Conference Notes

- An NCAA-best five SEC teams rank in the top 25 of the Dec. 11 NCAA RPI, including No. 2 Missouri, No. 5 Texas A&M, No. 8 Tennessee, No. 9 Arkansas and No. 25 Alabama.
- Eleven SEC teams rank in the Top 100 of the NCAA RPI.
- Seven SEC schools have played schedules that rank in the Top 50 according to the Dec. 11 NCAA RPI.
- An NCAA-leading nine SEC schools have a non-conference SOS that ranks in the Top 150.
- According to the Dec. 11 NCAA RPI, Missouri has played the most difficult schedule in the nation while Arkansas' schedule is ranked fourth most difficult.
- Eight teams are receiving mention in the Associated Press Top 25 highlighted by Top 10 teams Kentucky (8th) and Texas A&M (9th). Tennessee continues to climb in the rankings, coming in at 20th, while Florida is 22nd. Arkansas, Mississippi State, Alabama and Georgia are receiving votes.
- The SEC schedule begins December 30 with three games and then follows up with two games on December 31.
- The SEC Tournament will be played on the western banks of the Mississippi River for the first time when St. Louis, Mo., plays host to the 2018 event.

Team/Individual Notes

- SEC Player of the Week – LSU's Duop Reath, a 6-foot-11, 244-pound senior forward from Perth, Australia, scored a career-high 30 points in 27 minutes of action in leading the Tigers to a win over UNCW. He came off the bench to make 76.5 percent (13-of-17) of his field goal attempts and three of four free throws.
- SEC Freshman of the Week – Arkansas' Daniel Gafford, a 6-foot-11, 234-pound forward from El

Dorado, Ark., averaged 15 points 6.5 rebounds and four blocks in wins over Colorado State and No. 14 Minnesota. Gafford had 16 points, seven rebounds and six blocks against Minnesota. He was perfect from the field against the Gophers, making all eight of his shots. Gafford had 14 points and six rebounds in a win over Colorado State. He has pulled down five or more rebounds in seven straight games and has multiple blocks in five games, including three or more in three.

- Mississippi State has started the season 8-0 for the first time since beginning the 2003-04 campaign 13-0.
- Mississippi State is one of seven teams in the nation that remain undefeated.
- Texas A&M is holding opponents to just 36.2 percent shooting from the field and 23.3 percent from 3-point range which ranks fifth and second, respectively, in the nation.
- LSU ranks third nationally by converting 53.6 percent of its field goal attempts.
- LSU's Tremont Waters narrowly missed a triple-double against UNCW (Dec. 10) when he had 20 points, 10 assists and nine rebounds.
- Alabama's Donta Hall is third in the nation by making 75.0 percent of this field goal attempts.
- Florida's Egor Koulechov ranks fourth in the nation with his 96.4 percent free throw shooting.
- After a preseason media poll tabbed Tennessee to finish 13th in the SEC, the Volunteers are ranked 20th in the latest Associated Press poll.
- Tennessee's James Daniel III is NCAA Division I's leading active scorer with 1,984 career points.
- Kentucky's John Calipari reached the 700 on-court wins milestone in 894 career games on Nov. 26. Only Adolph Rupp (836 games), Jerry Tarkanian (876 games) and Roy Williams (879 games) reached 700 wins faster.

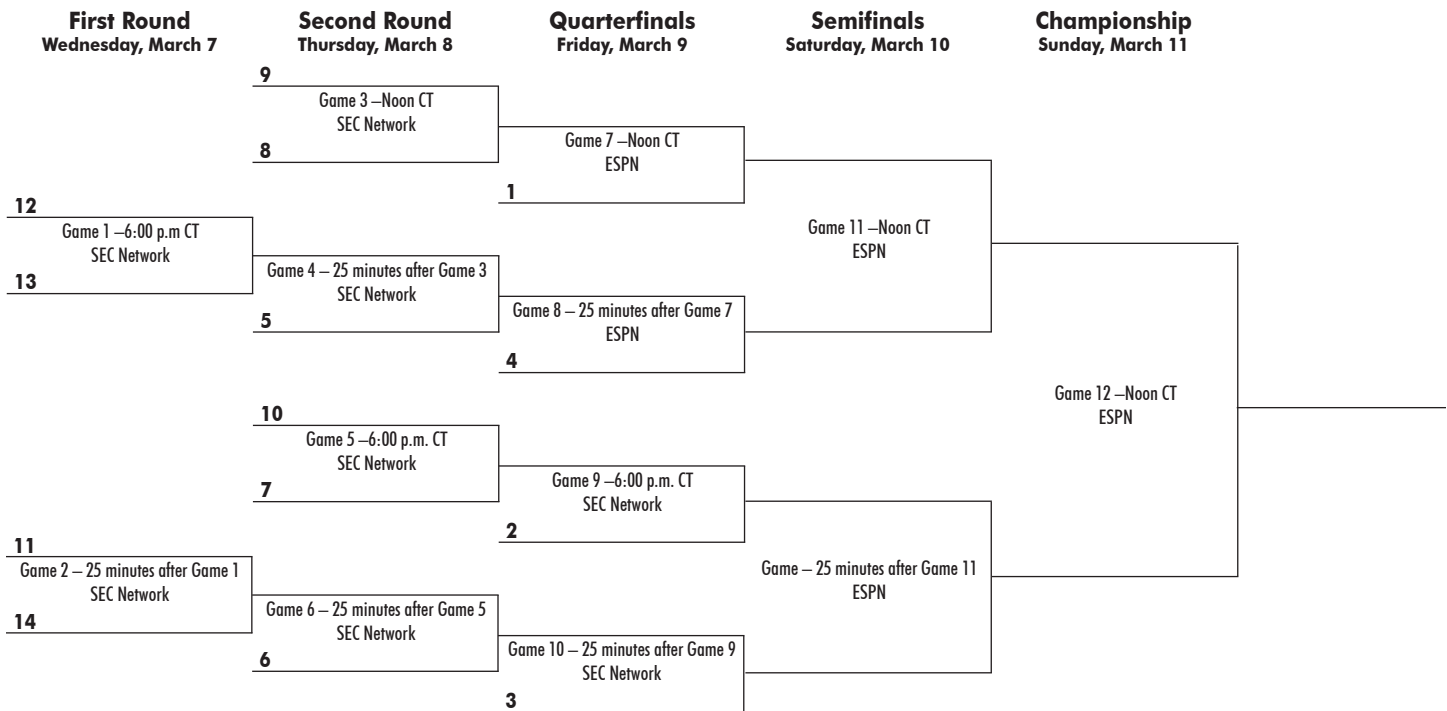

2018 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • SCOTTRADE CENTER • ST. LOUIS, MO



The Southeastern Conference Men's Basketball Tournament will be played on the western banks of the Mississippi River for the first time when St. Louis, Mo, plays host to the 2018 event.

Scottrade Center is a contemporary, 12-story glass and concrete structure located in the heart of downtown St. Louis. The home of the St. Louis Blues Hockey Club, Scottrade Center also features a full range of arena programming, including concerts, ice shows, family shows and other sporting events. Scottrade Center plays host to approximately 175 events per year, bringing nearly 2 million guests to downtown St. Louis annually and ranking it among the top arenas in the country.

The tournament has been played on the eastern banks of the Mississippi seven times with Baton Rouge (1938 and 1988), Memphis (1994 and 1997) and New Orleans (1996, 2003 and 2012) previously serving as hosts.

The winner of the 13-game tournament receives the SEC's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-14 based on their regular season conference finish.

Atlanta served as host of the inaugural SEC Tournament played following the 1932-33 season and did so again after the 1933-34 season. The event was held every year through 1952, with the exception of 1935. After a 26-year layoff (1953-78), the tournament was renewed in 1979. The 2018 tournament will be the 59th in league history and the 40th since the renewal.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 24 of the tournament champions since the tournament resumed in 1979 have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Three of

the last 12 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. Since the renewal in 1979, the SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only four times.

Kentucky leads the league with 30 SEC Tournament titles. Alabama is second with six, while Tennessee and Florida are tied for third with four. Mississippi State has three championship trophies while Georgia, Ole Miss and Vanderbilt have two. Arkansas, Auburn, LSU and former league member Georgia Tech have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC Tournament Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Men's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

- A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
- D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC Success

- Throughout the history of men's college basketball, the Southeastern Conference has captured 11 NCAA Championships and four NIT titles, putting the SEC as one of the nation's top basketball conferences.
- Thirteen of the 14 SEC coaches have led their teams to the NCAA Tournament. The one not included in that list is entering his third season coaching collegiately and was previously named the NBA Coach of the Year while directing his team to the NBA Finals.
- Nine SEC coaches have taken their teams to the Sweet 16, seven have advanced to the Elite Eight and five have gone on to the Final Four (includes Division II).
- Five SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four (includes DI) with two winning national championships.
- Ole Miss head coach Andy Kennedy is the winningest at his institution.
- 13 of the 14 SEC coaches have earned conference coach of the year honors and five have been named national coach of the year.
- Six SEC players were picked at the 2015 NBA Draft, including five who were chosen in the first round.
- LSU's Ben Simmons was drafted No. 1 overall in the 2016 NBA Draft. He is the fifth SEC player to be picked first overall in the draft and the fourth in the last seven years.
- The SEC's 17 Lottery Picks since 2010 are the most of any conference. The Big 12 was second with 15 and ACC was third with 14.
- Over the last seven NBA Drafts, 53 SEC players have heard their names called. Thirty-one of those were selected in the first round and four were the No. 1 overall pick.
- The SEC has had at least one team in the Final Four in seven of the past 12 years. Thirteen times in the last 25 years the SEC has had at least one team in the Final Four.
- Seven different SEC teams (Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State and South Carolina) have appeared in the Final Four.
- The SEC was 11-5 in NCAA Tournament games in 2017. It is the seventh consecutive season the SEC has been .500 or better in the NCAA Tournament. It is the 56th time the league has been .500 or better in NCAA Tournament games.
- The SEC has won three of the last 12 NCAA titles (2006-Florida, 2007-Florida, 2012 Kentucky). Only the ACC (three titles) has won more during that stretch.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in 27 of the last 28 years. All of the SEC's 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16 since 1996.
- SEC teams are 23-7 (76.7 percent) in postseason opening games over the last two years.
- Every team in the SEC has made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last 13 editions of the NCAA Tournament.
- Florida's Canyon Barry was named CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year while Vanderbilt's Luke Kornet was a CoSIDA Second Team Academic All-America selection. Arkansas' Moses Kingsley and Georgia's Juwan Parker each earned CoSIDA First Team Academic All-District honors.
- 72 men's basketball students were named to the 2016 SEC Academic Honor Rolls (Winter and First Year) for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
