MSU IS 50-4 ALL-TIME AGAINST SOUTHLAND FOES

Entering Friday's game against Southeastern Louisiana in Tupelo, the Bulldogs sport a dominating 50-4 ledger against the 14 teams that currently comprise the Southland Conference.

MSU has played 10 of the league members, with the Lions being the most common foe as Friday marks the 19th meeting between the two.

The last Southland Conference team MSU faced was New Orleans last year in Starkville, a game MSU won, 97-46.

MSU BREAKS TREND AGAINST KSU & MVSU

After losing 16-straight games when the opponent shoots 45 percent or better, Mississippi State won two straight under the same circumstances prior to Utah State.

Against Kennesaw State, MSU won despite the Owls shooting 45.5 percent from the floor.

Then against Mississippi Valley State, the Bulldogs claimed a 94-72 victory with the Delta Devils shooting 47.5 percent (28-59).

Utah State, though, won after hitting 28 of its 54 shots (.519). MSU also lost to a TCU team that shot 45.5 percent.

SCOUTING SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA

Southeastern Louisiana enters Friday's games sporting a 3-5 ledger after dropping a hard-fought 74-73 affair to Southeast Missouri on Dec. 7 despite leading 39-32 at the break.

It was the Lions' third-straight setback and fourth in their last five games.

Antonnio Benton paced SELU with 21 points, followed by Devonte Upson and Jeffery Ricard with 13 and 12 points, respectively. Benton also had a team-high 9 rebounds.

The Lions hit 29 of their 66 shots and turned the basketball over just seven times. But they lost the battle of the boards, 35-39.

LAST TIME OUT FOR MSU . . .

Mississippi State saw its seven-game home winning streak snapped with a 71-61 setback to TCU on Dec. 5 in the Big 12/SEC Challenge.

With the score tied at 6-apiece early in the contest, the Horned Frogs took the lead for good on a 3-pointer by Kyan Anderson and never looked back.

Craig Sword finished with a game-high 24 points for the second game in a row, and he also collected five steals. He was the lone MSU player in double digits.

Roquez Johnson and **Gavin Ware** paced the Bulldogs with six rebounds, but TCU won the overall battle, 34-32.

MSU connected on 24 of its 56 shots but converted 17 turnovers into just 12 points while committing 15 turnovers.

The Horned Frogs were 20-of-44 shooting overall and 6 of 14 beyond the arc.

SWORD, JOHNSON REPRESENTING

■ First, Craig Sword and Roquez Johnson were teammates at Carver High School in Montgomery, Ala., where they won a state championship together.

Now, the two are in the Top 3 at MSU in scoring as Sword is averaging 14.3 points and Johnson 11.0. Second is Gavin Ware of Starkville at 11.3 points.

Sword had a season-high 24 points against Loyola and TCU, while Johnson has scored in double-digits five of State's seven games. Against Loyola, he had career highs in points (20) and rebounds (11).

MSU TO MAKE APPEARANCE IN LAS VEGAS CLASSIC IN DECEMBER

■ The week of Christmas, Mississippi State will travel to Nevada to participate in the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic.

The Bulldogs open with South Florida and will then play either Santa Clara or UNLV.

MSU last played in the Classic in 2001, posting a 3-1 mark with wins against UL-Monroe, Richmond and Illinois-Chicago while losing to Cincinnati.

BULLDOGS 2013-14 ROSTER FEATURES FEW NEW FACES

■ The Bulldogs roster features just one new scholarship player eligible for this season freshman point guard I.J. Ready.

The Bulldogs also signed Fallou Ndoye, but he is redshirting this season.

Head Coach Rick Ray

- On April 1, 2012, Rick Ray was named the 19th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In his first season at MSU, produced two players to the SEC All-Freshman team Gavin Ware and Craig Sword



- On the staff of three different teams that have advanced to the NCAA Tournament — Indiana State, Purdue and Clemson.
- As an assistant at Clemson for two years, the Tigers won 38 games and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2011.
- During his time at Purdue as an assistant, the Boilermakers won 103 games in four years.
- All four teams at Purdue earned a berth in the NCAA Tournament, with the last two advancing to the Sweet 16.
- The 2009 Purdue team won 28 games and the Big 10 Tournament en route to garnering a No. 5 seed.
- While at Purdue, Ray was an assistant with second-year Tennessee coach Cuonzo Martin.
- The 2007 Purdue recruiting was considered one of the tops in the country, earning national rankings of No. 5 and No. 6 by Scout and Rivals, respectively.
- Ray was an assistant at Indiana State for seven years.
- In 2000 and 2001, the Sycamores won 20plus games and made the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2000, the ISU won the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title with a 14-4 ledger
- In 2001, Indiana State won the MVC Tournament before upsetting Oklahoma in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Ray also spent two seasons at Northern Illinois (2005 and 2006).
- Ray's first coaching job was at Nebraska-Omaha.
- Ray and his wife, Breyana, have two sons, Deacon and Mason, and one daughter, Katriece.





The dynamic duo of Craig Sword outside and Roquez Johnson inside lifted Mississippi State to a 65-64 overtime win against Loyola.

The teams were playing the "Game of Change" to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the two schools' historic meeting in the 1963 NCAA Tournament.

The contest was nip-and-tuck throughout. The score was tied 13 times and the lead changed hands 20 times. The largest lead for Loyola was seven points in the first half and the largest lead for MSU was six points in the second half.

Sword scored 24 points to lead the Bulldogs' offensive efforts. Johnson poured in a career-high 20 points.

The Bulldogs struggled out of the gates early offensively. MSU held a 9-8 lead before Loyola reeled off a 10-2 run for an 18-11 lead.

A late rally fell short as the Mississippi State dropped a 71-61 decision to TCU in the Big 12/ SEC Challenge.

MSU managed two two-point leads early in the game. TCU took advantage of the early offensive struggles to build a comfortable lead.

TCU built a 19-8 lead, as MSU did not reach double digits scoring until 11 minutes had been played. In the opening half, MSU shot 36 percent from the field and trailed 34-22 at the intermission

TCU stretched the lead to 18 at 45-27 with less than five minutes gone by in the second half. MSU turned up the intensity on both ends of the floor and made a run.

Still down 18 at 52-34, the Bulldogs trimmed the deficit to 10 points at 55-45 on a three-pointer by Ready. A jumper by Roquez Johnson capped a 16-4 run as MSU closed within 59-56 with 2:28 left in the contest.

The Bulldogs turned the ball over the next possession and the Horned Frogs hit 10 of 12 free throws to seal the victory.

For the contest, the Bulldogs hit 24 of 56 shots from the field (42.9 percent), 3 of 18 shots from 3-point range (16.7 percent) and 10 of 20 shots from the foul line (50.0 percent). The Horned Frogs hit 20 of 44 shots from the field (45.5 percent), 6 of 14 shots from 3-point range (42.9 percent) and 25 of 31 shots from the foul line (80.6 percent).

TCU held a 34-32 rebounding advantage. The Bulldogs had nine assists and 15 turn-overs, while the Horned Frogs had seven assists and 17 turnovers.
