WHAT TO NOTE AS MSU PLAYS NORTH FLORIDA . . .

- MSU is 7-1 all-time versus the teams from the Atlantic Sun Conference. The Bulldogs' lone loss came to South Carolina-Upstate on Dec. 20, 2014, in Jackson, 53-51. Their last game against an ASUN team was the following week against Jacksonville, 70-47.
- MSU has won 15 of its last 16 games in Jackson after its 70-64 win on Dec. 23 against USM.
- Freshman guard Nick Weatherspoon has now accounted for 10 of MSU's 13 charges taken.
- With his one block against the Golden Eagles, Aric Holman needs just six more to tie Gavin Ware for the eighth most in school history.
- In 29 games last year, junior All-SEC guard Quinndary Weatherspoon dished out 53 assists. Through 12 games this season, he has 54. As a freshman, he totaled 43 in 31 games.
- The Bulldogs lead the SEC and are 10th nationally in fewest points allowed at 61.1.
- Mississippi State has shot 50 percent or better from the flooir six times this season. Last year, the total was eight.
- Against Southern Miss, junior guard Xavian Stapleton had a season-high 12 points with a career-best four made 3-pointers. With his team trailing 54-50, he drained back-to-back treys to give MSU the lead for good.
- Mississippi State has held nine of its 12 opponents below 39 percent shooting and is second in the SEC in field goal percentage defense and 18th nationally at .379.
- Abdul Ado has 26 blocks on the year, a total that's eighth best by an MSU freshman in school history. His 2.4 clip is third in the SEC.
- Schnider Herard's streak of 43 games played in a row ended against Southern Miss.
- Under Ben Howland, MSU is 30-3 when leading at the half and 34-8 when shooting 45 percent or better from the floor.
- When Aric Holman scores in double-digits, the Bulldogs are 18-4 (9-1 this year).
- Mississippi State is looking for its first 12-1 start since opening the 2011-12 campaign 12-1.
- With 10 wins at Humphrey Coliseum, MSU has already matched its total from a year ago.

Q & GAME WINNERS

■ Game-winning shots have become the norm for junior All-SEC guard Quinndary Weatherspoon.

On Dec. 3 at home against Dayton, he collected a steal with 4 seconds left and went the length of the court for a layup to give MSU a thrilling 61-59 win.

Then against Jacksonville State, he drained a 3-pointer with 0.7 seconds left to lift the Bulldogs to a dramatic 59-56 win.

As a freshman against Vanderbilt, he drained a buzzer beater from 3-point range for a 75-74 victory.

SEEING DOUBLE

■ In the season opener against Alabama State, **Aric Holman** wasted little time recording a double-double.

The junior forward poured in 18 and grabbed 11 rebounds in the Bulldogs' win.

Against Green Bay, Abdul Ado broke into the category for his first with 12 points and 11 boards in just his second game at MSU.

Against Dayton, **Quinndary Weatherspoon** had 11 points and 10 rebounds for his third-career double-double.

Then against Cincinnati, Holman delivered again with 18 points and 10 rebounds.

He matched the feat in the win against UT Martin, marking the first time he's had double-doubles in back-to-back games.

In doing so, he had career highs in points (21) and rebounds (12).

LITTLE ACTION AT FTL

■ Three times this season, Mississippi State has limited opponents to just six free throw attempts or fewer.

Jacksonville State was the first, going 6-6 before North Georgia went 0-5.

Then against UT Martin on Saturday, the Skyhawks were just 4-6.

The last time MSU held an opponent without a free throw was on Jan. 19, 1985, in a 61-44 win against Ole Miss.

MSU FOUL SHOTS GO UP

■ After attempting 23 free throw attempts its previous three games, MSU made it to the charity stripe 21 times against UT Martin.

The Bulldogs' made (154) and attempted (230) free throws are the fewest in the SEC.

■ On Jan. 17, 2017, against Kentucky, MSU played its 600th in Humphrey Coliseum history, which dates to Dec. 1, 1975.

The Bulldogs are now 438-178 in the building following the Little Rock win.

MSU VERSUS RANKED FOES

■ After the 65-50 loss at Cincinnati, Mississippi State has now lost 18-straight games to ranked opponents.

Dating back to the 2010 season, MSU has dropped 20 of 23.

MSU SIGNS 3

■ Mississippi State took advantage of the early signing period and landed 5-star forward Reggie Perry and 4-star forwards DJ Stewart and Robert Woodard.

Perry, a 6-foot-8, 240-pound Thomasville, Ga., native, is the son of former MSU great Al Perry (1975-78), who ranks third all-time at MSU with 510 steals

He's rated as the No. 1 prospect out of the state of Georgia and listed as the No. 4 small forward nationally.

ESPN has him as the 16th best player regardless of position.

Woodard, the top-ranked player in Mississippi and a Dandy Dozen selection, is ranked 56th overall nationally and is the son of Robert Woodard, Sr., who played at MSU from 1987-90.

He led Columbus to the Class 6A crown in 2016 and was last year's Gatorade Player of the year.

The 6-6, 187-pound Stewart is listed as the 33rd best small forward.

As a junior at Riverside last year, he averaged 18.9 points, 9.7 rebounds and 3.1 assists.

Nationally, Scout has him as the 103rd best player overall, while Rivals has him at 103.

■ On Dec. 4, sophomore guard **Tyson Carter** became the first MSU player this season to receive one of the SEC's weekly honors.

After career-best 35 points against North Dakota State and 20 against Dayton, he was tabbed the league's player of the week.

His 35 points were the most scored since Darryl Wilson also had 35 against Alabama on 3-4-95.

BLOCK PARTY

■ Against Florida A&M on Nov. 18, Mississippi State recorded 13 blocked shots, with sophomore forward **Schnider Herard** leading the way with a career-high 6.

For MSU, it was the most blocks since also having 13 against Arkansas on Jan. 14, 2010.

The 6 blocks by Herard were also the most since Aric Holman had 5 last year against Northwestern St.

MSU is third in the SEC at 6.1.

BROTHERLY LOVE

■ Mississippi State is one of 29 schools nationally with brothers on the same team with **Quinndary** and **Nick Weatherspoon**.

They've also started all 12 games.

The last time MSU had two brothers start in the same game was Reginald and Reggie Delk against West Virginia in the NIT Final Four on March 27, 2007.

STINGY D

■ MSU has twice held opponents to 48 points. That ties for the fewest allowed in the SEC with Vanderbilt.

YOUTHFULL GROUP

■ The Bulldogs are one of five teams without any scholarship seniors, along with Kentucky, Holy Cross, Chattanooga and Robert Morris.

MSU's experience is ranked No. 329 out of 351 schools.

Ben Howland 22nd Season Overall | 3rd Season At Mississippi State 442-240 (41-34 at MSU)

- On March 23, 2015. Ben Howland was named the 20th head coach in Mississippi State history.
- In four different stints as a head coach, Howland has a 442-240 record -Northern Arizona (79-59), Pittsburgh (89-40), UCLA (233-107) and Mississippi State (41-34).
- · Led UCLA to three-consecutive Final Fours.
- In 2006, the Bruins played Florida for the national championship.
- In 2008, Howland became one of three coaches in NCAA Division I his-

tory to win at least 30 games in three-straight seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky 1947-49) and John Calipari (Memphis, 2006-08).

- During his 10-year tenure at UCLA, the Bruins went to the NCAA Tournament seven times and won four Pac-10 regular-season crowns, while having 18 players drafted by NBA teams.
- His 97 victories from 2006-08 stand as the most by any UCLA head coach in a three-year span.
- Has been a Conference Coach of the Year in the Pac-10, Big East and Big Sky.
- His final two years at Pitt, the Panthers went 57-11 and reached the Sweet 16 both years.
- In 2003, Pittsburgh won the Big East Tournament crown and held the nation's No. 2 ranking for eight weeks in the Associated Press poll before ending the year at No. 4.
- In 2002, Howland guided the Panthers to a school-record 29 wins en route to becoming the school's first coach in 26 years to garner National Coach of the Year honors.
- Howland's first coaching gig was at Northern Arizona, where his last three teams posted 20-plus win seasons, including a school-record 21 victories in 1997 en route to capturing the Big Sky regularseason title and played in the NIT.
- In 1998, Howland guided NAU to its first NCAA Tournament after capturing the Big Sky Tournament championship and second-straight regular-season crown.
- Howland spent one year as a graduate assistant at Gonzaga (1981) before becoming an assistant at California-Santa Barbara from 1982-94.
- Played two years at Santa Barbara College before transferring to Weber State, where he earned his degree in physical education in 1979.

Pittsburgh (2000-03)

• Howland and his wife, Kim, a former Weber State cheerleader, have two children – Meredith and Adam (Brittney) - and two grandsons, Benjamin Clark Howland II and Elijah Howland.
