#### LONG RANGE SUCCESS MIGHT BE RECORD SETTING

It's one thing to shoot a lot of 3-pointers. It's another to make them. And through the first 12 games, Mississippi State is doing both.

Entering Monday's showdown against Mississippi Valley State, the Bulldogs have hit 126 of their 297 shots beyond the arc. That's 42.4 percent accuracy. The school record came in 1995-96, when MSU drained 38.4 percent of its treys.

Nationally, the Bulldogs rank 2nd in 3-pointers made and ninth in 3-point percentage. In the SEC, they are tops in both categories.

#### NO FOUL PLAY FOR THE BULLDOGS

Ever notice the Bulldogs' opponents don't shoot a lot of free throws? Well, it's not a coincidence, because Mississippi State does a great job of not fouling, on both ends of the court.

To date, MSU has only been whistled for 146 fouls. That equates to 12.2 per game, the fewest in the country. The Bulldogs have also had just one player foul out — **Dee Bost** in the season opener against Rider. Of the six players that have started, **Ravern Johnson** has the fewest fouls of 12. Ironically, he's also been to the charity stripe fewer than any of the starters, but he's a perfect 6 of 6.

As for free throws, MSU is 160 of 229. In comparison, its opponents are just 95 of 148.

#### VARNADO'S COUNTDOWN TO HISTORY

Following his four-block performance against Centenary last Tuesday, **Jarvis Varnado** now has a nation-best 62 for the year and 456 for his career.

As a result, the Brownsville, Tenn., native is 79 shy of tying the NCAA mark of 535 held by former Louisiana-Monroe standout Wojciech Mydra (1998-2002).

Varnado, who has led the nation the past two years in this category, is currently fourth all-time in the NCAA record books, 25 behind Tim Duncan (Wake Forest), who totaled 481.

To get the record by the end of the regular season, Varnado needs to average 4.2 blocks in the next 19 games.

#### **MSU BY THE NUMBER**

**7** — Mississippi State's current winning streak now stands at **seven**. The school record is 19, which spanned two seasons from Jan. 15, 1962 to Dec. 15, 1962. The streak ended on Dec. 17 at Virginia Tech (82-65).

#### **MSTATE 17-2 AGAINST SWAC FOES**

Entering Monday's showdown against Mississippi Valley State, the Bulldogs are 17-2 against the 10 teams that currently comprise the Southwestern Athletic Conference.

Mississippi State has played every league foe except Grambling State and Southern.

The two most common teams MSU has played are Alabama A&M (4-0) and Alcorn State (2-2), while the last SWAC opponent the Bulldogs faced was Alabama State last year, a game MSU won 76-67 in Starkville.

#### MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 10-6 ledger against non-conference foes coupled with this year's 10-2 mark, MSU has compiled a dominant 131-41 (.762) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 123-32 (.794) regular-season.

#### MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 191-27 when leading at halftime (9-0 this year); 169-32 (7-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 200-61 (10-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 193-69 (9-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 148-26 (8-1) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

#### DECEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 3-3 mark coupled with this year's 5-0 record, the Bulldogs are 70-15 (.824) in the month of December since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 128-39 (.766) in December.

#### STEWART, VARNADO CLOSING IN ON MILESTONES

From 2000-03, Derrick Zimmerman played in 127 games. From 1980-83, Kalpatrick Wells started 110 games.

Both are school records. Both are likely to fall later this year.

Currently, **Jarvis Varnado** has played in 117 and has drawn 95 starts, while fellow senior **Barry Stewart** has appeared in 117 games with 82 starts to his credit.

Stewart is also likely to break Jeff Malone's minutes-played record of 3,851. He currently has 3,603 and needs to average around 13 minutes for the rest of the regular season to set a new mark. Currently, he's averaging 33.6 minutes through the first 12 games.

#### **RAINING 3s...AGAIN**

Last year, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers. Already, the Bulldogs are ahead of that pace.

MSU has connected on 126 of its 297 attempts through the first 12 games. In comparison, State was 78 of 225 through the first 12 games last year. If the pace continues, the Bulldogs will finish with 326 in just the regular season.

**Ravern Johnson** leads MSU with 38 3-pointers on 78 attempts and is on pace to finish with 98, which would be a single-season record. Darryl Wilson currently holds the top two spots with 97 in 1996 and 94 in 1995.

Through 12 games a year ago, he was 26 of 51 and led the nation in percentage.

# AS THE MEN DO, SO DO THE WOMEN

•While the Mississippi State men led the SEC and was second in the nation in blocked shots (7.5) per outing last year, the Lady Bulldogs (6.2) finished tops in the SEC and fifth nationally. Jarvis Varnado leads the nation with 165 and Lady Bulldog standout Chanel Mokango was ninth with 97. MSU was the only BCS school where the men and the women led their conference in blocked shots.

#### MAKING THE 3S OFF THE COURT

•In the spring, MSU not only excelled on the court, it put up impressive numbers in the classroom, too. The 16 players on the roster posted an overall GPA of 2.68, the second-highest average in two years. Seven players fi nished with a GPA of 3.0 or better, while two had a 4.0.

#### **OVERCOMING MAJOR DEFICITS**

●Three times last year, MSU has rallied from double-digit deficits — Arkansas (15) and South Carolina twice (10 both times) . The most a Rick Stansbury-coached team has battled back from is 20 (Kentucky, 1-5-02).

#### MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 44-12 mark for an .786 winning percentage. With a 13-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's first 11 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 140-34 (.805) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 65-23 (.739) SEC mark and a 75-11 (.872) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 346-132 (.724) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

## **BRYANT BECOMES FIRST MSU SIGNEE OF 2009-10 SIGNING CLASS**

Mississippi State coach Rick Stansbury has announced his first signee of the 2009-10 class, standout guard Brian Bryant.

The 6-foot-3, 165-pound Albany, Ga., native is currently a sophomore at Northwest Florida State College, where he has guided his team to a 5-0 start and is averaging 20 points, 7.6 rebounds and 5.4 assists, while shooting 41 percent from 3-point territory.

Last year as a freshman, he was limited due to a hand injury.

Prior to enrolling at Northwest Florida, previously known as Okaloosa Walton, Bryant prepped four years at Dougherty High School, where he led his team to two regional titles and four playoff appearances.

As a senior, he averaged 29.6 points, 9.3 rebounds, 3.6 steals and 3.6 assists en route to garnering team MVP honors and earning Albany

Herald Play of the Year honors for the second-straight season.

He was also selected to play in the Georgia North-South All-Star Game.

"He is the complete package of talent, athleticism, character and work ethic," 13th-year Raiders coach Bruce Stewart said. "He is a winner."

Bryant chose MSU over Auburn and Southern Miss.

Bryant is the fifth NWF State College men's player to head to the SEC in the last three seasons, following in the footsteps of Auburn's Tay Waller and Johnnie Lett, Alabama's Charvez Davis and South Carolina's Johndre Jefferson

He's also the second player MSU signed from Northwest Florida, joining forward Branden Vincent, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-04.






