Conference Notes

- Six SEC teams are in the top 50 of the Jan. 23 NCAA RPI with Kentucky leading the way at No. 3 while Florida is 11th, South Carolina 20th, Arkansas 33rd, Georgia 45th and Ole Miss 46th.
- Eleven SEC schools rank in the top 100 of the NCAA's RPI (as of Jan. 23). It is the third-highest total of Top 100 teams of any conference.
- All 14 SEC teams have played Top 150 SOS.
- Kentucky is ranked No. 4 in this week's Associated Press poll while South Carolina is 23rd and Florida is 25th.
- Road teams are 23-25 (47.9 percent) in league play this season.
- According to KenPom.com, the SEC ranks 32nd out of 32 conferences in terms of experience and seven SEC teams rank among the 60 most inexperienced teams in the nation. Mississippi State ranks 350 out of 351 teams while Kentucky is 345th, Missouri 338th, Tennessee 334th, LSU 333rd, Auburn 327th and Texas A&M 296th.
- Kentucky (1), Alabama (6), Florida (12), Arkansas (18), Texas A&M (28), Mississippi State (30), Georgia (31) and Auburn (32) have each signed Top 35 recruiting classes for 2017 according to ESPN.com.

Team/Individual Notes

- SEC Player of the Week – Ole Miss' Terence Davis, a 6-foot-4, 201-pound sophomore guard from Southaven, Miss., averaged 19 points, 11 rebounds and four assists in wins over Tennessee and at Missouri. He scored a career-high 20 points and grabbed 11 rebounds to help the Rebels knock off Tennessee. Thirteen of his 20 points came after halftime as Ole Miss overcame a 13-point second half deficit against the Vols. Davis recorded his fourth double-double of the season and his second of the week at Missouri

with 19 points, 11 boards and four assists.

- SEC Freshman of the Week – Auburn's Austin Wiley, a 6-foot-11, 255-pound center from Hoover, Ala., averaged 14.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in wins over LSU and Alabama. He totaled career-highs of 19 points and nine rebounds along with 25 minutes to lead Auburn to an 84-64 victory over Alabama. Wiley scored 15 of his 19 points and seven of his nine rebounds in the second half as the Tigers broke away from a 30-30 tie at halftime. He had 10 points, six rebounds and two blocks in Auburn's win over LSU.
- South Carolina is 5-1 since Sindarius Thornwell returned from suspension and is 11-1 on the season with him in the lineup.
- No opponent this season has reached its season average in regulation against the Florida defense.
- UK's Malik Monk is leading the SEC in scoring at 21.7 ppg. He is attempting to become just the fourth freshman to lead the league in scoring and the first since LSU's Chris Jackson averaged 30.2 ppg in 1989.
- Vanderbilt's Riley LaChance is shooting 56.9 percent (41-72) from 3-point range. The SEC record for 3-point percentage (minimum 100 attempts) is 52.9 percent (101-191) by Kentucky's Travis Ford in 1993.
- Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl earned his 500th career victory Jan. 18. He joins Kentucky's John Calipari (637) and Tennessee's Rick Barnes (629) as active SEC coaches with at least 500 career wins.
- Ole Miss's Sebastian Saiz ranks sixth in the NCAA statistics with 11.5 rebounds per game and sixth with 13 double-doubles on the season.
- Kentucky ranks third nationally with 92.9 ppg and in scoring margin at 20.8 ppg.

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2017 SEC Tournament

The Southeastern Conference Men's Basketball Tournament returns to Bridgestone Arena in Nashville in 2017. It will be the seventh time that the arena has served as the host of the SEC Tournament, having also hosted in 2001, 2006, 2010, 2013, 2015 and 2016.

Also the home of the NHL's Nashville Predators, Bridgestone Arena has the distinction of being one of the busiest venues in the United States over the past decade and a half, hosting more than 18 million guests during that time. Seating capacity is approximately 19,395 for basketball games.

The winner of the 13-game tournament receives the SEC's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-14 based on their regular season conference finish.

Atlanta served as host of the inaugural SEC Tournament played following the 1932-33 season and did so again after the 1933-34 season. The event was held every year through 1952, with the exception of 1935. After a 26-year layoff (1953-78), the tournament was renewed in 1979. The 2017 tournament will be the 58th in league history and the 39th since the renewal.



The SEC has shown extraordinary balance in the tournament, evidenced by the fact that a different school won the first seven titles after the renewal. The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 23 of the tournament champions since the tournament resumed in 1979 have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Three of the last 11 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. Since the renewal in 1979, the SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only four times.

Kentucky leads the league with 29 SEC Tournament titles. Alabama is second with six, while Tennessee and Florida are tied for third with four. Mississippi State has three championship trophies while Georgia, Ole Miss and Vanderbilt have two. Arkansas, Auburn, LSU and former league member Georgia Tech have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC Success

- Throughout the history of men's college basketball, the Southeastern Conference has captured 11 NCAA Championships and four NIT titles, putting the SEC as one of the nation's top basketball conferences.
- Twelve of the 14 SEC coaches have led their teams to the NCAA Tournament. One not included in that list is entering his second season coaching collegiately and was previously named the NBA Coach of the Year while directing his team to the NBA Finals. The other coach has directed his teams to four postseason appearances in five years as a head coach.
- Eight SEC coaches have taken their teams to the Sweet 16, seven have advanced to the Elite Eight and five have gone on to the Final Four (includes Division II).
- Five SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four (includes DII) with three winning national championships.
- Ole Miss head coach Andy Kennedy is the winningest at his institution.
- 13 of the 14 SEC coaches have earned conference coach of the year honors and five have been named national coach of the year.
- Six SEC players were picked at the 2015 NBA Draft, including five who were chosen in the first round.
- LSU's Ben Simmons was drafted No. 1 overall in the 2016 NBA Draft. He is the fifth SEC player to be picked first overall in the draft and the fourth in the last seven years.
- The SEC's 17 Lottery Picks since 2010 are the most of any conference. The Big 12 was second with 15 and ACC was third with 14.
- Over the last seven NBA Drafts, 53 SEC players have heard their names called. Thirty-one of those were selected in the first round and four were the No. 1 overall pick.
- Sixteen of ESPN.com's Top 100 players have signed with SEC schools in the class of 2015. Over the last two recruiting classes, SEC schools have signed 37 Top 100 players.
- Seven of the top 25 scorers from 2016 are slated to return as well as 10 of the top 20 rebounders and three of the top 10 playmakers.
- The SEC has had at least one team in the Final Four in six of the past 11 years. Twelve times in the last 24 years the SEC has had at least one team in the Final Four.
- Six different SEC teams (Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU and Mississippi State) have appeared in the Final Four.
- The SEC was 3-3 in NCAA Tournament games in 2016. It is the sixth consecutive season the SEC has been .500 or better in the NCAA Tournament. It is the 55th time the league has been .500 or better in NCAA Tournament games.
- The SEC has won three of the last 12 NCAA titles (2006-Florida, 2007-Florida, 2012 Kentucky). No other conference has won more titles during that stretch (ACC and Big East also have three titles).
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in 26 of the last 27 years. Thirteen of the SEC's 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16 since 1996.
- SEC teams are 18-4 (81.8 percent) in postseason opening games over the last two years (7-0 in 2014, 6-2 in 2015 and 5-2 in 2016).
- Every team in the SEC has made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last 12 editions of the NCAA Tournament.
- 72 men's basketball students were named to the SEC Academic Honor Rolls (Winter and First Year) for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above. Over the last two seasons, 186 men's basketball students have been listed on the SEC Academic Honor Rolls.
- Kentucky's Alex Poythress was named third team Academic All-America
- Alabama's Retin Obasohan, Kentucky's Alex Poythress, South Carolina's Mindaugas Kacinas and Vanderbilt's Luke Kornet earned first team Academic All-District honors from CoSIDA.
- Forty-one SEC men's basketball students active in 2015-16 have received their degrees. Additionally, former stars Rashad Wright (Georgia) and Johnny Neumann (Ole Miss) were among players returning to complete their degrees.
