Conference Notes

• The SEC's eight NCAA Tournament selections is the most in league history. The previous record was six which was accomplished nine times, most recently in 2008.

• The SEC's 10 teams advancing to postseason play (8 NCAA, 2 NIT) ties for the most in league history. In 2001, six SEC teams received NCAA Tournament invites while four participated in the NIT.

• SEC teams are 52-24 (68.4 percent) in the NCAA Tournament since 2012 (10-3 in 2012, 4-3 in 2013, 12-3 in 2014, 6-5 in 2015, 3-3 in 2016, 11-5 in 2017 and 6-2 in 2018).

• SEC teams are 31-9 (77.5 percent) in postseason opening games over the last five years (7-0 in 2014, 6-2 in 2015, 5-2 in 2016, 5-3 in 2017 and 7-2 in 2018).

• The SEC's eight teams in the Top 50 of the Selection Sunday RPI led the nation: No. 8 Tennessee, No. 10 Kentucky, No. 15 Auburn, No. 29 Texas A&M, No. 30 Arkansas, No. 42 Alabama, No. 43 Missouri and No. 46 Florida.

• Thirteen SEC teams had Top 60 SOS and five were in the Top 15.

• The SEC's 128 Quadrant 1 and Quadrant 2 wins are more than any other conference.

• The SEC earned a 6-4 win in the fifth annual Big 12/SEC Challenge on Jan. 27. Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Kentucky, Tennessee and Vanderbilt each picked up wins to give the league the trophy.

• The SEC led the nation with six former players being named NBA All-Stars.

• SEC basketball teams won 75.4 percent of their regular season non-conference games in 2018. That is the best regular season non-conference winning percentage since 2006-07 (77.4 percent).

Team/Individual Notes

• Alabama is making its 20th appearance in the NCAA Tournament and first since 2012.

• For the third time in the last four seasons, Arkansas punched its ticket to the Big Dance. It is The Razorbacks' 32nd NCAA Tournament appearance.

• Auburn is playing in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2013. It is the Tiger's ninth time in the NCAA Tournament.

• Florida earned an NCAA Tournament bid for the second straight season. It marks the Gators' 19th appearance overall and the second in three seasons under Mike White.

• Kentucky extended its national record for most NCAA Tournament appearances to 57. This is the fifth straight appearance in the NCAA Tournament for the Wildcats.

• LSU is making its eighth NIT appearance and hosted for the fourth time.

• Mississippi State returned to postseason play for the first time since 2012 with its ninth overall appearance in the NIT.

• Missouri received its 27th invitation to the NCAA Tournament while head coach Cuonzo Martin is taking his third different team to the Big Dance.

• Tennessee is making its 21st all-time NCAA Tournament appearance and its first since 2014, when it advanced to its seventh Sweet Sixteen.

• Texas A&M is making its 14th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Eight of the Aggies' 14 appearances have come since 2006.

• Auburn and Tennessee shared the 2018 SEC Championship with 13-5 conference records. It is Auburn's third SEC title and first since 1999. It is Tennessee's 10th SEC championship and first since 2008.

• Kentucky won its 31st SEC Tournament Championship and ran its tournament winning streak to 12 games.
