2017-18 ARGOS TO WATCH



MARVIN JONES (G., 6-4, 185, Jr., Decatur, Ga.)

2016-17: Started 28 of 29 games on the season... Averaged 27.8 minutes per game... Led team in three-point percentage (43.2%)... Second on team in points per game (11.3)... Scored season-high 28 points in back to back games vs. Auburn Montgomery (2/20) and Lee (2/23)... Went 6-for-8 from three (75%) vs. Auburn Montgomery on 2/20... Tied second on team for blocks on season with 17... Tied 10th place in three-point field goals in a single season with 57... 43.2% three-point field goal percentage for season ranks seventh in program history. Junior College: Attended Shelton State Community College / Georgia Perimeter College... Second Team Junior College All-American, First Team All Conference, NJCAA Alabama Community Player of the Year.



RASHAAN BENSON (G, 6-0, 185, Jr., Memphis, Tenn.)

2016-17: Started all 29 games this season... Second on team with an averaged 30.9 minutes per game... Led team in assists per game (4.5) & second for steals on the season (35)... Scored season-high 22 points in back-to-back games vs. Valdosta State (12/12) and Union (12/15)... Posted season-high 10 assists on 01/02 vs. North Alabama... Averaged 10.6 points per game... Recorded a double-double on 1/2 vs. North Alabama... Finished fifth in conference for assists per game at 4.5... Tied 10th in single-season three-point field goals with 57... Finished seventh in single season three-point field goal percentage at 43.2%... Finished career ninth in assists with 222.

DARRYL TUCKER (F, 6-7, 205, Sr., Mount Vernon, N.Y.)

2016-17: Started three of 29 games... Averaged 19.5 minutes per game... Recorded five double-doubles on the season... Led team in defensive rebounds (141)... Second on team in offensive rebounds (78)... Tied second on team for blocks on season with 17... Third on team in steals with 29... Scored season-high 22 points 02/25 vs. Shorter... Recorded season-high 11 defensive rebounds on 02/16 vs. North Alabama... Averaged 10.5 points per game. Attended Central Georgia Technical College and Georgia Perimeter College . . . Named to All-Defensive Team in 2015-16.

2016-17: Played in 29 games... Averaged 19.7 minutes per game... Scored season-high 22 points 01/02 vs. North Alabama... Led team in steals with 42...Attended Western Texas College . . . Earned Defensive Player of the Year honors . . . Averaged 10 points, 2.3 rebounds, and 1.3 assists per game at Western Texas College... Posted 50% field goal percentage to go along with a 36% success rate from three-point range... Contributed 1.5 assists per game.

THE BURKHAMER FILE



Jeff Burkhamer became the fourth head men's basketball coach in UWF history when was hired on April 15, 2015.

Burkhamer enters his third season as UWF's head coach in 2017-18. He implemented a new culture for the program by bringing new energy and expectations to UWF basketball. The Argos finished his first season winning four of their last sev-

en games. The team finished 20-9 (14-8 GSC) in his second season, completing the biggest turnaround in UWF and Gulf South Conference history (7 wins to 20 wins).

Burkhamer has 33 years of coaching experience, including 15 as a head coach at the NCAA Division II level. He holds a career record of 400-222 in 20 years as a head coach. He was a combined 218-153 in seven seasons at Armstrong State and six at Lander, and he also posted a record of 155-41 in six seasons as a junior college head coach at North Greenville College and Santa Fe Community College.

CONTINUED IMPROVEMENT

- 2015-16 was head coach Jeff Burkhamer's first year at UWF and the team saw numerous immediate statistical improvements under Burkhamer's direction.
- The team made a major leap in 2016-17. UWF finished 20-9 (14-8 GSC) in his second season, completing the biggest turnaround in UWF and Gulf South Conference history (7 wins to 20 wins) while finishing one possession shy of the NCAA Tournament.
