU coach Ben Howland is 200 games above .500.
- Quinndary Weatherspoon is now 55 points shy of becoming the 37th player in school history to reach 1,000 for a career following his season-high 22-point performance against North Georgia.
- Aric Holman is now tied with Derrick Zimmerman for the ninth most blocks in school history with 89 after collecting two against North Georgia.
- The Bulldogs lead the SEC and are 21st nationally in fewest points allowed at 61.9.
- The only players to start all games are Nick Weatherspoon and Quinndary Weatherspoon.
- MSU has shot 45 percent or better from the floor in all eight games, with four games .500 or better. The Dogs' .496 percentage is third in the SEC and 34th nationally.
- Defensively, Mississippi State has held seven of its eight opponents below 39 percent shooting (Dayton, .457) and is second in the SEC in field goal percentage defense and 17th nationally at .375.
- The Bulldogs are looking to snap a 17-game losing skid to ranked teams.

A CLOSER LOOK AT MSU

VOTE GETTERS

■ In the Associated Poll released on Dec. 11, Mississippi State received eight votes.

The Bulldogs haven't been ranked since the 2012 campaign.

Q & GAME WINNERS

■ Another game, another game winner.

On Dec. 3 against Dayton, junior All-SEC guard **Quinndary Weatherspoon** collected a steal with 4 seconds left and went the length of the court for a layup to give MSU a thrilling 61-59 win.

Then against Jacksonville State back in November, he drained a 3-pointer with 0.7 seconds left to lift the Bulldogs to a dramatic 59-56 win.

As a freshman against Vanderbilt, he drained a buzzer beater from 3-point range for a 75-74 victory.

SEC HONORS CARTER

■ On Dec. 4, sophomore guard Tyson Carter became the first MSU player to receive one of the SEC's weekly honors.

After pouring in a career-best 35 points against North Dakota State and 20 againt Dayton, he was tabbed the league's player of the week.

His 35 points were the most scored since Darryl Wilson also had 35 against Alabama on 3-4-95.

BLOCK PARTY

■ Against Florida A&M on Nov. 18, Mississippi State recorded 13 blocked shots, with sophomore forward **Schnider Herard** leading the way with a career-high 6.

For MSU, it was the most blocks since also having 13 against Arkansas on Jan. 14, 2010.

The 6 blocks by Herard were also the most since Aric Holman had 5

last year against Northwestern St. MSU leads the SEC at 6.6

SEEING DOUBLE

■ Last year, Aric Holman and Schnider Herard recorded four of MSU's five double-doubles, while Xavian Stapleton had one.

In the season opener against Alabama State, Holman wasted little time adding to his total.

The junior forward tied his career highs in points (18) and rebounds (11) to give him three for his career.

Against Green Bay, Abdul Ado broke into the category for his first with 12 points and 11 rebounds in just his second game at MSU.

Then against Dayton, **Quinndary Weatherspoon** had 11 points and 10 rebounds for his third-career double-double.

BROTHERLY LOVE

■ Mississippi State is one of 29 schools nationally with brothers on the same team with **Quinndary** and **Nick Weatherpsoon**.

They've also started all seven games.

The last time MSU had two brothers start in the same game was Reginald and Reggie Delk against West Virginia in the NIT Final Four on March 27, 2007.

YOUTHFULL GROUP

■ The Bulldogs are one of five teams without any scholarship seniors, along with Kentucky, Holy Cross, Chattanooga and Robert Morris.

MSU's experience is ranked No. 331 out of 351 schools.

2 FOR 20

■ Against Green Bay, MSU had two players score 20-plus points — Tyson Carter (25) and Quinndary Weatherspoon (20).

It was the first time the Bulldogs

had two players score 20-plus points in the same game since **Quinndary Weatherspoon** had 25 and **Lamar Peters** 23 at Auburn on Feb. 7, 2017.

JUST 6 AT CHARITY STRIPE

■ In the 59-56 win against Jacksonville State, MSU limited the Gamecocks to just six free throw attempts.

It was the fewest attempts by an opponent since Georgia State had only six last year on Dec. 4, 2016.

JSU's six made were also the fewest since Georgia State had four on the same date.

WHEN Q HITS 20

When junior guard Quinndary Weatherspoon scores 20 or more points, Mississippi State benefits.

He's now reached that feat 12 in his career and The Bulldogs are 10-2 in those games.

■ On Jan. 17, 2017, against Kentucky, MSU played its 600th in Humphrey Coliseum history, which dates to Dec. 1, 1975.

The Bulldogs are now 436-178 in the building following the North Georgia win.

MSU VERSUS RANKED FOES

■ Entering Tuesday's game at Cinncinnati, Mississippi State has lost 17-straight games to ranked opponents.

MSU SIGNS 3

■ Mississippi State took advantage of the early signing period and landed 5-star forward Reggie Perry and 4-star forwards DJ Stewart and Robert

Woodard.

Perry, a 6-foot-8, 240-pound Thomasville, Ga., native, is the son of former MSU great AI Perry (1975-78), who ranks third all-time at MSU with 510 steals.

He's rated as the No. 1 prospect out of the state of Georgia and listed as the No. 4 small forward nationally.

ESPN has him as the 16th best player regardless of position.

Woodard, the top-ranked player in Mississippi and a Dandy Dozen selection, is ranked 56th overall nationally and is the son of Robert Woodard, Sr., who played at MSU from 1987-90.

He led Columbus to the Class 6A crown in 2016 and was last year's Gatorade Player of the year.

The 6-6, 187-pound Stewart is listed as the 33rd best small forward.

As a junior at Riverside last year, he averaged 18.9 points, 9.7 rebounds and 3.1 assists.

Nationally, Scout has him as the 103rd best player overall, while Rivals has him at 103.

Ben Howland 22nd Season Overall | 3rd Season At Mississippi State 439-239 (38-33 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015. Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 435-239 record -Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (38-33).
- · Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division I his-

tory to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).

- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regularseason title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- · Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children Meredith and Adam (Brittney) - and two grandsons, Benjamin Clark Howland II and Elijah Howland.
