### WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS SOUTHERN MISS ...

- Quinndary Weatherspoon is now 6 points shy of 500 for his career.
- Monday marks the 24th game Mississippi State has played at Mississippi Coliseum. The Bulldogs are 17-6 overall.
- MSU has won 13 out of its last 14 games in Jackson, including last year's outing against Northern Colorado. 93-69.
- Mississippi State and Southern Miss have met three times in Jackson, with the Golden Eagles enjoying a 2-1 advantage. The two last met at Mississippi Coliseum on Dec. 15, 1980, with USM claiming a 68-53 win. The Bulldogs claimed the initial meeting in Jackson, 62-52, on Jan. 28, 1963. USM claimed 65-60 win the following year.
- After shooting just 16.7 percent from the foul line last season as a freshman, sophomore forward Aric Holman has improved dramatically, draining 20 of his 27 attempts (.741).
- MSU is 45-20 against the 2 teams that currently comprise Conference USA. Southern Miss (14-4) is the team the Bulldogs have played the most, while North Texas is last foe MSU played (a 66-56 win on Nov. 17, 2015).
- •I.J. Ready is 102nd nationally and 4th in the SEC with his 2.45 assist/turnover ratio.
- •I.J. Ready is now 234 points shy of becoming the 37th player in MSU history to score 1,000 for a career. He also needs just 7 assists to move into the MSU all-time Top 10. In addition, he is 14 steals shy of moving in the MSU Top 10 record book.
- In his last two games, backup guard **Lamar Peters** has scored 34 points on 12-of-22 shooting with a 9-of-16 mark beyond the arc.
- KenPom.com has Mississippi State as the least experienced team (.72) of all 351 DI programs.
- When is Mississippi State successful? When shooting 45 percent of better (5-0), outrebounding foes (5-0) and winning or being tied at the half (6-0).
- Of current SEC players, I.J. Ready is 11th with 766 points, third with 125 steals and fourth with 319 assists.



### MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Last year, MSU was 10-5, including a 5-1 mark against non-conference foes. This year, MSU is 4-2.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 41-season composite record of 422-173 (.710) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

### LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

■ In the season-opener against Norfolk State, freshman guard **Tyson Carter** drew the start.

28 years ago, his father, Greg, drew a start on opening day against Christian Brothers as a freshman.

While Tyson poured in 17 points on 6-of-8 shooting with five made 3-pointers, Greg was 5-6 with 10 points.

Tyson's 17 points were the most by a freshman on opening day since that same game his father played, when Chancellor Nichols also totaled 17

### **HOWLAND LOOKING TO JOIN ELITE CLUB**

■ Ben Howland enters his second season at Mississippi State looking to achieve a feat only 12 coaches have ever done, and that's lead four different teams to the NCAA Tournament.

Howland has already guided Northern Arizona, Pittsburgh and UCLA to the Big Dance.

The first 12 coaches to do so are Lon Kruger, Steve Alford, John Beilein, Lefty Driesell, Cliff Ellis, Larry Eustachy, Jim Harrick, Fran McCaffery, Tom Penders, Tubby Smith, Rick Pitino and Eddie Sutton.

### **WEATHERSPOON CLOSE TO 500**

■ In the loss to Central Florida on Nov. 17, **Quinndary Weatherspoo**n scored 19 points to give him 400 for his career.

Through his first 38 games, he now has 494 points.

### **BULLDOGS SIGN 3**

■ Mississippi State took advantage of the early signing period Wednesday and signed three players — two 4-stars and and one 3-star — to give MSU its second Top 15 signing class in a row.

Joining MSU next season are guards Nick Weatherspoon (Velma Jackson) of Canton, Miss., and KeyShawn Feazell (Lawrence County) of Monticello, Miss., and forward Garrison Brooks (Auburn High School) of Lafayette, Ala.

Weatherspoon is the younger brother MSU sophomore standout **Quinndary Weatherspoon**, while Brooks is the son of MSU assistant coach, **George Brooks**.

### **BROOKS NOTED FOR RECRUITING**

■ In this year's Sporting News preseason basketball publication, MSU assistant **George Brooks** was named the second best recruiting in the SEC.

Brooks, a 1996 MSU graduate, has been an assistant with the Bulldogs for seven years after serving as head coach at Meridian Community College.

He's been responsible for signing top talent such as **Quinndary Weatherspoon**, **Mario Kegler** and Garrison Brooks.

### 2-1 IN CHARLESTON

■ Mississippi State posted a 2-1 ledger in the Charleston Classic with wins against Boise State and UTEP.

The lone loss came against Central Florida. MSU is now 92-81 all-time in regular-season tournaments.

### HARDCOURT ROBBERY

■ Three times this year, Mississippi State has collected 11 or more steals.

Against Oregon State, the Bulldogs were credited with 17 steals, the most since also having 17 against Florida Atlantic on 11-13-12.

The Bulldogs are third in the SEC with their 8.4 average, 35thth nationally.

Individually, **Quinndary Weatherspoon** is second in the SEC with his 2.3 steals, while **I.J. Ready** is fourth at 1.9. On the national scene, that's 30th and 77th, respectively.

### WELCOMING NEW COMPETITION

■ The Bulldogs' first five games this season were against first-time foes.

Those newcomers were Norfolk State, Central Florida, Boise State, UTEP and Lehigh.

MSU has faced all remaining teams at least once.

### WRIGHT MOVE

■ Eli Wright earned his first-career start against Northwestern State and responded with 11 points on 4-of-5 shooting to go along with his 7 rebounds.

On the year the freshman has appeared in all 9 games and is averaging 3.4 points and 1.6 rebounds

### **CAREER GAMES**

■ Both sophomore **Aric Holman** and freshman **Lamar Peters** had career games against UTEP in terms of scoring.

Holman poured in 18 in the Bulldogs' 61-54 victory, while Peters totaled 13.

All four of Peters' field goals were from 3-point range. On the year, the New Orleans native is 7-17 beyond the arc. In his last three games, he's averaging 14.6 points.

Holman has scored 10-plus points in six of MSU's nine games. Last year in 26 appearances, he never reached double digits.

### TAKING ADVANTAGE OF CHARITY

■ Mississippi State is fourth in the SEC with its 75.8 percentage at the free throw line.

On the year, the Bulldogs are 125 of 165, having shot 82 percent or better in three games.

In their last outing against East Tennessee State, they were just 13-20/.

**Quinndary Weatherspoon** is tops on the team with 20-plus attempts at .865, while **Tyson Carter** is second at .864.

Nationally, the Bulldogs are 32nd.

### LARGEST SETBACK AT HOME

■ The 14-point loss to Lehigh on Nov. 25 was the largest non-conference home game since also losing by 14 to McNeese State on 12-30-14.

It was also the largest setback at the Hump with **Ben Howland** at the helm.

### **FORCING TURNOVERS**

■ In the last four games, Mississippi State has forced 70 turnovers, the best four-game stretch of the season.

The high mark was 21 against Oregon State, which MSU converted into 28 points. That was the most forced since last year against South Carolina on Feb. 27 at the Hump.

### **LONG-RANGE SUCCESS**

■ Against Georgia State on Dec. 4, MSU made a season-high 13 3-pointers, its most since draining 15 against North Carolina A&T on 12-12-10.

The 22-point margin of defeat was also the largest this year.

Through nine games, the Bulldogs 68-196 beyond the arc (.347), a percentage that's sixth best in the SEC.

Lamar Peters leads MSU with 18 made 3-pointers, while his 2.6 average is currently fourth in the league.

### **MSU GOES UNDEFEATED IN ITALY**

■ This past August, Mississippi State spent a little more than two weeks traveling across all of Italy playing games.

Quinndary Weatherspoon averaged a team-high 23.3 points, followed by Tyson Carter at 20.5 and Eli Wright at 15.3.

**Aric Holman** was the top rebounder at 7.8 boards.

The Bulldogs went 4-0.

### Ben Howland 21th Season Overall | 2nd Season At Mississippi State 421-226 (20-20 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015, Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 421-226 record – Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (20-20).
- Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division

I history to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).

- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regular-season title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.
- This past year, Howland was inducted into both the Northern Arizona and Weber State hall of fames.
- Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children Meredith and Adam (Brittney) – and two grandsons, Benjamin Clark Howland II and Elijah Howland.
