### JOHNSON TABBED SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

It shouldn't come as a surprise that Ravern Johnson collected his first SEC player of the week honor on Monday.

In two games last week against DePaul and UCLA, the junior guard from Lyon, Miss., averaged 21.5 points and five rebounds per game as the Dawgs rolled to a 76-45 win against the Blue Demons in Tampa, Fla., at the SEC/Big East Challenge and a 72-54 triumph against the Bruins at the John Wooden Classic in Anaheim, Calif.

After totaling 14 points against DePaul, Johnson lit up UCLA for a career-high 29 points, the most by a Bulldog this season, on 80-percent shooting (12-of-15). He connected on five of his eight attempts from beyond the arc, pushing his team lead to 27 three-pointers on the season as MSU defeated the Bruins for the first time in school history.

He currently leads MSU going into the Wright State contest with a 14.4 scoring clip.

### VARNADO'S COUNTDOWN TO HISTORY

Following his seven-block performance against UCLA, Jarvis Varnado now has a nation-best 47 for the year and 441 for his career.

As a result, the Brownsville, Tenn., native is 94 shy of tying the NCAA mark of 535 held by former Louisiana-Monroe standout Wojciech Mydra (1998-2002).

Varnado, who has led the nation the past two years in this category, is currently tied for 8th all-time with Connecticut's Emeka Okafor.

To get the record by the end of the regular season, Varnado needs to average 4.3 blocks in the next 22 games.

### FIRST-HALF CLAMP DOWN

In the last three games, opponents have discovered scoring against MSU's defense in the first half can be quite laborious.

In those outings, MSU has yielded just 56 points in the opening frame, an average of 18.7 points

### **MSTATE 1-4 AGAINST HORIZON LEAGUE FOES**

Entering Wednesday's showdown against Wright State, the Bulldogs are 1-4 against the 10 teams that currently comprise the Horizon League.

However, Mississippi State has only played five of the teams. The schools MSU hasn't faced are Cleveland State, Green Bay, Milwaukee, Wright State and Youngstown State.

The last league foe the Bulldogs battled was Butler. That came in the first round of the 2003 NCAA Tournament in Birmingham, Ala., when Butler won a heartbreaker at the buzzer, 47-46.

### MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 10-6 ledger against non-conference foes coupled with this year's 7-2 mark, MSU has compiled a dominant 128-41 (.757) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 120-32 (.789) regular-season.

### MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 189-27 when leading at halftime (7-0 this year); 167-32 (5-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 197-61 (7-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 190-69 (6-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 146-26 (6-1) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

### **DECEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY**

Including last year's 3-3 mark coupled with this year's 3-0 record, the Bulldogs are 67-15 (.817) in the month of December since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 125-39 (.762) in December.

### STEWART, VARNADO CLOSING IN ON MILESTONES

From 2000-03, Derrick Zimmerman played in 127 games. From 1980-83, Kalpatrick Wells started 110 games.

Both are school records. Both are likely to fall later this year.

Currently, **Jarvis Varnado** has played in 114 and has drawn 92 starts, while fellow senior **Barry Stewart** has appeared in 114 games with 79 starts to his credit.

Stewart is also likely to break Jeff Malone's minutes-played record of 3,851. He currently has 3,500 and needs to average around 17 minutes for the rest of the regular season to set a new mark. Currently, he's averaging 33.3 minutes through the first eight games.

### **RAINING 3s...AGAIN**

Last year, Mississippi State set a single-season record in 3-pointers made by draining 296. Already, the Bulldogs are ahead of the pace they established a year ago.

To date, MSU has connected on 92 of its 223 attempts (.413) through the first nine games. In comparison, State was 65 of 175 (.371) through the first nine games last year.

If the Bulldogs maintain their pace, they'll finish with 317 going into the SEC Tournament.

Ravern Johnson leads MSU with 27. He hit 83 a year ago and is on pace to hit 93, which would be the third most in a single season at MSU.

•While the Mississippi State men led the SEC and was second in the nation in blocked shots (7.5) per outing last year, the Lady Bulldogs (6.2) finished tops in the SEC and fifth nationally. Jarvis Varnado leads the nation with 165 and Lady Bulldog standout Chanel Mokango was ninth with 97. MSU was the only BCS school where the men and the women led their conference in blocked shots.

### MAKING THE 3S OFF THE COURT

•In the spring, MSU not only excelled on the court, it put up impressive numbers in the classroom, too. The 16 players on the roster posted an overall GPA of 2.68, the second-highest average in two years. Seven players fi nished with a GPA of 3.0 or better, while two had a 4.0.

### **OVERCOMING MAJOR DEFICITS**

●Three times last year, MSU has rallied from double-digit deficits — Arkansas (15) and South Carolina twice (10 both times) . The most a Rick Stansbury-coached team has battled back from is 20 (Kentucky, 1-5-02).

### MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 43-12 mark for an .782 winning percentage. With a 13-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's first 11 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 139-34 (.803) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 65-23 (.739) SEC mark and a 74-11 (.871) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 345-132 (.723) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

### BRYANT BECOMES FIRST MSU SIGNEE OF 2009-10 SIGNING CLASS

Mississippi State coach Rick Stansbury has announced his first signee of the 2009-10 class, standout guard Brian Bryant.

The 6-foot-3, 165-pound Albany, Ga., native is currently a sophomore at Northwest Florida State College, where he has guided his team to a 5-0 start and is averaging 20 points, 7.6 rebounds and 5.4 assists, while shooting 41 percent from 3-point territory.

Last year as a freshman, he was limited due to a hand injury.

Prior to enrolling at Northwest Florida, previously known as Okaloosa Walton, Bryant prepped four years at Dougherty High School, where he led his team to two regional titles and four playoff appearances.

As a senior, he averaged 29.6 points, 9.3 rebounds, 3.6 steals and

3.6 assists en route to garnering team MVP honors and earning Albany Herald Play of the Year honors for the second-straight season.

He was also selected to play in the Georgia North-South All-Star Game.

"He is the complete package of talent, athleticism, character and work ethic," 13th-year Raiders coach Bruce Stewart said. "He is a winner."

Bryant chose MSU over Auburn and Southern Miss.

Bryant is the fifth NWF State College men's player to head to the SEC in the last three seasons, following in the footsteps of Auburn's Tay Waller and Johnnie Lett, Alabama's Charvez Davis and South Carolina's Johndre Jefferson.






