### KICKING THINGS OFF

**LAST TIME OUT:** L, 0-2 vs. #13 Notre Dame

**HIGHLIGHTS:** The best season in Mississippi State's soccer history came to a close as the Bulldogs fell 2-0 to Notre Dame in the Sweet 16 at the MSU Soccer Field. Notre Dame struck twice in the first half while pumping in 14 shots to State's one. The Bulldogs responded with seven shots in the second half but could not find an equalizer. The Fighting Irish would go on to lose in the Elite Eight to Stanford.

### KEY STORYLINES

**BEST THEY'VE EVER BEEN:** MSU's 19 wins in 2024 were a program record, and its three losses were also the fewest in school history.

**VIVA STARKVEGAS:** The Bulldogs turned the MSU Soccer Field into a fortress in 2024, running their home unbeaten streak to 16 matches, including 14 consecutive wins. State finished the year 12-1 at home and conceded just two goals in Starkville.

**HISTORY IN STARKVEGAS:** MSU advanced to the Sweet 16 for the second consecutive season in front of a school-record 4,022 fans in a 1-0 victory over Washington. That stood as the nation's highest attended Second Round match.

**DAWGS' HOT STARTS:** In the James Armstrong era, State was 57-1-6 when scoring first. Over those six years, the Bulldogs were 37-0-3 when leading at half.

- Constructed in 1995 ahead of the Bulldogs' first season of soccer competition.
- Located on the north side of the Mississippi State University campus between Barr Avenue and College View Drive.
- Features a main grandstand area which accommodates more than 500 people, while the grass hillsides that bookend the stands can seat over 1,000 fans for any given contest
- 2,600 square-foot brick facility which houses a concession stand, men's and women's restrooms and a spacious press box debuted in 2008
- Enhanced with a new 18'x32' Daktronics HD video board situated in the northwest corner of the complex before the start of the 2018 season.

## TEAM NOTES

## CHAMPIONS OF THE SEC

- State soccer etched its name into the history books, clinching sole possession of the SEC Regular Season Championship for the first time in program history with a hard-fought 2-0 win at Texas A&M (Oct. 27).
- The Bulldogs were propelled in the match by goals from Ally Perry and Elle McCaslin along with a commanding defensive display led by goalkeeper Maddy Anderson.
- The Bulldogs went 10-0-0 in SEC play becoming the fifth school in league history to win every conference match in a season.
- State was the only team in the nation to win every one of its regular-season conference matches.
- The Bulldogs outscored opponents 29-2 in conference play.

## RECORDS WERE MADE TO BE BROKEN

- MSU's 19 wins in 2024 were a program record, and its three losses were also the fewest in school history. That resulted in a school record winning percentage (.864).
- State ranked No. 8 in average attendance in 2024 with 1,927 fans per match, a program record. The Bulldogs' 25,051 total attendance ranked sixth nationally, and MSU added four new single-match attendance records to the program record book.
- Mississippi State reached a No. 1 national ranking and earned a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history.
- The Bulldogs' No. 9 final RPI was their highest on record as was their No. 10 ranking in the final United Soccer Coaches poll.

## HONOR ROLL CALL

- Macey Hodge, Maddy Anderson and Rylie Combs gave MSU multiple All-Americans for the first time in school history.
- Hodge also became MSU's first MAC Hermann Award semifinalist.
- Five Bulldogs were named to the United Soccer Coaches All-Region teams, including a program-best four First Team selections.

## ELITE DEFENSIVE PERFORMANCE

- At the heart of Mississippi State's stellar season was a love of the defensive side of the ball. MSU's plus-35 goal differential ranked 10th nationally thanks in large part to allowing just 10 goals this season.
- Anchoring this effort was graduate goalkeeper Maddy Anderson, the 2024 SEC Goalkeeper of the Year, whose record-setting performance drew national attention. Anderson led the NCAA in nearly every major goalkeeping category in the regular season, including goals against average (0.28) and shutout percentage (.824). She finished the season among the nation's top 10 in goals against average (0.47; 8th) and shutouts (14; 2nd).
- Anderson's allowed only 10 goals across 22 games while recording an .846 save percentage, making her one of the premier shot-stoppers in college soccer.
- Under assistant coach and goalkeepers coach Kat Stratton, the Bulldogs have set program record each of the last three years in both shutouts (16) and fewest shots allowed per game (7.5).
- The Bulldog defense led the SEC and ranked second nationally in shutout percentage (72.7 percent) and goals against average (0.45).

## PERRY LEADING THE CHARGE

- Offensively, the Bulldogs were propelled by junior forward and First Team All-SEC selection Ally Perry.
- Perry led the team with 10 goals and 24 points, frequently finding the net at critical moments and applying constant pressure on opposing defenses.
- She led the SEC in shots per game (4.36) and tied the school record with five game-winning goals, which led the SEC and ranked 17th nationally.
- Perry recorded at least one point in 50 percent of State's matches in 2024.

## PRO DAWGS

- Six members of MSU's 2024 squad signed professional contracts following the season.
- Macey Hodge signed a two-year contract with Angel City FC in the NWSL, and she was later joined on the club by Hannah Johnson, who signed a roster relief contract after being name to the preseason roster as a trialist.
- Maddy Anderson also signed with an NWSL club after a preseason trial, joining Racing Louisville FC's roster.
- Internationally, Rylie Combs crossed the Atlantic to play in Sweden with Eskilstuna United in the second division, Elitettan.
- Aitana Martinez-Montoya returned to Europe following the season. The Spaniard signed with Racing Power FC in neighboring Portugal.
- After recovering from her season-ending injury, Colombian Women's National Team member and Olympian Ilana Izquierdo signed with Atletico San Luis in Mexico.

## SEC COACH OF THE YEAR - JAMES ARMSTRONG

- Six years ago, James Armstrong inherited a program that had only one season with a winning SEC record before his arrival in 2019.
- Armstrong's milestone year in 2024 saw him become the winningest soccer coach in Mississippi State history while delivering the program's first SEC Championship.

## SOMETHING 'BOUT THAT WHITE KIT

- Under Armstrong, State was 39-11-7 when wearing the white kit.
- The Bulldogs went 12-2 this season when donning white on white.

TEAM NOTES

VIVA STARKVEGAS

- MSU posted its best home record in program history (12-1-0).
- The Bulldogs turned MSU Soccer Field into a fortress, extending their home unbeaten streak to 16 matches, including 14 consecutive wins, during the 2024 season.
- The team ended the year drawing seven consecutive top-10 crowds, contributing to a strong home-field advantage.

MACEY IN THE MIDFIELD

- As a fierce competitor and inspirational leader, Macey Hodge has been the pulse of the Bulldogs' midfield, orchestrating plays and driving the team's success.
- Recognized as SEC Midfielder of the Year, Hodge's dynamic presence and game-changing abilities have made her a focal point on both ends of the pitch.
- Hodge was also named MSU's first MAC Hermann Trophy semifinalist and earned a spot on TopDrawerSoccer's Best XI First Team.
- She played 97 career matches at State, logging 8,509 minutes, both of which are program records. She totaled five assists over five seasons.

CLUTCH COMBS

- As the anchor of Mississippi State's defense, Rylie Combs has redefined what it means to be a leader on the back line.
- Recognized as SEC Defender of the Year, Combs has been a force in shutting down some of the most potent offenses in the country.
- She played 92 percent of the team's minutes in 2024 and was the only Bulldog field player to eclipse the 1,800-minute mark.
- Combs helped State's defense hold opponents to a school-record 7.5 shots per game.

ALL THE ALL-SEC HONORS

- Mississippi State's depth of talent and team cohesion was highlighted by multiple All-SEC selections for the fourth year in a row and seventh time in school history.
- State's nine honorees tripled the previous MSU single-season record.
- Maddy Anderson, Rylie Combs, Macey Hodge and Ally Perry earned First Team honors,
- Zoe Main, Ilana Izquierdo and Alexis Gutierrez earned Second Team recognition, and Aitana Martinez-Montoya was a Third Team selection.
- Kennedy Husbands earned SEC All-Freshman Team honors.

GOING FOR GOLD

- Ilana Izquierdo became the 11th student-athlete in school history to compete in an Olympic Games while still an active student-athlete or immediately following their final year of eligibility. Of the prior such athletes, eight returned to campus the following fall.
- Izquierdo is the first active student-athlete to represent MSU at an Olympics since Marta Pen Freitas (POR) did so in the women's 1500m at the 2016 Rio Games. Pen Freitas returned to campus but turned pro before completing the 2017 outdoor track season.
- She is the first to do so in a team sport since B.J. Wallace (USA) played baseball at the 1992 Barcelona Games.
- Izquierdo will be the fourth-youngest player on Colombia's women's soccer roster and the 21st-youngest in the tournament.
- She was joined by State's first All-American in soccer, Catalina Perez, who made her second Olympic team for Colombia.
- The duo was the first pair of MSU athletes to ever compete together in a team sport at the Olympics.
- State was one of 12 schools with multiple soccer players in the Olympics. Of those, only Florida (CAN), Florida State (USA), Penn State (USA), Stanford (USA) and West Virginia (CAN) saw athletes compete as teammates for the same nation.
- Colombia won its first ever Olympic match in Paris with Izquierdo starting in the 2-0 victory over New Zealand. The nation reached the Olympic quarterfinals for the first time in program history before meeting world No. 1 Spain where Izquierdo's squad lost on penalties.

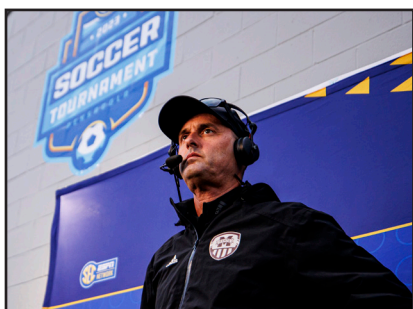
