FOR STANSBURY, IT ALL STARTED IN JACKSON

On November 17, 1998, a new era of Mississippi State basketball was ushered in when **Rick Stansbury** coached his first game for the Maroon & White.

It was indeed a successful start, as Stansbury's debut at the helm resulted in a 105-53 victory against Arkansas-Pine Bluff at Mississippi Coliseum in Jackson. For the new coach, it was the first of eight-straight wins to start the year.

That victory in the capital city, however, was bitter-sweet. Following the game, Stansbury learned his mother, Norma, had passed away in Florida.

WITH JACKSON COMES GREAT ACCURACY

In the seven games Mississippi State has played in Jackson's Mississippi Coliseum with **Rick Stansbury** at the helm, the Bulldogs are shooting 51.2 percent from the floor (220-430), while holding opponents to 32.2 percent (156-485). State's margin of victory has also been impressive, an average of 28.3 points.

MSU has won nine straight in Jackson and is 13-5 all-time.

12 AND COUNTING FOR STANSBURY

Tuesday's showdown with the Gents marks MSU's 12th "home" game played in the Magnolia State away from Humphrey Coliseum since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach. The Bulldogs are currently 11-0 in those games. Mississippi State is 7-0 at Mississippi Coliseum, 2-0 at the BancorpSouth Center in Tupelo, and 2-0 at the DeSoto Civic Center in Southaven.

VARNADO'S COUNTDOWN TO HISTORY

Following his five-block performance at Houston last Saturday, **Jarvis Varnado** now has a nation-best 58 for the year and 452 for his career.

As a result, the Brownsville, Tenn., native is 83 shy of tying the NCAA mark of 535 held by former Louisiana-Monroe standout Wojciech Mydra (1998-2002).

Varnado, who has led the nation the past two years in this category, is currently tied for fifth all-time with Tarvis Williams (Hampton) in the NCAA record books.

To get the record by the end of the regular season, Varnado needs to average 4.2 blocks in the next 20 games.

MSU BY THE NUMBER

22.2 — Mississippi State's staunch defense held Houston's high-octane offense to 22.2 points below its season average (86.2) on Saturday.

MSTATE 7-0 AGAINST SUMMIT LEAGUE FOES

Entering Tuesday's showdown against Centenary, the Bulldogs are 7-0 against the 12 teams that currently comprise the Summit League.

However, Mississippi State has only played Centenary and Oral Roberts.

While MSU is 6-0 against the Gents, it defeated Oral Roberts 91-69 in December of 1978.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 10-6 ledger against non-conference foes coupled with this year's 9-2 mark, MSU has compiled a dominant 130-41 (.760) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 122-32 (.792) regular-season.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 190-27 when leading at halftime (8-0 this year); 168-32 (6-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 199-61 (9-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 192-69 (8-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 147-26 (7-1) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

DECEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 3-3 mark coupled with this year's 5-0 record, the Bulldogs are 69-15 (.821) in the month of December since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 127-39 (.765) in December.

STEWART, VARNADO CLOSING IN ON MILESTONES

From 2000-03, Derrick Zimmerman played in 127 games. From 1980-83, Kalpatrick Wells started 110 games.

Both are school records. Both are likely to fall later this year.

Currently, **Jarvis Varnado** has played in 116 and has drawn 94 starts, while fellow senior **Barry Stewart** has appeared in 116 games with 81 starts to his credit.

Stewart is also likely to break Jeff Malone's minutes-played record of 3,851. He currently has 3,570 and needs to average around 14 minutes for the rest of the regular season to set a new mark. Currently, he's averaging 33.6 minutes through the first 10 games.

RAINING 3s . . . AGAIN

Last year, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers. Already, the Bulldogs are ahead of that pace.

MSU has connected on 112 of its 270 attempts through the first 11 games. In comparison, State was 74 of 219 through the first 11 games last year. If the pace continues, the Bulldogs will finish with 316 in just the regular season.

Ravarn Johnson leads MSU with 33 3-pointers and is on pace to finish with 93, which would be the third most in a single season. Darryl Wilson holds the top two spots with 97 in 1996 and 94 in 1995.

2009-10 Bulldog Bites

AS THE MEN DO, SO DO THE WOMEN

●While the Mississippi State men led the SEC and was second in the nation in blocked shots (7.5) per outing last year, the Lady Bulldogs (6.2) finished tops in the SEC and fifth nationally. Jarvis Varnado leads the nation with 165 and Lady Bulldog standout Chanel Mokango was ninth with 97. MSU was the only BCS school where the men and the women led their conference in blocked shots.

MAKING THE 3S OFF THE COURT

●In the spring, MSU not only excelled on the court, it put up impressive numbers in the classroom, too. The 16 players on the roster posted an overall GPA of 2.68, the second-highest average in two years. Seven players finished with a GPA of 3.0 or better, while two had a 4.0.

OVERCOMING MAJOR DEFICITS

●Three times last year, MSU has rallied from double-digit deficits – Arkansas (15) and South Carolina twice (10 both times) . The most a Rick Stansbury-coached team has battled back from is 20 (Kentucky, 1-5-02).

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 44-12 mark for an .786 winning percentage. With a 13-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's first 11 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 140-34 (.805) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 65-23 (.739) SEC mark and a 75-11 (.872) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 346-132 (.724) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

BRYANT BECOMES FIRST MSU SIGNEE OF 2009-10 SIGNING CLASS

Mississippi State coach Rick Stansbury has announced his first signee of the 2009-10 class, standout guard Brian Bryant.

The 6-foot-3, 165-pound Albany, Ga., native is currently a sophomore at Northwest Florida State College, where he has guided his team to a 5-0 start and is averaging 20 points, 7.6 rebounds and 5.4 assists, while shooting 41 percent from 3-point territory.

Last year as a freshman, he was limited due to a hand injury.

Prior to enrolling at Northwest Florida, previously known as Okaloosa Walton, Bryant prepped four years at Dougherty High School, where he led his team to two regional titles and four playoff appearances.

As a senior, he averaged 29.6 points, 9.3 rebounds, 3.6 steals and 3.6 assists en route to garnering team MVP honors and earning Albany

Herald Play of the Year honors for the second-straight season.

He was also selected to play in the Georgia North-South All-Star Game.

"He is the complete package of talent, athleticism, character and work ethic," 13th-year Raiders coach Bruce Stewart said. "He is a winner."

Bryant chose MSU over Auburn and Southern Miss.

Bryant is the fifth NWF State College men's player to head to the SEC in the last three seasons, following in the footsteps of Auburn's Tay Waller and Johnnie Lett, Alabama's Charvez Davis and South Carolina's Johndre Jefferson.

He's also the second player MSU signed from Northwest Florida, joining forward Branden Vincent, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-04.

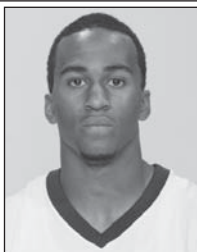

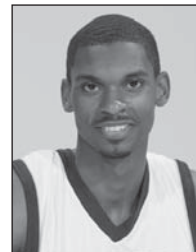

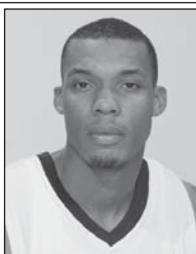
