- The Dartmouth softball team heads to Starkville, Mississippi for The Snowman: Alex Wilcox Memorial Tournament.
- The Big Green will take on Murray State, Abilene Christian and host Mississippi State in their second weekend of the 2023 season.

Last Weekend

- Dartmouth opened the season in Madeira Beach, Florida last weekend at the Spring Games event. The Big Green earned their second 3-0 start in program history and first since 2009 with wins over FIU, UT Martin and Valparaiso to open the weekend.
- The Big Green's momentum was halted by Siena dropping its first game of the year by a score of 5-3. Dartmouth was unable to defeat Notre Dame Sunday afternoon, falling to the Fighting Irish, 7-4.
- Kate Farren, Mary Beth Cahalan and Leila Hennessy each recorded home runs over the weekend. Maddie Katona was strong offensively throughout the weekend, recording five hits in 11 at-bats, while Farren picked up six RBIs in five games.
- Rachel McCarroll and Stella Bale were featured in the circle for Dartmouth. McCarroll finished the weekend with a 3-1 record, including a complete-game victory over FIU in Dartmouth's season-opener. Bale appeared in four games, recording 16 strikeouts in 16.1 innings of action.

Wait, Have We Met?

- Dartmouth will face off with three opponents for the first time in program history this
 weekend. This has been a common theme for the Big Green this season, as they have
 battled two unfamiliar opponents already and are set to face one more following this
 weekend.
- The Big Green are 1-1 against first-time opponents this season. Dartmouth met Valparaiso last weekend at the Spring Games, defeating the Beacons by a score of 5-2. The Big Green also faced off with Notre Dame for the first time in Madeira Beach, Florida, falling short by a score of 7-4.
- Dartmouth travels to Mississippi for the first time in program history. While the Big Green open the year in the south most seasons, the Magnolia State has alluded the program. Dartmouth holds an 0-1 record against teams from Mississippi, as the Big Green fell to Mississippi Valley State in a neutral-site game in 2017.
- Following this weekend, Dartmouth is scheduled to face one more first-time foe. The Big Green travel to Moraga, California for a pair of games against St. Mary's from March 17-18.

Scouting Report

Scouting Mississippi State

- The Bulldogs are set to host The Snowman: Alex Wilcox Memorial Tournament with a record of 12-4 to start the season. Mississippi State is receiving votes in both major polls.
- MSU comes off a successful 2022 campaign, capped off by hosting a Super Regional in Starkville. The Bulldogs earned their first Super Regional berth in program history by defeating No. 2 Florida State twice in Tallahassee.
- The Bulldogs have won six games in a row heading into the tournament. This includes
 a win over Mississippi Valley State on Tuesday in their first home contest of the year.

Scouting Murray State

- Murray State enters the weekend with a record of 8-6 and have won four of its last five games. The Racers protected their home field well last weekend in the Velvet Milkman Invitational, picking up wins over Ball State, Loyola Chicago and Bellarmine.
- The Racers captured their first conference tournament title last season, earning a bid to the Regional Round of the NCAA Tournament. Returning senior Gracie Osbron picked up where she left off a season ago, holding a batting average of .442 and leads her team with 19 hits, three home runs and 15 RBIs through 14 games.

Scouting Abilene Christian

- Abilene Christian has not shied away from tough competition thus far in 2023, as the Wildcats have faced off with ranked opponents three times. ACU took part in the Lone Star State Invitational last weekend, which featured a pair of matchups against then-No. 10/12 Virginia Tech and a contest against No. 9/13 Texas.
- The Wildcats played Virginia Tech close in its final game of the weekend, falling by a score of 4-1. Abilene Christian showed marked improvement after dropping an 11-0 tilt to the Hokies two days prior.

About Alex Wilcox

- The Snowman: Alex Wilcox Memorial Tournament honors the legendary spirit of the late Alex Wilcox. Diagnosed with ovarian cancer in 2015, Wilcox defied the odds and continued to play softball during her treatments, leading Brantley High School to a pair of Alabama state championships.
- As a freshman at Mississippi State, Wilcox continued to battle cancer while pursuing her dream of playing collegiate softball. She appeared in eight games, starting three during her freshman season.
- The Bulldogs immortalized Wilcox following her passing in 2018, making her the first female student-athlete to have her jersey retired on September 18, 2018. MSU rebranded its annual February tournament to honor Wilcox's memory.

Jen Williams Head Coach - 5th Season Alma Mater - Middlebury '07

Career Record: 211-183-1 Dartmouth Record: 43-61 Last Season: 20-24

Jennifer Williams was hired in October of 2018 as the seventh head coach in the history of the program.

Last season, Williams led the Big Green to a thirdplace finish in the Ivy League standings following a strong season in conference play. Dartmouth concluded the 2023 campaign with a 14-7 record against Ivy League opponents, finishing one game outside of the conference championship series.

Williams mentored Billie McFadyen during the 2022 season, as the senior earned Ivy League Player of the Year honors. McFadyen led the conference in hits (48), was fourth in batting average (.350) and RBIs (25).

Williams comes to Dartmouth from MIT where she spent the previous eight seasons as the head coach, becoming the winningest coach in program history. She guided the Engineers to a 168-122-1 record, which includes a 122-46-1 mark since 2015. In 2018, Williams led MIT to a 38-11-1 record, breaking 18 team records in the process and winning its first-ever New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) championship. The team also earned a spot in the DIII College World Series, finishing seventh in the nation, two years after placing fifth at the event.

During her eight years as the head coach at MIT, Williams and her staff received the NFCA New England Coaching Staff of the Year Award in 2016 and 2018 as her teams finished in the top 10 of the national rankings. Williams coached the first-ever all-American softball player at MIT along with four Academic All-Americans, 13 all-conference selections, 10 all-region athletes and two NEWMAC Pitchers of the Year. MIT advanced to the NCAA Softball Tournament three times and made the College World series twice. Her 2018 team posted a cumulative GPA of 3.670, which ranked fourth in the country among DIII institutions.

To go along with her duties as head coach, Williams has served as the director of sports performance at MIT since 2012. This position included being in charge of strength and conditioning, nutrition, sports medicine and communication with the sports engineering program to search for relevant projects to enhance student-athlete well-being and training efficiency.

Prior to arriving at MIT, Williams spent one year at Southern New Hampshire University as an assistant coach where she worked closely with the pitching staff and assisted with infield and hitting instruction.

Williams began her coaching career in 2007 at Smith College where she was the primary defensive coach for pitchers and corner infielders for two years as she pursued a master's of science in exercise science and sports studies. Her coaching experience extends overseas, she worked as the pitching coach for the Junior and Senior Swedish National Softball Teams in 2008. She also assisted the Enköping Softball Team while in Sweden.

A 2007 graduate of Middlebury College, Williams was a four-year member of the softball team as a pitcher. She graduated as the all-time leader in career wins (32), complete games (41) and innings pitched (327.1).

Sydney Benz was promoted to first assistant coach during the summer of 2022 following her first season with the Big Green. She leads Dartmouth's hitting efforts and assists with defensive coaching.

Last season, Benz served as Dartmouth's defense coach and led the No. 1 defensive unit in the Ivy League. She helped mentor Ivy League Player of the Year Billie McFadyen and All-Ivy League selection Kate Farren to strong seasons in the infield. Benz helped Dartmouth attain the best fielding percentage in the Ivy League as the program finished the season with a 14-7 record in conference play.

Benz joined the coaching staff in August of 2021 after serving two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach at East Carolina. She had a hand in the day-to-day operations of the Pirates program, including practice plans, recruiting, film break down and scouting reports while acting as the first base coach. She also organized and facilitated the team travel plans and meals, plus helped grow the sport in the Greenville area by providing hitting and defensive instruction to local athletes.

Ashley Weingartz joined the Dartmouth softball staff as an assistant coach prior to the 2023 season.

Weingartz joins the Big Green following a stint at Hofstra as an assistant coach during the 2022 season. She worked primarily with defense and coached first base throughout the season. Weingartz was involved in the day-to-day operations of the program, which included practice planning, scouting reports and coordination of video and travel.

She helped lead the Pride to a third-place regular season finish in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA), as Hofstra finished the year with a 13-6 conference record.

After the 2022 campaign, four members of the Pride were honored with post season conference awards. Weingartz aided Meghan Giordano and Chelsea Manto to first-team All-CAA honors, while Amanda Maffucci earned second-team status. Julia Apsel was named to the CAA All-Rookie team while Weingartz was on staff with the Pride.

Sarah Goodman enters her fourth season with the Big Green as a volunteer assistant coach. She serves as the program's catching coach and the pitch caller.

Goodman previously spent five seasons at MIT. During her time in Cambridge, the Engineers enjoyed a multitude of broken team records, the first conference championship in program history, four NCAA tournament appearances, two Super Regional Championships, and two trips to the DIII College World Series, finishing fifth and seventh in the country. Goodman was part of staffs to receive the NFCA New England Coaching Staff of the Year Award in both 2016 and 2018. Goodman primarily worked with the catchers and outfield as well as offensive development and pitch calling during her run with the Engineers.

Prior to her tenure at MIT, Goodman spent two seasons as a Graduate Assistant Coach with her alma mater, Smith College, and helped them to an ECAC Championship title in 2014. She also spent five seasons as a head coach for club ball in Rochester, New York.
