HOME AWAY FROM HOME

Mississippi State is back in California. For the second time in less than three weeks.

Hopefully for the Bulldogs against San Diego, they'll have similar results as they had the first time they were out West.

On Dec. 12, MSU blew past perennial power UCLA 72-54 in the John R. Wooden Classic in Anaheim. Overall, the Bulldogs have won two straight in the Golden State, dating back to the 2007-08 campaign when they won at Loyola Marymount. With **Rick Stansbury** at the helm, MSU is 5-6 in California.

NOW THAT'S PROTECTING THE BASKETBALL

Against Houston on Dec. 19, Mississippi State had a season-high 19 turnovers. But in their last two games, the Bulldogs have done a much better job of protecting the basketball.

How much better? Try a combined 14 miscues, including the season-low four MSU committed against Mississippi Valley State on Monday.

That was the fewest turnovers MSU had since four in the season opener against Louisiana Tech in 2007-08. The last time the Bulldogs had fewer than 10 was last year's SEC Tournament semifinals when they were charged with six.

VARNADO'S COUNTDOWN TO HISTORY

Following his seven-block performance against Mississippi Valley State last Monday, **Jarvis Varnado** now has a nation-best 69 for the year and 463 for his career.

As a result, the Brownsville, Tenn., native is 72 shy of tying the NCAA mark of 535 held by former Louisiana-Monroe standout Wojciech Mydra (1998-2002).

Varnado, who has led the nation the past two years in this category, is currently fourth all-time in the NCAA record books, 18 behind Tim Duncan (Wake Forest), who totaled 481.

To get the record by the end of the regular season, Varnado needs to average 4.0 blocks in the next 18 games.

MSU BY THE NUMBER

11 — With **Rick Stansbury** at the helm, Mississippi State has developed a reputation as a top defensive team. This year is no different. In fact, when MSU holds opponents to less than 45 percent shooting from the floor, it's 11-0.

MSTATE 5-2 AGAINST WEST COAST CONFERENCE

Entering Thursday's showdown at San Diego, the Bulldogs are 5-2 against the seven teams that currently comprise the West Coast Conference.

Mississippi State has played five of the league members — Gonzaga, Portland, San Diego, Santa Clara and St. Mary's.

Not counting last year's game in Starkville against San Diego, the last time MSU battled a West Coast member was during the 2005-06 season when it defeated Santa Clara (82-69, Dec. 3, 2005) in overtime in Starkville.

MSU ENJOYS MORE NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Including last year's 10-6 ledger against non-conference foes coupled with this year's 11-2 mark, MSU has compiled a dominant 132-41 (.763) record against non-conference opponents during the **Rick Stansbury** era (since 1998-99), including a 124-32 (.795) regular-season.

MISSISSIPPI STATE'S RECORD WHEN . . .

During the **Rick Stansbury** era, the Bulldogs are: 192-27 when leading at halftime (10-0 this year); 169-32 (7-0) when shooting 45 percent or better from the field; 201-61 (11-0) when the opposition shoots less than 45 percent from the field; 193-69 (9-1) when out-rebounding or tying opponents; and 149-26 (9-1) when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

DECEMBER DOMINANCE UNDER STANSBURY

Including last year's 3-3 mark coupled with this year's 7-0 record, the Bulldogs are 71-15 (.822) in the month of December since **Rick Stansbury** was named head coach.

Dating back to the 1987-88 season when Richard Williams was overseeing the program, Mississippi State owns a composite ledger of 129-39 (.768) in December.

STEWART, VARNADO CLOSING IN ON MILESTONES

From 2000-03, Derrick Zimmerman played in 127 games. From 1980-83, Kalpatrick Wells started 110 games.

Both are school records. Both are likely to fall later this year.

Currently, **Jarvis Varnado** has played in *118* and has drawn *96* starts, while fellow senior **Barry Stewart** has appeared in *118* games with *83* starts to his credit.

Stewart is also likely to break Jeff Malone's minutes-played record of 3,851. He currently has 3,628 and needs to average around 12.4 minutes for the rest of the regular season to set a new mark. Currently, he's averaging 32.9 minutes through the first 13 games.

BOMBS AWAY...FIRING ON ALL CYLINDERS

Last year, Mississippi State set a single-season record with 296 made 3-pointers. Already, the Bulldogs are ahead of that pace.

MSU has connected on 138 of its 330 attempts through the first 13 games. In comparison, State was 83 of 244 through the first 13 games last year. If the pace continues, the Bulldogs will finish with 329 in just the regular season.

Ravern Johnson leads MSU with 43 3-pointers on 88 attempts and is on pace to finish with 102, which would be a single-season record. Darryl Wilson currently holds the top two spots with 97 in 1996 and 94 in 1995.

Through 13 games a year ago, Johnson was 27 of 56 and was one of the best in the nation as far as percentage was concerned.

Jarvis Varnado leads the nation with 165 and Lady Bulldog standout Chanel Mokango was ninth with 97. MSU was the only BCS school where the men and the women led their conference in blocked shots.

MAKING THE 3S OFF THE COURT

●In the spring, MSU not only excelled on the court, it put up impressive numbers in the classroom, too. The 16 players on the roster posted an overall GPA of 2.68, the second-highest average in two years. Seven players fi nished with a GPA of 3.0 or better, while two had a 4.0.

OVERCOMING MAJOR DEFICITS

●Three times last year, MSU has rallied from double-digit deficits — Arkansas (15) and South Carolina twice (10 both times) . The most a Rick Stansbury-coached team has battled back from is 20 (Kentucky, 1-5-02).

MSU KNOWS HOW TO WIN GAMES AT 'THE HUMP'

Over the course of the last decade, Mississippi State's Humphrey Coliseum has become a difficult venue for opposing teams. Since the 2006-07 season, the Bulldogs have posted a 45-12 mark for an .789 winning percentage. With a 13-5 mark last year, the Bulldogs have reached twin-digit home wins during each of coach Rick Stansbury's first 11 seasons at the MSU helm.

Mississippi State is now 141-34 (.806) overall at Humphrey Coliseum under Stansbury's direction, including a 65-23 (.739) SEC mark and a 76-11 (.874) record against non-conference opponents.

The Bulldogs have compiled a 35-season composite record of 347-132 (.724) at "The Hump" since Mississippi State's basketball facility opened prior to the 1975-76 campaign.

BRYANT BECOMES FIRST MSU SIGNEE OF 2009-10 SIGNING CLASS

Mississippi State coach Rick Stansbury has announced his first signee of the 2009-10 class, standout guard Brian Bryant.

The 6-foot-3, 165-pound Albany, Ga., native is currently a sophomore at Northwest Florida State College, where he has guided his team to a 5-0 start and is averaging 20 points, 7.6 rebounds and 5.4 assists, while shooting 41 percent from 3-point territory.

Last year as a freshman, he was limited due to a hand injury.

Prior to enrolling at Northwest Florida, previously known as Okaloosa Walton, Bryant prepped four years at Dougherty High School, where he led his team to two regional titles and four playoff appearances.

As a senior, he averaged 29.6 points, 9.3 rebounds, 3.6 steals and 3.6 assists en route to garnering team MVP honors and earning Albany

Herald Play of the Year honors for the second-straight season.

He was also selected to play in the Georgia North-South All-Star Game.

"He is the complete package of talent, athleticism, character and work ethic," 13th-year Raiders coach Bruce Stewart said. "He is a winner."

Bryant chose MSU over Auburn and Southern Miss.

Bryant is the fifth NWF State College men's player to head to the SEC in the last three seasons, following in the footsteps of Auburn's Tay Waller and Johnnie Lett, Alabama's Charvez Davis and South Carolina's Johndre Jefferson

He's also the second player MSU signed from Northwest Florida, joining forward Branden Vincent, who played for the Bulldogs from 2003-04.



THE JUNIORS

45 • Elgin Bailey • F/C • 6-8 • 254 • New Orleans, LA

Bailey saw action in 27 games last year before dislocating his ankle against Florida. He still managed to finish second on the team in blocked shots with 26. Bailey finished the year averaging 3.9 points and 2.4 rebounds. He returned to the court against SE Louisiana but did not play against Bethune-Cookman. Scored his first point of the year on a free throw against Texas-Pan American and logged four minutes against Richmond and six against Old Dominion in South Padre. Hasn't played in the last six games and will likely apply for a medical redshirt.

15 • Riley Benock • G • 6-4 • 180 • Battletown, KY

He has seen action in all 13 games and is averaging 2.6 points and has collected eight steals and dished out 12 assists. His best outing came against Centenary and St. Bonaventure, where he totaled 9 points on three 3-pointers on each occasion. He had two treys against DePaul and finished with six points. Had three points against UCLA in eight minutes. Did not score against Wright State or Houston, but had two steals in 18 minutes against Mississippi Valley State. Hailing from the same high school as Mississippi State head coach Rick Stansbury, Riley saw action in all 36 games as a reserve. He averaged 2.3 points and 0.9 rebounds per outing. His 16 steals tied for fifthmost on the team. He is returning from foot surgery to repair a stress fracture over the offseason.

THE SOPHOMORES

4 • Twany Beckham • G • 6-5 • 190 • Louisville, KY

Beckham played in the last 32 games of last season and was one of MSU'S first players off the bench. He logged a total of 33 minutes in the SEC Tournament and averaged 1.5 points, 2.0 rebounds and dished out three assists. He finished the year averaging 1.6 points and 1.5 boards a game.

5 • Romero Osby • F • 6-8 • 230 • Meridian, MS

Has seen action in 12 of 13 games this year games and is averaging 5.6 points and 3.0 boards. He's also tied for fourth with five blocks. Scored a season-high 13 points against DePaul to go along with his season-best sevene rebounds. Had five points and five rebounds against St. Bonaventure and had eight points against Texas-Pan American. Against UCLA, he had two points and two rebounds. In his last outing against Wright State, he scored scored 10 points on 4-of-4 shooting, including a 2-of-2 mark beyond the arc. Played just two minutes at Houston, but in 17 minutes against Centenary he finished with 8 points on 3-of-5 shooting. Didn't play against Mississippi Valley State due to a family matter. Osby played in all 36 games for the Bulldogs as a true freshman last year. He scored a career-high 15 points against North Alabama. He also averaged 4.1 points and 2.6 boards per contest, while scoring in double-digits three times. Osby also finished fourth on the team with 12 blocks.

THE FRESHMEN

30 • Wendell Lewis • C • 6-8 • Selma, AL

Has seen action in all 13 games and had a career-high 7 points against St. Bonaventure, while tying his career of five rebounds (Bethune-Cookman). He is currently averaging 2.4 points and 2.3 rebounds. In 14 minutes against DePaul, he hauled in four rebounds. He had four points and a rebound against UCLA. Totaled 4 points and 2 boards against Wright State but didn't play in the second half due to a slightly sprained ankle. Scored one point against Houston in four minutes and had two points against Centenary in eight minutes and had two points and a rebound in 10 minutes against Mississippi Valley State. Signed in April, Lewis chose MSU over SEC rivals Auburn, Georgia, Alabama and Ole Miss. He was selected to compete in the Mississippi-Alabama All-Star game. As a McDonald's All-American nominee, Lewis was ranked as the 27th best center by ESPN. While earning team MVP honors his senior year, he led the team in points (16.5), rebounds (11.2) and blocks (3).

50 • John Riek • F • 7-1 • 242 • Khartoun, Sudan

After sitting out an NCAA-mandated nine game suspension to start the year, John Riek saw his first action against Wright State, but logged just one minute of play. He traveled for the first time to Houston, but did not play. Saw his most significant action against Centenary, where he totaled six points and grabbed seven reboudns in just eight minutes. Against Mississippi Valley State, he had four points, five rebounds and three blocks in 11 minutes. The final member of the MSU recruiting class, Riek inked his commitment to the Bulldogs in May of 2009. With enhanced shot-blocking and rebounding skills, he made a name for himself at the LeBron Skill Academy where he scored 18 points in 24 minutes. His 7 foot, 8 ½ inch wingspan made him the top-rated center by Rivals.com in the class of 2008.

10 • Shaun Smith • G • 6-6 • 195 • Brooksville, MS

The first member of the 2009 MSU signing class, the heralded All-State member from Noxubee County is known for his athleticism and ball-handling skills. Ranked the 23rd best shooting guard in the country by Scout.com, Smith inked his next four years with Bulldog basketball on his birthday. As a senior, he averaged 25.1 points, 5.8 rebounds and 2.2 steals.

1 • Renardo Sidney • G • 6-10 • 260 • Jackson, MS

Is waiting to be cleared to play by the NCAA. One of MSU's most highly touted recruits, Sidney brings numerous accolades including McDonald's All American selection, USA Junior National Select Team inclusion as well as Naismith High School Player of the Year finalist. He was also tabbed Co-MVP at the Jordan Brand Classic at the famous Madison Square Garden in New York City. Sidney made his national impression at the McDonald's All-Star game where he scored 11 points while grabbing 6 rebounds.

Mississippi State 82 Oklahoma City 54

STARKVILLE, Miss. — Junior Ravern Johnson's 23 points sparked a convincing 82-54 win by 18th-ranked Mississippi State against Oklahoma City in the exhibition opener for both teams at Humphrey Coliseum.

Johnson drained 6-of-10 three-pointers, shot 8-of-15 from the floor and grabbed five rebounds.

Three other Bulldogs recorded doubledigit efforts in the win, led by junior Kodi Augustus' 16 points. Sophomore Dee Bost joined senior Barry Stewart by scoring 11 points, while Bost added 6 assists.

All-SEC senior Jarvis Varnado grabbed 11 rebounds, notched 8 points and blocked 4 shots. Freshman Wendell Lewis continued his impressive preseason performance by claiming 8 rebounds in just 13 minutes.

OCU point guard Chris Brown led the game with 24 points.

The Bulldogs struggled with their opponents in the first half, but never trailed in the game. After scoring the first eight points, State saw two free-throws from OCU's Brown spark a 10-0 run that pulled the game within a point. At the break, MSU led 38-33 half.

STARKVILLE, Miss. — Junior forward Kodi Augustus scored 16 points and grabbed 11 rebounds to pace 18th-ranked Mississippi State to a 90-70 win agaisnt Georgetown College.

MSU completed its two-game exhibition slate having never trailed in either game.

Augustus connected on 6-of-9 shots from the floor and all three of his free throws. All-SEC senior Jarvis Varnado totaled 17 points, 9 rebounds and 5 blocks.

Also scoring in double-digits were sophomore point guard Dee Bost with 14 points to go along with his 8 assists, while Phil Turner totaled 12 points.

Pacing the game in scoring was Georgetown's Eddie Gray with 19.

State jumped out to an early eight-point lead in the game's first 10 minutes. The Tigers responded with a six-point run capped by two consecutive treys from Vincent Crutcher to pull within two points with 8:50 left in the half. The Bulldogs responded in a big way, finishing the half on a 23-5 run sparked by a Varnado pass resulting in a dunk from Augustus. MSU led 41-22 at the break.

Rider 88 Mississippi State 74

STARKVILLE, Miss. — Mississippi State senior Jarvis Varnado collected his 16th career double-double despite the Bulldogs dropping a 88-74 decision to Rider in front of 7,241 fans at Humphrey Coliseum.

Varnado, collected 22 points and 14 rebounds on the night as MSU dropped the opening game of the season for the first time since a 79-76 setback to Louisiana-Lafayette in 2002.

Varnado also tallied seven blocks and scored six of the game's first 11 points to give the Bulldogs an early nine-point advantage.

Dee Bost and Ravern Johnson also reached double figures, scoring 14 and 10 points, respectively.

State maintained the lead until the 45-second mark when a Mike Ringgold layup gave the Rider a lead that it would never relinquish. Ringgold and Novar Gadson collected 21 points each to lead Rider.

The opener was marred by a Rider squad that went 30-of-59 (50 percent) from the field, including a sizzling 62-percent clip from the 3-point stripe.

Stewart then drained two free throws with 31 seconds left and two missed shots from the charity stripe by Jackson gave State a chance with 26 seconds on the clock.

After a missed Stewart jumper, Varnado was fouled on the rebound but drained just one attempt from the stripe as State trailed 62-61 with nine seconds left. Pomare then broke away from a full-court trap to place San Diego ahead by three with just four seconds on the clock.
