## WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS DETROIT . . .

- ✓ For the first time since 1947-48, MSU has held its first 11 opponents to 68 points or less.

  That year, the Bulldogs achieved that feat in the first 13 games.
- Five times this season, MSU has shot 50 percent or better from the floor. All of last year, the Bulldogs shot 50 percent or better four times.
- → MSU's 12.9 fouls per game are the second fewest in the nation (Wisconsin, 12.8).
- ▼ The 10-1 start is Mississippi State's best since opening the 2003-04 campaign 13-0.
- → Arnett Moultrie leads the SEC in rebounding (11.3) and double-doubles (5).
- Rodney Hood currently has the sixth-best scoring average in school history for freshmen at 12.9. Rickey Brown (1976-77) is tops at 19.3. Hood's 34.6 minutes is currently third best and is second this year in the SEC.
- Against Florida Atlantic, Rodney Hood became the first MSU player this season to log 40 minutes.
- Dee Bost is now just 16 assists shy of breaking the school record of 514 held by Derrick Zimmerman (2000-03).
- → During its current nine-game winning streak, MSU is yielding just 61.3 points.
- ✓ In just 11 games, the Bulldogs have already utilized five different lineups.
- MSU is one win shy of winning 10-straight games for the first time since opening the 2003-04 campaign 13-0.
- → The Bulldogs are one win shy of 1,300 all-time victories.
- Against Florida Atlantic, Jalen Steele had career highs in steals (3), rebounds (7), free throws made (7) and free throws attempted (8).
- ▼ The Detroit game marks the first true road outing for Mississippi State this season. Last year, the Bulldogs were 4-5 in true road games.

# **BULLDOGS ARE 3-4 AGAINST HORIZON LEAGUE FOES**

Entering Saturday's outing against Detroit, the Bulldogs are 3-4 against the 10 teams that currently comprise the Horizon League.

MSU has played six of the 10 league members and no one more than twice.

The last Horizon League team the Bulldogs played was Detroit last year in Starkville. Prior to that, it was Wright State in December of 2009, a game MSU won in Starkville, 80-69.

# **DECEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY**

Including last year's 4-5 mark, coupled with this year's 3-0 ledger, the Bulldogs are 79-20 (.798) in the month of December since Rick Stansbury was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 137-44 (.757) in December.

## **MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS**

Including last year's 8-6 mark in non-conference action, coupled with this year's 10-1 record, Mississippi State has compiled a 151-50 (.751) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 141-40 (.779) regular-season mark.

## MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 221-38 (10-0 this year) when leading at halftime; 161-37 (8-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 237-72 (8-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 220-81 (9-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 172-31 (7-0) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

# **BOMBS AWAY . . . AGAIN AND AGAIN**

In 2009-10, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers, an average of 8.2 an outing.

In 31 games last year, the Bulldogs were nearly on the same pace, having drained 246 of their 680 attempts for an 7.9 average.

Early this year, the Bulldogs are off that torrid pace somewhat, as they've drained 76 in 10 games, including the four on Tuesday against Florida Atlantic in a 75-68 victory.

Last Saturday against Troy, MSU tied a school record with 16 made 3-pointers.

# **SCOUTING DETROIT**

Detroit fell to 5-7 on Sunday night, losing to Alabama in Tuscaloosa, 62-54.

The Titans, who were paced by Ray McCallum's 13 points, trailed 38-22 at the break before closing the deficit to single digits in the second half.

Detroit shot 32.1 percent from the floor (17-53) and was 0 of 12 from 3-point range.

The Titans did win battle of the boards, 38-31, with LaMarcus Lowe leading the way with 10 rebounds.

## LAST TIME OUT FOR MSU . . .

Mississippi State extended its winning streak to nine games on Tuesday with a 75-68 win against Florida Atlantic.

The Bulldogs led the entire first half, but fell behind 55-54 with 7:34 to play. However, MSU regained the lead for good on a 3-pointer by Dee Bost.

The senior guard paced the Bulldogs with 22 points, while dishing out three assists to go along with his one steal. Rodney Hood recorded his first double-double with 19 points and a career-best 10 rebounds.

MSU also shot 50.0 percent from the floor (27-54).

# **Bulldog Hoops Turns 100**

- MSU is celebrating its 100th season of basksetball this year. The first year the Bulldogs fielded a team was in 1908-09, when they posted a 5-5 ledger. The first game was against the Columbus Athletic Club on Jan. 1, 1909, with Mississippi State claiming a 35-6 win in Starkville. The coach that year was T.H. Werner. It was Werner's only year at the helm.
- It will be a year-long celebration, as former players and coaches will be recognized. In addition, a "Starting 5" will be announced as will the "5 Greatest Games" in school history, as voted on by the fans.

## **PRESESON HONORS**

In October, the media predicted MSU to finish 5th in the overall standings. In addition, senior guard **Dee Bost** was tabbed first-team All-SEC. Two weeks later, the league coaches voted Bost first team All-SEC

and junior forward Renardo Sidney second-team.

## **BULLDOGS GRAB TOURNAMENT TITLE IN NEW YORK**

Mississippi State knocked off No. 19 Texas A&M and No. 15 Arizona in back-to-back nights last week to win the 2011 2K Sports Classic, benefitting Coaches vs. Cancer.

It was the 18th in-season tournament title the Bulldogs have won, while improving their record to 86-73 following Friday's 67-57 win against Arizona. It was MSU's first tournament crown since the 2000 Bank One Fiesta Bowl Classic, when it also upended Arizona.

# 1,000-POINT CLUB HAS BOST; MOULTRIE CLOSING

On Feb. 9, 2011, against Arkansas at Humphrey Coliseum, junior guard **Dee Bost** became the 33rd MSU player to score 1,000 points for a career. He reached the milestone with 3:34 left in the first half on a 3-pointer that tied the game at 25-apiece.

**Arnett Moultrie** came to MSU after transferring from UTEP, where he totaled 650 points his first two seasons. After scoring 137 points in his first eight games, including a career-best 28 against S. Alabama on Nov. 12, he is on pace to eclipse 1,000 points for his career this season.

He currently has 787 career points and 612 rebounds.

## **BOST MOVING UP SCORING/STEAL RECORD BOOKS**

Senior guard **Dee Bost** scored 22 points against Florida Atlantic on Tuesday to give him 1,323 points for his career, as he moved past Rich Knarr and Tang Hamilton for the 15th most in school history.

He also had 1 steal to give him 154 for his career, which tied him with Tony Watts (1989-92) for the 6th most in the record bookds. He needs just seven more to crack the Top 5. Timmy Bowers (2001-04) is No. 5 with 161 steals.

# **MOULTRIE IMPRESSIVE IN DEBUT**

**Arnett Moultrie** became the first Mississippi State player to record a double-double in his Bulldog debut since Lawrence Roberts (26 points, 15 rebounds) in 2002-03 against UT Martin.

Against EKU, Moultrie had 13 points and 10 rebounds.

## **HOOD TURNING HEADS FROM DAY 1**

Guard **Rodney Hood** became the first true freshman to score in double-digits his first four games since Rickey Brown in 1976-77 when he opened his career by scoring 10-plus points his first 12 games.

The record is held by Ray White in 1975-76 when he scored in double-digits all 28 games.

# **BULLDOGS IN ELITE COMPANY...**

Mississippi State is one of only two SEC schools to post winning conference records in each of the last three seasons. In the "Super 6" conferences, the Bulldogs find themselves in elite company, as only 18 of the 73 teams who have competed in those leagues the last three years have accomplished the feat.

STARKVILLE, Miss. — Mississippi State made 10 3-point baskets as it defeated Detroit 82-76

The Bulldogs converted 50 percent of their shot attempts in the final half and never trailed over the final 28 minutes of play.

One Bulldog not letting down was senior sharp shooter Ravern Johnson, who scored 25 points on a 10-for-15 night from the floor with three 3-pointers. Johnson has now gone 19 points or better in each of the first three games of the season.

Johnson's fi nal trey ran the Maroon and White advantage to a game-best 12 points at 73-61 with 5:41 remaining.

Still, the Titans crawled back within 76-73 on a Jason Calliste layup with 1:14 remain-

The Titans got no closer. Again, it was a three-point spread at 79-76 when UD's Chase Simon missed the back end of two free throw attempts with nine seconds remaining.

Jalen Steele hit two free throws an Johnson one more to seal the victory.

Both teams were hot in the opening half. The Bulldogs hit their first four 3-point attempts and sprinted out to an 18-12 advan-

The Titans reeled off 10 straight points to take a 22-18 advantage with 12:44 left before halftime and went into the break up

# REBOUNDING STREAK ENDS

Through the first eight games of the season, MSU had out-rebounded all eight of its opponents.

But against West Virginia in Game 9, the streak ended when the Mountaineers won the battle of the boards, 36-

And while the Bulldogs' 46 rebounds were the most since they had 47 against Alabama State on 12-14-10, Troy matched the effort with 46 as well.

On the year, MSU has a +5.1 rebound margin (38.5-33.5).

## GOOD SHOWING AT THE POLLS

Mississippi State finds itself ranked in both polls for the first time since the 2009-10 preseason rankings.

It's the highest the Bulldogs have been in either poll since the 2003-04 campaign, when it climbed to No. 4 in AP and No. 5 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Polls. That year, MSU won the overall SEC crown.

As a ranked team this season, Mississippi State has posted a 5-0 ledger.

# 3-POINT RECORD TIED AGAIN

Against Troy in a 106-68 victory, Mississippi State tied a school record with 16 made 3-pointers.

The Bulldogs also had 16 treys against Arkansas (2-7-09) and St. Bonaventure (12-5-09).

From an individual standpoint against the Trojans, senior guard **Dee Bost** drained 7 3-pointers, one shy of tying the school record of 8 held by Winsome Frazier, Marckell Patterson, Antonio Jackson and Darryl Wilson.

It was the second time he has made 7 3s, the first coming two years ago against Auburn.

## ASSISTS COMING FROM ALL DIRECTIONS

In the win against Troy, MSU dished out a season-high 30 assists, the most since being credited with 31 against Louisiana-Monroe on 12-5-01.

The 30 ranks tied for 7th in school history, while the record of 34 came against Chicago State on 12-4-74.

Dee Bost led the charge with 9, while Rodney Hood and Arnett Moultrie had career best of 6 and 5, respec-

# MEET THE HEAD COACH



onsistency is a key ingredient to the recent success enjoyed by the Mississippi State University basketball program, one that is stressed in the players' daily activities on and off the basketball floor that has translated into the program's recent run of national prominence gained under head coach Rick Stansbury.

That consistency was brought to the forefront four years ago when MSU's 14th-year head basketball coach became the all-time winningest basketball coach in school history, surpassing Richard Williams' mark of 191. Now with a 14-year coaching record of 282-155 at the Bulldog helm, the 9th-most wins in SEC history, Stansbury has guided 10 State squads (6 NCAA & 4 NIT) to postseason tournament appearances and nine clubs to 20-plus wins campaigns.

MSU has averaged 21.3 wins the last six years (2006-11), including winning an outright SEC overall championship in 2004, along with back-to-back SEC West crowns in the 2003-2004 and 2007-2008 seasons an another in 2010, and SEC Tournament titles in 2002 and 2009.

Most recently, Stansbury piloted last year's 17-14 State squad to a second place finish in the Western Division, but missed out on a post-season berth for the first time in five seasons.

From 2001-05, he guided MSU to five-consecutive postseason tournament appearances for the first time in school history, including a streak of four straight NCAA Tournament berths from 2002 through 2005.

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. With the 12-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's 13 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 168-43 (.796) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 76-28 (.731) SEC mark and a 92-15 (.860) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 374-141 (.726) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

The 17th-ranked Bulldogs placed five players in double figures and dished out an amazing 30 assists in a 106-68 rout of Troy for their eighth-straight win.

The 30 assists ranks seventh all-time, while MSU matched a school-record with 16 made 3-points baskets.

The Bulldogs topped the century mark for the first time since a 105-53 against St. Bonaventure in 2009.
