BULLDOGS GET FIRST TRUE ROAD TEST

Although Mississippi State has played four games away from the friendly confines of Humphrey Coliseum, it hasn't played on the opponent's home floor.

However, that changes at 1 p.m. on Saturday when MSU visits Houston. In true road games last year, the Bulldogs were 5-4, with four of the victories coming in SEC play. In non-conference action, MSU knocked off St. Bonaventure, 76-71.

Mississippi State plays a total of three non-conference road games this season, with the other two coming at San Diego and Western Kentucky.

VARNADO'S COUNTDOWN TO HISTORY

Following his six-block performance against Wright State, **Jarvis Varnado** now has a nation-best 53 for the year and 447 for his career.

As a result, the Brownsville, Tenn., native is 88 shy of tying the NCAA mark of 535 held by former Louisiana-Monroe standout Wojciech Mydra (1998-2002).

Varnado, who has led the nation the past two years in this category, is currently 6th all-time in the NCAA record books.

To get the record by the end of the regular season, Varnado needs to average 4.2 blocks in the next 21 games.

YES . . . THAT'S 63 PERCENT ACCURACY

To say Mississippi State shot lights out against Wright State would be an understatement. The Bulldogs were scorching, as they drained 63 percent of their shots (29 of 46).

That was the fourth-best shooting percentage under Rick Stansbury, with the top coming at home last year against Western Kentucky at 66 percent (35 of 53). The best percentage on the road of 65.3 percent (32 of 49) came at Tulane on 12-29-01.

Individually against the Raiders, MSU had four players with at least four attempts shoot 71 percent or better — **Jarvis Varnado** (100.0), **Romero Osby** (100.0), **Barry Stewart** (72.7) and **Ravern Johnson** (71.4).

MSU BY THE NUMBER

MSTATE 89-65 AGAINST CONFERENCE USA FOES

Entering Saturday's showdown at Houston, the Bulldogs are 89-65 against the 12 teams that currently comprise Conference USA.

However, Mississippi State hasn't played UTEP, Central Florida or SMU.

The last league foe the Bulldogs battled was Houston last January at the Hump, an 82-65 MSU victory. The team Mississippi State has played the most is Tulane, and the Bulldogs own a 54-37 series advantage. State is also 14-4 against Southern Miss.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 10-6 ledger against non-conference foes coupled with this year's 8-2 mark, MSU has compiled a dominant 129-41 (.759) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 121-32 (.791) regular-season.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 190-27 when leading at halftime (8-0 this year); 168-32 (6-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 198-61 (8-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 191-69 (7-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 146-26 (6-1) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

DECEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 3-3 mark coupled with this year's 4-0 record, the Bulldogs are 68-15 (.819) in the month of December since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 126-39 (.764) in December.

STEWART, VARNADO CLOSING IN ON MILESTONES

From 2000-03, Derrick Zimmerman played in 127 games. From 1980-83, Kalpatrick Wells started 110 games.

Both are school records. Both are likely to fall later this year.

Currently, **Jarvis Varnado** has played in *115* and has drawn *93* starts, while fellow senior **Barry Stewart** has appeared in *115* games with *80* starts to his credit.

Stewart is also likely to break Jeff Malone's minutes-played record of 3,851. He currently has 3,533 and needs to average around 17 minutes for the rest of the regular season to set a new mark. Currently, he's averaging 33.3 minutes through the first 10 games.

RAINING 3s...AGAIN

Last year, Mississippi State set a single-season record in 3-pointers made by draining 296. Already, the Bulldogs are ahead of the pace they established a year ago.

To date, MSU has connected on 104 of its 248 attempts (.419) through the first 10 games. In comparison, State was 69 of 189 (.365) through the first 10 games last year.

If the Bulldogs maintain their pace, they'll finish with 322 going into the SEC Tournament.

Ravern Johnson leads MSU with 30 after hitting 83 a year ago.

•While the Mississippi State men led the SEC and was second in the nation in blocked shots (7.5) per outing last year, the Lady Bulldogs (6.2) finished tops in the SEC and fifth nationally. Jarvis Varnado leads the nation with 165 and Lady Bulldog standout Chanel Mokango was ninth with 97. MSU was the only BCS school where the men and the women led their conference in blocked shots.

MAKING THE 3S OFF THE COURT

•In the spring, MSU not only excelled on the court, it put up impressive numbers in the classroom, too. The 16 players on the roster posted an overall GPA of 2.68, the second-highest average in two years. Seven players fi nished with a GPA of 3.0 or better, while two had a 4.0.

OVERCOMING MAJOR DEFICITS

●Three times last year, MSU has rallied from double-digit deficits — Arkansas (15) and South Carolina twice (10 both times) . The most a Rick Stansbury-coached team has battled back from is 20 (Kentucky, 1-5-02).

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 44-12 mark for an .786 winning percentage. With a 13-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's first 11 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 140-34 (.805) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 65-23 (.739) SEC mark and a 75-11 (.872) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 346-132 (.724) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

BRYANT BECOMES FIRST MSU SIGNEE OF 2009-10 SIGNING CLASS

Mississippi State coach Rick Stansbury has announced his first signee of the 2009-10 class, standout guard Brian Bryant.

The 6-foot-3, 165-pound Albany, Ga., native is currently a sophomore at Northwest Florida State College, where he has guided his team to a 5-0 start and is averaging 20 points, 7.6 rebounds and 5.4 assists, while shooting 41 percent from 3-point territory.

Last year as a freshman, he was limited due to a hand injury.

Prior to enrolling at Northwest Florida, previously known as Okaloosa Walton, Bryant prepped four years at Dougherty High School, where he led his team to two regional titles and four playoff appearances.

As a senior, he averaged 29.6 points, 9.3 rebounds, 3.6 steals and 3.6 assists en route to garnering team MVP honors and earning Albany

Herald Play of the Year honors for the second-straight season.

He was also selected to play in the Georgia North-South All-Star Game.

"He is the complete package of talent, athleticism, character and work ethic," 13th-year Raiders coach Bruce Stewart said. "He is a winner."

Bryant chose MSU over Auburn and Southern Miss.

Bryant is the fifth NWF State College men's player to head to the SEC in the last three seasons, following in the footsteps of Auburn's Tay Waller and Johnnie Lett, Alabama's Charvez Davis and South Carolina's Johndre Jefferson.

He's also the second player MSU signed from Northwest Florida, joining forward Branden Vincent, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-04.

STARKVILLE, Miss. — In its most well-balanced offensive attack of the season, Mississippi State dismantled the visiting Houston Cougars 82-65 at Humphrey Coliseum.

Three Bulldogs scored in double digits, led by sophomore guard Phil Turner's season-high 16 on 6-of-7 shooting, including a 3-of-4 effort from behind the arc. Fellow sophomore backcourt threat Ravern Johnson added 14 points and three assists while freshman big-man Romero Osby put up 13 after hitting 2-of-3 attempts from long range and grabbed seven boards.

Freshman point guard Dee Bost eight assists and six rebounds. Jarvis Varnado led the squad with

eight rebounds.

Junior guard Aubrey Coleman recorded the game's only doubledouble for the Cougars with 11 points and 10 rebounds, while junior guard Kelvin Lewis led his team with 16 points.

MSU led by as many as 28 points and began both halves on fire, scoring the first eight points of the first and outscoring the Cougars 20-4 in the first nine minutes of the second.

In those first minutes of the second stanza, Houston hit just one of its first 16 attempts from the field to finish the game with a 27.2 percent mark - the second-lowest efficiency for an MSU opponent this season.

The win was Mississippi State's first victory against Houston in six tries, dating back to 1963.
