SETTING THE SCENE

- Fresh off a Sun Belt Conference sweep of Coastal Carolina and its third series win of 2022, ULM
 faces Mississippi State in its first non-conference game in two weeks Tuesday evening. The two
 teams have not played since an early-season tournament in 2010. The Bulldogs are the second
 Southeastern Conference opponent for the Warhawks this season. ULM lost two games to thenNo. 21 Auburn in the Tigers' Plainsman Invitational in February.
- ULM and Mississippi State have not played since 2010 with the Bulldogs holding a 12-6 advantage in the series. The Warhawks won five of their six games in 1997 or seasons prior with the last ULM coming in 2000.
- The Warhawks outscored the Chanticleers 19-6 over the three-game series, which included
 their fifth shutout of the year, a 2-0 victory in game two. Over the weekend series, ULM had 31
 hits, the highest series total of 2022, while limiting Coastal Carolina to only 13 total hits, the
 lowest opponent total for an SBC series.
- Freshman second baseman Alexis Chavez extended her hit streak to 11 games, the longest current streak by a Warhawk. She is tied with Kennedy Johnson for second as both trail Lourdes Bacon's 41 hits with 37. She is third on the team with 22 runs scored and a .346 batting average. She is second behind Bacon with nine stolen bases. Kennedy Johnson and Gabby Davila both have six-game hitting streaks.
- ULM scored 11 runs and had 15 hits in the series opener vs. Coastal Carolina, the highest single-game totals for the Warhawks in Sun Belt games this year.
- For the second-straight series, ULM's pitching corps posted a combined ERA of 1.40 over the three-game sweep of Coastal Carolina. Kinsey Kackley, Victoria Abrams and Adrianna Chavarria allowed only three combined earned runs in the three games. Kackley picked up two wins, including a complete game shutout where she gave up only three hits in game two.
- The Warhawks started the 2022 season 7-0, their best start since going 10-0 to open the 2006 campaign. Head coach Molly Fichtner, in her fourth year at the helm of the program, has led the Warhawks to 23 wins already this season.

LEAD-OFF HITS

- Jacelyn Buck went 5-for-8 (.625) during the three-game Coastal Carolina series with three walks, 2 RBI, two doubles, seven total bases and one run scored. Madelyn Fletcher had five RBI on the weekend with three runs scored. Jacelyn Buck and Gabby Davila each had five hits and Kennedy Johnson and Alexis Chavez had four apiece.
- In the last 10 Sun Belt Conference games, lead-off hitter Alexis Chavez is batting .400 with 14 hits. Kennedy Johnson is right behind Chavez with 11 hits and leads this stat subset with nine RBI. Chavez (5) and Johnson (4) combined for nine of the team's 16 doubles in that timeframe.
- Kennedy Johnson's .407 batting average in Sun Belt Conference games is best on the ULM team
 and ranks seventh in the league. She has 22 hits, tied for second in the SBC, a total that includes
 a league-best eight doubles.
- In Sun Belt Conference action, Warhawk pitcher Adrianna Chavarria is ranked third for holding
 opponents to a .156 batting average with Victoria Abrams 10th at .228. Kinsey Kackley ranks
 ninth with 41.2 innings pitched and 10th with 32 strikeouts. On the ERA chart, Chavarria is seventh in the SBC with a 1.91 ERA and Abrams is ninth at 2.56.

ULM swept its Sun Belt Conference series against Coastal Carolina with two wins in a doubleheader Friday. For ULM, it was the first sweep of a Sun Belt opponent since 2018 when the Warhawks took three games from the Chanticleers.

Game one was scoreless for both ULM and Coastal Carolina through four innings with two of the Chanticleers' three hits coming in the first two innings. The Warhawks scored in the fifth when Lourdes Bacon led off with a single, stole second and then advanced to third on a Coastal throwing error. Gabby Davila plated Bacon with her single on the next play for a 1-0 ULM lead.

In the sixth inning, Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week Kennedy Johnson hit a double and moved to third on a Jacelyn Buck single. Johnson scored on a Madelyn Fletcher sacrifice fly for the 2-0 lead and eventual final score. Victoria Abrams (7-3) pitched a three-hit shutout in game one striking out three and allowing only five baserunners.

In the second game, the Warhawks went to work with five runs in the first two innings. Korie Kreps drew a walk, moved around the bases and scored on a Davila sacrifice fly as Davila went 3-for-5 on the day with three RBI. Makiya Thomas led off the Coastal half of the first inning with a home run to tie the game at one-all.

Four runs on four hits in the second inning put ULM up 5-1. Kelsey Giddens drew a walk and Fletcher's single to left moved her to second and a wild pitch advanced both runners. Kennedy Page's ground out plated Kelsey Giddens and moved Fletcher to third. Alexis Chavez stole second after a bunt single, allowing Fletcher to come home. Kreps stole third and scored on Buck's double.

Coastal Carolina's Maddy Jennings homered in the bottom of the second and Thomas hit her second home run of the game to bring the Chants within two runs at 5-3 in the third. The Warhawks added a final run in the seventh when Johnson singled to lead off the inning and scored on Davila's double.

Johnson and Page each had two hits in game two with doubles coming off the bats of Kreps, Davila and Buck. Kreps scored two runs and had an RBI along with Buck and Page. Buck drew two walks and Davila had two RBI in game two.



STANGIER-YOUNG LEADERSHIP CENTER



Construction began last fall on the Stangier-Young Leadership Center, a multi-purpose venue that will provide student-athletes an opportunity to achieve more academically, athletically and professionally. The softball program collected more than \$1.1 million in private donations, including \$300,000 each from lead benefactors Gretchen Stangier and Carol Young.

Located along the first-base line of ULM's current complex, the Stangier-Young Leadership Center will offer more than 6,000 square feet of functional space, including a new covered bullpen.

Because the project came together so quickly, many of the current Warhawks will have the chance to utilize it before completing their eligibility with construction complete by fall 2022.

A program that finished No. 14 nationally academically in 2020-21 will have access to more resources, including a tutor room, a study area that can also serve as a place for team gatherings, a 35-seat film room, to watch film on opponents or to develop life skills, an expanded locker room, upgraded showers, a nutrition bar, areas for uniform and equipment storage and a laundry room.

Fund-raising efforts began later in 2020 with a launch event that was a bigger hit than anyone could have imagined. Stangier and Young became friends of the program in January 2020 after attending ULM's "Hang Out with the Hawks" fundraiser. Stangier's wealth management business is based in Portland, Oregon, while Young lived in Monroe for about five years. Gretchen Stangier had never been to a softball game of any kind up until that point. While Stangier wasn't a softball aficionado, she was impressed with Fichtner.

"Watching how she presented herself and presented the vision of what she wanted to create and the excitement and enthusiasm she could instill in the students is what caught my attention," Stangier said. "That's a very rare quality." Learning more about Fichtner's plans, she decided to invest in the cause.

"These are future leaders who are women who will be able to go back and make impacts of their own," Stangier said. "It's kind of that ripple effect."

Softball had been a huge part Young's upbringing and she played into her 30s. She'd even been contemplating playing again to pursue a gold medal in the national senior games.

"The reason I wanted to do that is because softball was such an important part of my life when I was a kid," she said. "Reflecting back on my life, I realized how much I got from having participated in softball. It taught me how to be a leader and how to deal with failure. It gave me leadership skills."

After attending ULM's softball fundraiser and meeting the players and coaches, Young was inspired to give back as well.

"This is so much more meaningful than me going back and trying to play," Young said. "It's like giving back what I got from softball and helping pass that on to this group of girls and generations to come."

Additionally, Stangier and Young connected Fichtner with other donors to bring the project to life.

ON THE STANGIER-YOUNG LEADERSHIP CENTER

"When Coach Fichtner first showed it to me, I was like, 'Wow, this is going to be amazing, but it's beyond anything I actually had in mind. We're super appreciative of everything she and the coaching staff have done for us so far and how fast they've gotten it done. This is going to take our program to the next level. This will get recruits here that might not have come before because of the facilities."

HEAD COACH MOLLY FICHTNER



MOLLY FICHTNER

Molly Fichtner enters her fourth season as head softball coach at ULM in 2022. She was hired as the seventh head softball coach in the history of ULM on September 21, 2018.

Fichtner's third season at ULM in 2021 saw the Warhawks pick up 17 wins, the most in her tenure, and a signature win over the No. 14 Ragin' Cajuns to conclude the regular season. It marked ULM's first win over the Cajuns since 2012. The Warhawks also picked up a pair of wins over I-20 rival Louisiana Tech. ULM also picked up a win at the Sun Belt Conference Championship for the second consecutive tournament.

Fichtner coached senior Jayden Mount to NFCA Third Team All-South Region and First Team All-Sun Belt Conference honors after hitting .338 with five home runs, nine doubles, one triple, 24 RBIs and 18 walks to seven strikeouts. Junior Korie Kreps was Second Team All-SBC after hitting .324 with four homers, 12 doubles, three triples, 16 RBIs and 33 walks. As a team, ULM's batting average jumped 17 points and ERA dropped by nearly two-thirds of a run as compared to the 2019 season.

In the COVID-19 pandemic shortened 2020 season, Fichtner's Warhawks built off the success established late in the 2019 season by going 10-14. As a team, ULM was hitting .295 and had posted a team ERA of 4.30 before the season was shut down. The Warhawk pitching staff threw three shutouts and allowed just one run twice.

In her first season at ULM, the Warhawks improved throughout the course of the season, winning two of their final three Sun Belt Conference series to claim the final spot in the 2019 SBC Championship. Once ULM arrived in San Marcos, Texas the Warhawks hit their peak, winning three games and advancing to the semifinals before having the season come to an end. Sydney McKay led the team with a .382 batting average while stealing 26 bases.

Fichtner has seen success at the highest levels of the game. The Houston, Texas native won 14 games in her first season as ULM head coach and led her team to the semi-finals of the Sun Belt Conference tournament.

Fichtner made the transition to Monroe from East Carolina University, where she spent a year as an assistant coach. Before her time with the Pirates, Fichtner spent two seasons in the same role at Dartmouth College.

After her honor-filled collegiate career, Fichtner remained at Alabama as a volunteer coach while pursuing her master's degree. After finishing her master's degree in 2015, she played one season in the National Fastpitch (NPF) league with the Dallas Charge.

Fichtner is a 2014 graduate of Alabama, who started her collegiate career at UTSA in San Antonio, Texas, before transferring to Tuscaloosa for her final two seasons. With the Crimson Tide, Fichtner appeared in 102 games, starting in 88.

As a senior, she was named to the All-SEC Second Team after pacing the Crimson Tide with a .391 batting average in conference play while tallying 27 hits, seven doubles and 16 RBI. Fichtner threw out a conference-leading seven would-be base stealers and committed just two errors in 125 chances with no passed balls behind the dish for a .984 fielding percentage in SEC play. Fichtner helped the Crimson Tide reach the Women's College World Series as Alabama advanced all the way to the National Championship Series.

In the classroom at Alabama, Fichtner earned President's List status all four semesters and was named a 2014 First-Team Academic All-American before graduating Summa Cum Laude with a 4.0 GPA. Fichtner also earned national-level recognition when selected as a National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-America Scholar-Athlete in 2013.

Fichtner carried over her success in the classroom to her coaching duties, assisting with the supervision of student-athlete academic progress and working with the academic advisors to ensure the student-athletes are thriving on and off the field.

During her time at UTSA, Fichtner was a two-time All-Southland Conference player, the 2011 Southland Freshman of the Year and 2012 Southland's Student-Athlete of the year.

During her years as an assistant coach at ECU and Dartmouth, Fichtner became familiar with the responsibilities required to run an efficient and successful softball program. She oversaw all administrative management duties for each program, in addition to her on-field and team responsibilities.

Fichtner shares her immense awareness of the game with her student-athletes, assisting with drills, studying film, and further growing her knowledge through statistical research and data collection. She has coached and counseled players in all positions, specializing in outfield skills, catching and hitting.

Fichtner has built a repertoire of experience in breaking down film, preparing scouting reports and practice plans, and preparing student-athletes for both the physical and mental aspects of the game.

Fichtner received her Master of Science degree in sports management from the University of Alabama in May 2015, only one year after earning a bachelor's degree in human environmental sciences from UA as well.
