#### WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS EAST TENNESSEE STATE . . .

- Quinndary Weatherspoon is now 19 points shy of 500 for his career.
- After shooting just 16.7 percent from the foul line last season as a freshman, sophomore forward Aric Holman has improved dramatically early on, draining 18 of his 24 attempts (.750).
- In its last outing against Georgia State, MSU made a season-high 13 3-pointers, its most since draining 15 against North Carolina A&T on 12-12-10.
- The 22-point margin of defeat was also the largest this year.
- In addition, the game produced career high in points for Lamar Peters (24), Mario Kegler (16) and Schnider Herard (8).
- MSU is 42-13 against the 10 teams that currently comprise the Southern Conference. Samford (25-6) is the team the Bulldogs have played the most, while Western Carolina is last foe MSU played (a 66-56 win on Nov. 17, 2015).
- Mississippi State is looking for its first 7-2 start since opening the 2013-14 campaign 9-2.
- I.J. Ready is now 234 points shy of becoming the 37th player in MSU history to score 1,000 for a career. He also needs just 11 assists to move into the MSU all-time Top 10. In addition, he is 14 steals shy of moving in the MSU Top 10 record book.
- In his last four games, I.J. Ready has dished out 21 assists and collected 12 steals while turning the ball over just 10 times. He's fourth in the SEC with a 2.7 turnover/assist ratio, 62nd nationally.
- According to KenPom.com, Mississippi State is the least experienced team (.71) out of all 351 Division I programs.
- The Bulldogs are looking for their first four-game winning streak under Ben Howland.
- When is Mississippi State successful? When shooting 45 percent of better (5-0), outrebounding foes (5-0), dishing out more assists (6-0) and winning or being tied at the half (6-0).
- MSU is second in the SEC and 19th nationally with its .772 free throw percentage.
- Of current SEC players, I.J. Ready is 10th with 766 points, third with 125 steals and fourth with 315 assists. He reached the 300 mark with assists against Northwestern State.

#### LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

■ In the season-opener against Norfolk State, freshman guard **Tyson Carter** drew the start.

28 years ago, his father, Greg, drew a start on opening day against Christian Brothers as a freshman.

While Tyson poured in 17 points on 6-of-8 shooting with five made 3-pointers, Greg was 5-6 with 10 points.

■ Ben Howland enters his second season at Mississippi State looking to achieve a feat only 12 coaches have ever done, and that's lead four different teams to the NCAA Tournament.

Howland has already guided Northern Arizona, Pittsburgh and UCLA to the Big Dance.

The first 12 coaches to do so are Lon Kruger, Steve Alford, John Beilein, Lefty Driesell, Cliff Ellis, Larry Eustachy, Jim Harrick, Fran McCaffery, Tom Penders, Tubby Smith, Rick Pitino and Eddie Sutton.

### A CLOSER LOOK AT MSU

#### **WEATHERSPOON REACHES 400**

■ In the loss to Central Florida on Nov. 17, **Quinndary Weatherspoo**n scored 19 points to give him 400 for his career.

Through his first 37 games, he now has 481 points.

#### FRESHMAN SCORING

■ Tyson Carter is averaging 10.6 points, the most for a freshman since Jamont Gordon averaged 13.8 in 2005-06.

Right now, that would rank 10th-best all-time. Rickey Brown's average of 19.3 in 1977 is the freshman record.

#### **BULLDOGS SIGN 3**

■ Mississippi State took advantage of the early signing period Wednesday and signed three players — two 4-stars and and one 3-star — to give MSU its second Top 15 signing class in a row.

Joining MSU next season are guards Nick Weatherspoon (Velma Jackson) of Canton, Miss., and KeyShawn Feazell (Lawrence County) of Monticello, Miss., and forward Garrison Brooks (Auburn High School) of Lafayette, Ala.

Weatherspoon is the younger brother MSU sophomore standout **Quinndary Weatherspoon**, while Brooks is the son of MSU assistant coach, **George Brooks**.

#### **BROOKS NOTED FOR RECRUITING**

■ In this year's Sporting News preseason basketball publication, MSU assistant **George Brooks** was named the second best recruiting in the SEC.

Brooks, a 1996 MSU graduate, has been an assistant with the Bulldogs for seven years after serving as head coach at Meridian Community College.

He's been responsible for signing top talent such as **Quinndary Weatherspoon**, **Mario Kegler** and Garrison Brooks.

#### 2-1 IN CHARLESTON

■ Mississippi State posted a 2-1 ledger in the Charleston Classic with wins against Boise State and UTEP.

The lone loss came against Central Florida. MSU is now 92-81 all-time in regular-season tournaments.

#### HARDCOURT ROBBERY

■ Three times this year, Mississippi State has collected 11 or more steals.

Against Oregon State, the Bulldogs were credited with 17 steals, the most since also having 17 against Florida Atlantic on 11-13-12.

The Bulldogs are second in the SEC with their 9.0 average, tied for 19th nationally.

Individually, **Quinndary Weatherspoon** leads the league with his 2.7 steals, while **I.J. Ready** is third at 2.1. On the national scene, that's 13th and 45th, respectively.

#### WELCOMING NEW COMPETITION

■ The Bulldogs' first five games this season were against first-time foes.

Those newcomers were Norfolk State, Central Florida, Boise State, UTEP and Lehigh.

MSU has faced all remaining teams at least once.

#### **WRIGHT MOVE**

■ Eli Wright earned his first-career start against Northwestern State and responded with 11 points on 4-of-5 shooting to go along with his 7 rebounds.

In his last two games, he's totaled 21 points on 7-of-9 shooting to go along with his 10 rebounds, 3 steals and 2 assists.

The freshman has appeared in all 8 games.

#### **WALK-ON SUCCESS**

■ Against Northwestern State, walk-on **Nick Singleton** came off the bench and provided a much-needed spark for the Bulldogs.

In 13 minutes, he totaled 5 points. He entered the game having played just two minutes.

He's now appeared in three games and is averaging 1.7 points in 16 minutes of action.

#### **ALL-TOURNAMENT**

■ Quinndary Weatherspoon earned All-Tournament honors at the Gildan Charleston Classic after scoring a career-high 25 points against Boise State.

He also totaled 19 points against Central Florida and 9 against UTEP, his last game of year due to his season-ending wrist injury.

#### **CAREER GAMES**

■ Both sophomore **Aric Holman** and freshman **Lamar Peters** had career games against UTEP in terms of scoring.

Holman poured in 18 in the Bulldogs' 61-54 victory, while Peters totaled 13.

All four of Peters' field goals were from 3-point range. On the year, the New Orleans native is 7-17 beyond the arc. In his last two games, he's averaging 12.0 points.

Holman has scored 10-plus points in five of MSU's seven games. Last year in 26 appearances, he never reached double digits.

#### TAKING ADVANTAGE OF CHARITY

■ Mississippi State is second in the SEC with its 77.2 percentage at the free throw line.

On the year, the Bulldogs are 112 of 145, having shot 82 percent or better in three games.

In their last outing against Georgia State, they were 7-9.

**Tyson Carter** is tops on the team with 20-plus attempts at .864, while **Quinndary Weatherspoon** is second at .862.

Also shooting better than 80 percent with at least 15 attempts is **Eli Wright** (12-15).

Nationally, the Bulldogs are 19th.

#### LARGEST SETBACK AT HOME

■ The 14-point loss to Lehigh on Nov. 25 was the largest non-conference home game since also losing by 14 to McNeese State on 12-30-14.

It was also the largest setback at the Hump with **Ben Howland** at the helm.

#### **DEFENSIVE EFFORTS**

■ In the last three games, Mississippi State has forced 58 turnovers, the best three-game stretch of the season.

The high mark was 21 against Oregon State, which MSU converted into 28 points. That was the most forced since last year against South Carolina on Feb. 27 at the Hump.

#### Ben Howland 21th Season Overall | 2nd Season At Mississippi State 421-225 (20-19 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015, Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 421-225 record – Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (20-19).
- Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division

I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).

- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- This past year, Howland was inducted into both the Northern Arizona and Weber State hall of fames.
- Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children Meredith and Adam (Brittney) – and two grandsons, Benjamin Clark Howland II and Elijah Howland.
