QUICK FACTS

- The Tigers travel to Starkville to face off with Mississippi State.
- Missouri leads the all-time series over the Bulldogs 11-7.
- Mizzou swept South Carolina last weekend before downing Kansas City in a midweek contest.
- Kimberly Wert broke the Mizzou all-time home run record against South Carolina. She sits atop the Mizzou record book with 48 homers.
- Local product Kara Daly has been sensational for the Tigers in her freshman season. She is tied for the team lead with nine home runs on the season.
- Casidy Chaumont has been extremely productive in the field and at the plate. She leads the team with a .420 batting average while crushing 12 extra-base hits.
- Kendyll Bailey has reached base safely in each of the last 12 games, a career best mark. She has eight home runs on the season.
- Regining SEC Freshman of the Year Jenna Laird has been productive in year two. She surpassed the 100-hit mark for her career and she has already stolen 18 bases on the year.
- The Tigers return some experience in the circle with Jordan Weber and Laurin Krings. Krings has already surpassed her win total and her strikeout total from 2021.
- Mizzou is in the fourth season under head coach Larissa Anderson.
- Anderson is the 10th coach in program history, and owns a career record of 249-135-1 (.648) in her eight seasons as a head coach.
- Mizzou is coming off of a 42-17 showing and a Super Regional appearance in Anderson's third year at the helm.

SOUTH CAROLINA/KANSAS CITY RECAP

- The Tigers swept the Gamecocks for the second-straight year. Mizzou has won eight of the last nine meetings against South Carolina.
- Kimberly Wert broke the Mizzou all-time home run record with a solo home run in the first game of the series. She batted .667 on the weekend with a double, a home run and four RBI.
- Laurin Krings picked up a win in each of her two starts. She pitched 13 innings while allowing only three runs and striking out 15 batters.
- Graduate Kendyll Bailey continued her career season with a 4-for-10 performance at the plate with a home run. She also turned a pair of double plays at second base.
- Casidy Chaumont led the Tigers with a pair of extra-base hits against Kansas City, including a two-run home run.

LEADING OFF: BROOKE WILMES

- Brooke Wilmes was named Second Team All-SEC, NFCA First Team Southeast All-Region and NFCA Third Team All-American in 2021.
- She earned a preseason First Team All-American nod from Softball America ahead of the 2022 season and was recognized by the league's coaches as an All-SEC selection.
- Wilmes has eight home runs on the year, moving into tenth place in program history with 35.
- In the 2021 NCAA Columbia Regional and Super Regional, Wilmes homered in five of six games.
- She is one of five Tigers to reach 250 hits. She is currently fourth with 258 over her career.
- Wilmes is the second Tiger to ever record five hits in one game, against Florida State in 2021. All-American Rhea Taylor is the only other Tiger to accomplish the feat.
- The graduate student ranks in the Tigers' top ten for hits, runs, doubles, home runs and RBI.
- She led the team in batting average (.373) with 79 hits, tying her for fifth in program history for a single season in 2021.
- Against Illinois (Mar. 16), she recorded the first multi-home run game of her career while hitting three over the doubleheader.

SENSATIONAL SHORTSTOP

- Jenna Laird made a major impact on the Mizzou program as a Freshman and has continued her success in her sophomore season.
- She was named as the SEC Freshman of the Year, First Team All-SEC, SEC All-Freshman, and NFCA Southeast All-Region one year ago.
- Laird started every game at shortstop and batted .369 in her rookie campaign, including a .410 mark in SEC play.
- She was named SEC Freshman of the Week four times during the 2021 season.
- Laird set a career high with six RBIs in a win over Kent State in 2021.
- In the series-opening game with Mississippi State, Laird homered in each of her first two at bats for her first multi-home run game (April 17).
- The New Yorker was named to the NFCA/Schutt Sports Freshman of the Year Top 15 List.
- Laird has already stolen a career-high 16 bases in her sophomore season.
- She surpassed 100 career hits after only 86 games. She leads the team with 41 hits on the year.
- On the basepaths, Laird has been aggressive and difficult to catch. She is 30-for-32 on stolen base attempts in her career.

HATTI'S BACK

- Graduate catcher Hatti Moore is returning to the Tigers for a fifth season. She was recognized by the league's coaches as a preseason All-SEC selection.
- Moore batted .320 on the season with 17 home runs and 50 RBI. She led the team in walks and slugged at a .657 clip.
- Moore started 145 consecutive games behind the plate for Mizzou, a program record.
- Currently, she ranks eighth on the all-time program home run list with 38 round-trippers.
- She earned NFCA Southeast Second Team All-Region honors in 2021.
- Moore homered three times in a doubleheader twice last season. On the first day of the season, she smashed three against Florida State and Memphis.

TEAM AND PLAYER NOTES**WERT ALERT**

- Kimberly Wert crushed 17 home runs and 48 RBIs in 2021 and has continued her impressive offensive production in 2022.
- So far, she has smashed 14 extra-base hits, including five doubles and nine homers.
- Wert has reached 141 RBIs in her Mizzou career, ranking ninth in program history. She also added 13 RBIs in her freshman season at Hofstra.
- Wert broke the Mizzou all-time home run record against South Carolina with her 48th home run. Jen Bruck's record stood for 13 seasons.

HONNOLD'S GOLD

- Sophomore Alex Honnold has been very productive in her sophomore season.
- She is tied for second on the team with 12 extra-base hits, surpassing her total from 2021.
- She leads the team with three triples on the season, no other player has more than one.
- Against Liberty, Honnold went 2-for-4 with two doubles, her first game with multiple extra-base hits.
- She then tripled in back-to-back games against North Carolina and Bethune-Cookman.
- Honnold has started every game in right field.
- She homered and drove in a career high four runs in the Tigers' win over Stanford (March 20).
- As a freshman, she batted .278 with seven doubles, one triple and 16 RBI. She split time between second base, right field and designated player while making 31 starts over 46 appearances.

CHAUMONT SHOWS-OUT

- Casidy Chaumont earned SEC Co-Player of the Week honors after batting .615 with a double and two home runs at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic.
- She then batted .700 at the Mizzou Tournament with three doubles, a home run and nine RBI.
- Chaumont leads the team with a .420 batting average and a .754 slugging percentage.
- She again made SportsCenter's Top Ten Plays with diving catch against St. Thomas that was the seventh-best play of the day. It marked the fourth time over the last two seasons that she has made an appearance.
- The outfielder has driven in four runs in a single game in three separate contests on the year.

DEALING DUO

- Laurin Krings is again piling up the strikeouts with 131 over 102.2 innings of work.
- Krings and Jordan Weber combined for some dominant performances in the 2021 NCAA Tournament. The pair combined to allow only two hits over three games of the Columbia Regional.
- Weber tossed the 40th no-hitter in program history against Iowa State to clinch a spot in Supers. In the postseason, she recorded a 0.90 ERA over 31 innings.
- In her two NCAA Tournament starts, Krings went 2-0 with 14 innings pitched and 20 strikeouts.
- "Specs" led the Tigers with 122 strikeouts during the 2021 season and she held a 3.3 K/BB ratio. She has improved her K/BB ratio to 3.70 in 2022 with 122 strikeouts over 97.2 innings.
- Laurin Krings tossed her first no-hitter against Bethune-Cookman while striking out eight batters (Feb. 19), before tossing a perfect game against Bradley (Mar. 6).
- Krings' 14 strikeouts against Texas Tech represented the most by a Mizzou pitcher since 2013. She then matched the total with 14 strikeouts over six innings against Bradley.

HOME RUN RACE

- Hatti Moore, Kimberly Wert and Brooke Wilmes each rank among the top Mizzou home run hitters of all time.
- Wert sits atop the program home run list with 48 homers as a Tiger and Moore is in sole possession of eighth after crushing her 38th homer. Wilmes ranks tenth in program history after hitting her 35th career home run.
- Wert passed Jen Bruck for the all-time record against South Carolina (April 1).
- The 2021 team set a program record with 91 home runs on the season. Returning players hit 77 of 91 homers.
- The Tigers have crushed 52 home runs over 36 games in 2022.

EXPERIENCE IN THE CIRCLE

- After entering last season with only one upperclassman and very little postseason pitching experience, the Tigers will start 2022 in a different situation after making a deep run in the tournament.
- Jordan Weber was the ace of the staff in 2021. She made 27 starts on the year and went 12-7 with a 2.82 ERA. She led all pitchers with a .180 opposing batting average.
- Then-freshman Laurin Krings led the Tigers with 122 strikeouts compared to only 37 walks.
- Against Auburn, Weber became the first Mizzou pitcher to strikeout 13 batters since Chelsea Thomas in 2013 vs. LSU.
- Megan Schumacher led Mizzou pitchers with a 2.69 ERA.
- Jordan Weber tossed the program's 40th no-hitter against Iowa State to send Mizzou to the Super Regionals.
- Emma Nichols operated as the Tigers' closer and a key reliever. Entering in numerous high-pressure situations, Nichols tied for the nation's lead with seven saves in 2021.

TIGERS PICKED TO FINISH FIFTH IN SEC

- Mizzou was predicted to finish fifth in the hyper-competitive Southeastern Conference in a preseason vote among the league's coaches.
- The Tigers are placed between preseason No. 4 Tennessee (103 points) and preseason No. 6 LSU (93 points). Mizzou garnered 97 points in the preseason poll.
- Alabama was picked as the preseason favorite to win the SEC, garnering seven of the 13 first place. Florida (three), Arkansas (two) and Tennessee claimed the other six first place votes.
- Mizzou is no stranger to outperforming its predicted finish in the preseason coaches' poll.
- In 2019, the Tigers were predicted to finish last in the conference, but rallied to finish tied for sixth in the conference with a 12-12 record — reaching the NCAA Tournament.
- The Tigers finished with a 3-0 record in SEC play in 2020 after sweeping Ole Miss at home.
- Mizzou finished third in the SEC in 2021 after being picked to finish eighth overall. The Third-place finish matched the Tigers' best-ever since joining the Southeastern Conference.

TOUGH SCHEDULE IN 2022

- Coach Anderson set up a very challenging schedule for the Tigers in the 2022 season.
- Mizzou will play 19 games against teams ranked in at least one of the preseason polls.
- The Tigers play eight games against teams ranked in the top-15 of either preseason poll.
- Mizzou will face two of the top three teams in the nation according to the preseason polls in No. 2 Alabama and No. 3 UCLA.

Over the 45 years of its existence, Mizzou Softball has proven itself as a Women's College World Series-level program. Since 2017, the Tigers have a facility that matches the team's on-field excellence.

The \$17.5 million Mizzou Softball Stadium is located within the Mizzou Athletics Sports Park, and has ample amenities for fans and players alike. Featuring over 700 chairback seats – nearly 10 times the total of its predecessor, University Field – along with bleachers and a spacious outfield berm, the stadium can easily accommodate 2,500 fans.

Fans entering the stadium are greeted by a beautiful brick façade, complemented by a Centria paneling system. The stadium offers beautiful views whether sitting in the infield seating, or atop the berm area. LED lit 'Mizzou Tigers' signage hangs from the press level, and an LED-lit lantern piece sets atop the facility's main elevator.

A "full-view" concourse allows fans to not miss a pitch while visiting one of two concession stands or the on-site Tiger Team Store. The concourse is located beneath a spacious elevated press box, which features dedicated broadcast and radio booths, space for working press and game management, and a Club Suite.

Fans will also appreciate the brand-new video board; with over 300 square feet of LED display, it is much larger than the previous board at University Field.

The new field's dimensions are 200 feet at the foul lines and 220 feet at center field. A 10-foot, crushed-brick warning track separates the six-foot wall from an expansive outfield of lush Kentucky Bluegrass, carefully tended by Jerry Cummings and the Mizzou Sports Turf staff. The DuraEdge infield lays atop a drainage system built to USGA specs.

Both teams are protected from the elements by bench-heated dugouts, and have access to bullpens down their respective foul lines, and batting cages underneath the stands. In addition, six dedicated TV camera wells allow for easy production of SEC Network telecasts.

The Tigers' home team suite is located directly behind the third-base dugout, and includes, 32 lockers, and amenities such as a mud room, equipment-storage area and coaches meeting room.

One of the premier collegiate softball events came to Mizzou Softball Stadium in 2018, as the Tigers hosted the annual Southeastern Conference Tournament May 8-12. It marked Mizzou's first time ever hosting the SEC Tournament and only the second conference tournament ever to be held in Columbia, Mo. (1980 Big Eight Tournament). Big events are nothing new for the Tigers program, however, as Mizzou has served as the host for nine NCAA Regionals and four NCAA Super Regionals since 2005.
